

The number potency of Capricorn is ten (10) symbolising the one "I AM" that exists in ALL and its creation.


Pythagoras expressed this through the Tetractys symbol, ten dots in four rows, each with one, two, three and four dots.






The vertical column 3



Shambala 56: Indebtedness



Recollect Shambala, bow down to the Lord Sanat Kumara, and tread the path of Lord Maitreya, the World Teacher.

Shambala is the centre for transformation. Death as a transformation is a truth, fundamentally inaugurated by Shambala. Those who die, are reborn again and again on the planet. A detached attitude to things and a state of no-desire is indeed a rarity on this planet. Even the ones, who have transcended the desire nature in them, cannot pass-over from the planet so very easily.

Even beyond crossing over the desire, the duty remains. We are indebted to the planet. The more one gains in awareness, the more one comprehends that it is not easy to stand free of this debt. The Hierarchy on the planet is also engaged in the duty that emerges out of such indebtedness to the planet.

Death is to the body and not to the being. To the beings, death brings no change in awareness. Desire brings the beings back again and again into cycles of birth and death. Shambala therefore teaches that death to body is no death! To be dead to one's own nature of desire and to be born again in duty is seen as real transformation. Such birth is seen as a much superior birth. To discharge the duties emerging out of the indebtedness towards the Seers and the planet, one needs to conduct acts of service on the planet for long cycles of time.

To those ever engaged in duty untouched by the residues of desire, the formation of the subtle body (Antahkarana Sareera) is a reality. By functioning with the subtle body, when the duties are discharged, there is no obligation to further remain on the planet. Even the subtle body can be dropped at will! The Masters of Wisdom that we know about, are the ones ever engaged in the work of goodwill, functioning through the subtle bodies. Lord Sanat Kumara guides the Hierarchy of Masters on the planet.

Lord Sanat Kumara dropped even his subtle body in the previous cycle of time (Kalpa), ascending to the state of Brahman. He is a grand light that has voluntarily instated himself on the planet for the upliftment of the beings.

Shambala thus teaches about the three deaths. The first is death to the form. The second is to the body of desire. Thereby, there is a cessation of the actions arising out of the desire nature. The third of the deaths is the Nirvana that results from the accomplishment of the ordained duties on the planet.

Master Djwhal Khul informs us that the only light that has stayed back on the planet having transcended the three states is Lord Sanat Kumara. Out of love for the beings on the planet, He has voluntarily stayed back and is available on this planet!

Saraswathi Suktam 7 The precision of utterance 2


There is a combination of sounds in a word. For example the word AKSHARAM consists of: A KA SHA RA M. It is a sound that:

The servant is no other than the mind. The mind needs something to do all the time. When it has no work to do, it works on the nerves of men. This is the major problem of humanity. "How to manage mind?" is a huge topic. Many books can be written on this to make business. But none of these books are helpful. The seers solved this problem long ago and the scriptures contain the solution. The mind which is a doer shall be entrusted work. The hermit gave the clue to set the mind upon the tree, to go up and down. The tree is no other than the tree of life within you. Life activity is perceptible in us as respiration. It is an activity of inhalation and exhalation. Application of mind upon inhalation and exhalation can be an activity of fairly long duration by which mind engages with and tries to find the source of life activity.

By regular application of mind upon respiration one accomplishes much, the final accomplishment being initiation. Man gains quietude, peace, and even health by regular application of mind upon respiration. The rhythmic activity of respiration brings rhythm to mind and man is able to accomplish much with the help of rhythm. Man also gains the ability to withdraw mind from objectivity by applying the mind upon respiration. By this he would not let his mind into objectivity when no duties are involved. He thus avoids avoidable actions. His life tends to be concise and precise and does not flow anymore into non-essential activities. By this he gains much time for contemplating upon respiration and gains the related peace and quietude. As said earlier, regular sittings are helpful for the purpose of observing inhalation and exhalation.

On Secret Doctrine

Dhyan-Chohans



This body serves as the vehicle for the "growth" and the transformations through Manas and owing to the accumulation of experiences, of the finite into the infinite, of the transient into the eternal and absolute.

The "Lunar Monads" cannot progress, for they have not yet had sufficient touch with the forms created by "Nature" to allow of their accumulating experiences through its means. It is the Manasa Dhyanis who fill up the gap, and they represent the evolutionary power of intelligence and mind, the link between "spirit" and "matter", in this round.¹

The pure object, apart from consciousness is unknown to us, while living on the plane of our three-dimensional world. Cosmic ideation focused in a principle or Upadhi (basis) results as the consciousness of the individual ego. Its manifestation varies with the degree of Upadhi, e.g., through that known as Manas it wells up as mind-consciousness; through the more finely differentiated fabric (sixth state of matter) of the Buddhi resting on the experience of Manas as its basis, as a stream of spiritual intuition.²

The supra-consciousness descends into the mind and even further into the grosser plane to turn the man into a Master - an immortal, divine one. Master CVV calls this as "physical immortality".³

The objective of Master CVV YOGA is to develop etheric body of the human being through the "New Pituitary" to experience continuity of life.

"You shall experience simultaneous existence in all the planes". This is the keynote of Aquarian Wisdom, the high point of human birth and the

Doctrine of Eternal Presence

Introduction to Srimad Bhagavatham 6



As long as the Creator remained in the Presence of THAT (THAT in English is equivalent to tat in Sanskrit) things happened well. Whenever he was out of the Presence things did not happen well. If that is the case with the Creator, you and I cannot be better off, without being in the Presence. We too have to be in THAT, if things have to proceed well. The whole scheme (the Plan of creation) runs from THAT. You can be a watchful, observant to witness and experience the splendour of all that happens through you. A part in you does, while another part in you witnesses and enjoys. If you settle only in the doing part, you remain as labourer. You can enjoy the splendour. You need to settle in that part where you remain an observer, while the other part responds to the world. The observer is the Insider. The doer is the outsider. The insider resides in the Antahkarana. While the outsider lives in objective mind, senses, body and surrounding environment, i.e., Bahir Karana. As you learn to sit in the inner chamber, you perceive the Lord's work and let it flow through you. If you sit in the outer chamber, you get into illusion, entangled, confused and bound. The Creator realised this and settled in the Presence. Thus the Creator himself is the first disciple and the first medium to this philosophy of Bhagavata.

Sound



Respiration and Pulsation The sound "SO-HAM" and "OM" 1

If we carefully listen to the respiration, making a very rhythmic respiration, we will listen to two sounds. One sound is when we inhale, the other sound is when we exhale. When we inhale, we can listen to the sound SO and when we exhale, we can listen to the sound HAM. SO HAM is the sound that we listen to when we carefully listen to our own respiration. Keep listening to your own inhalation and exhalation, you will inevitably hear these two sounds.

Continuous listening to the rhythmic happening of these two sounds, SO and HAM, by applying the mind upon inspiration and expiration, we gain to the next advanced step called Pulsation, and we will be able to listen to pulsation. Pulsation is the basis for our respiration. If there is no pulsation inside, there is no respiration. By continuous listening to the rhythmic happening of the sound SO-HAM, we merge the mind into respiration. As mind is thus merged into respiration, the two go together to join the pulsation. That is the state of our Existence, where the respiratory process and the thinking process have merged. That is said to be the first point of Unity of Consciousness.

Normally, certain forms are agreeable and certain forms are not agreeable to the mind. The cat is agreeable, but not the tiger. A peacock is agreeable, but not a snake. 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

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
Rudra The Lord of Cosmic Will and Vibration

The Teacher is a vehicle of the Divine 1





The occult science recognises pure existence as absolute God, which is within and beyond creation. Pure existence means that, it is not conscious as yet. Consciousness is hidden in it and is capable of emerging there from. In that state of pure existence there is no observer and the observed. It is compared to a deep slumber. When an individual is in deep sleep he is existing but not conscious of his existence. From this state of sleep, awakening happens. The individual gains awareness of his existence, becomes conscious of his existence. Thus awareness and consciousness are seen as an emergence from existence. This state of pure existence called absolute God is the potential source of all manifestations of which the first emanation is called awareness. It is also called Prakruthi, meaning the cosmic nature. This is the first modification of God absolute as all knowing God. The seeming nothingness yields to knowledge or awareness or consciousness called the light. The impulse for seeming nothingness to that of awareness is explained as a spring-up; as an emergence. It is called one becoming two; existence becoming awareness. Later this awareness details into a triple, which is the second modification. This triple is will knowledge - action. In the scriptural terminology the pure existence is the absolute God, existence - awareness is male-female God and the triple is the trinity.

The primary modification is from pure existence to awareness. This is an awakening that happens according to scriptures as per a time plan. Thus the awareness and time are said to be emerging with the help of a trill that happens to the state of pure existence. This trill is called cosmic force, cosmic fire, cosmic prana. It is an impulse from existence and later



continues to be as pulse in creation. This pulsation is the chief motivating force for all that manifests in creation from supra cosmic existence to mundane existence. All visible existence has its basis in pulsation. This pulsating force is force of prana and is said to be the foremost in creation. Without this force the existence remains inactive and the very activity of awareness is not without the source. It is the cause of all activity and is the base for all modifications of awareness into various states up to the gross physical. This dynamic pulsating prana is the chief instrument of transformations of Prakruthi from subtle to gross states and from gross to subtle states. The pranic descent enables unfoldment of the worlds from cosmic to solar and from solar to planetary levels. Its absorption withdraws these worlds into itself. Thus prana is seen as a thread that holds together all that is in manifestation. It is like the one thread that holds the beads of a rosary.



Picture to the Month Capricorn - Blessing and Protection




Light upon Death. Overseas Messages VIII
