



Be a performer, be a performer with goodwill in mind.





Are There Angels in Stars?

We may be answered that the personal beliefs of some pious Astronomers, however great they may be as scientific characters, are no proofs of the actual existence and presence in space of intelligent supramundane Beings, of either Gods or Angels. It is the behaviour of the stars and planets themselves that has to be analysed and inferences must be drawn therefrom. Renan asserts that nothing that we know of the sidereal bodies warrants the idea of the presence of any intelligence, whether internal or external to them.

Let us see, says Reynaud, if this is a fact, or only one more empty scientific assumption.

The orbits traversed by the planets are far from being immutable. They are, on the contrary, subject to perpetual mutation in position, as in form. Elongations, contractions, and orbital widening, oscillations from right to left, slackening and quickening of speed... And all this on a plane which seems to vacillate. [Terre et Ciel.p.28. lbid.]

As is very pertinently observed by des Mousseux:

Here is a path having little of the mathematical and mechanical precision claimed for it; for we know of no clock which, having gone slow for several minutes should catch up the right time of itself and without the turn of a key.

So much for blind law and force. As for the physical impossibility – a miracle indeed in the sight of Science – of a stone raised in the air against the law of gravitation, this is what Babinet – the deadliest enemy and opponent of the phenomena of levitation – (cited by Arago) says:

Everyone knows the theory of bolides [meteors] and aeroliths . . . In Connecticut an immense aerolith was seen [a mass of eighteen hundred feet in diameter], bombarding a whole American zone and returning to the spot [in mid-air] from which it had started. [Oeuvres d'Arago.vol.i.,

219: quoted by De Mirville, iii.462.]

Thus we find in both of the cases above cited – that of self-correcting planets and meteor of gigantic size flying back into the air – a "blind force" regulating and resisting the natural tendencies of "blind matter," and even occasionally repairing its mistakes and correcting its failures. This is far more miraculous and even "extravagant," one would say, than any "Angel-guided" Element.

The Time Sense

The time sense of man is governed by Saturn. Man is made to wait by his own limitation. We say, "I am late." When we say that we are late or early, it is relative to a prefixed time. Suppose, that we fix our breakfast at 9 o' clock in the morning. If we reach the dining table at 8.30 a.m., we say that we are early, and if we reach at 9.30 a.m. we say that we are late. Whether late or early, it is relative to a time point fixed by us. Now, suppose that we have not fixed a time point, then there is no such thing as late or early. That is why there is one spiritual statement, which says, "There is no such thing as delay." Delay is when we expect an event to happen in a particular time, and relative to that expectation there is delay.

Suppose that we have fixed a time point to go to the beach at 4 o'clock and if we reach at 4.30 p.m. we feel, "Oh! We have delayed." The feeling of delay is arising out of a prior fixation, by a prior expectation. If there is no expectation, there is no delay. Where there is expectation, there is delay. Where there is expectation, there is disappointment; thus, it works relatively. The time sense of man is also governed by Saturn.

Thought 2

Thought is power; it is the deciding factor in life. This is a statement upon which all should ponder, for we can achieve nothing without thought. The Teacher

42. Enters and Resides in the Heart

The Teacher enters into the heart and resides therein the moment he is ardently invoked. Seating therein he conducts all the work of transformation relating to the physical, emotional and mental. The daily invocation of the Teacher into the heart centre is recommended. How to visualize the Teacher in the heart is already given in the previous names.

When the student invokes the Teacher, the Teacher enters the heart of the student and stays therein on a throne of lion. Since the heart astrologically relates to the sun sign Leo, seating in the heart is seating on the lion's throne. The Teacher is one who conquered long back the leonine energies; symbolically it is said that he conquered and killed the lion. The lion stands for self-consciousness which relates to the pride of personality. The Teacher has conquered it. He would enable the student also to conquer the lion.

The student therefore is well recommended to visualize the Teacher on the lion's throne and he himself seating at his feet offering himself to the Teacher for necessary rectification and transformation. The attribute of the Teacher given here suggests that not only the Teacher enters the heart of the student; he also enables the student to eventually enter the heart region and sit in the lotus of the heart. The lotus of the heart or the throne of the lion may not be understood as two things. It is a different presentation of the same state of consciousness. Each student is treated differently by the Teacher.

The heart is called hridayam, is 'Hrith-I-Am', meaning 'here I AM'. This is the facility of the etymological key in Sanskrit. In English also the word heart can be broken as he-art which is, cryptically to say, the art of the Divine (He), He-art centre. But this is a farfetched interpretation, while in

Sanskrit hridayam literally means 'here I AM'. The Master sits at the heart when invoked and conducts the art of transformation.

Very early in the morning I recollect the holy sandals of the Master in the inner chamber of my heart.

Kapila

The Essential Teachings of Kapila 1

- 1. The mind holds the master key for either liberation or conditioning. When you desire, it causes conditioning. It is so even when you desire liberation. Desiring liberation is also a desire. When you align mind with the universal consciousness, the liberation is the result.
- 2. Food, when taken in, gets assimilated into the system, losing its separate identity and helps energising the body. Likewise, the individual soul through discipleship can be assimilated into the Universal Soul, losing separative, selfish existence. The One in all is realised and there is no other.
- 3. The one who seeks liberation should forget desiring it. Acting as a wife, a child, a co-born, a friend, a husband, a disciple, a Master, etc one should identify with the One in all and align with the One. When thus aligned, liberated state of the being is a reality. When not identified and aligned, conditioning is a reality.

The one who attempts to escape from the worldly relation to find liberation is the one who is tricked and is hopelessly caught. He is like the one pursuing the oasis for water.

- 4. The creation, its process, the emergence of the cosmic, solar, planetary systems, the birth, the death, the various stages of life (as child in the womb, child, youth, adult, old age) are the details of a grand play emerging from an idea just like an idea from us manifests into a creation of our own. An idea to marry for instance!
- 5. The scenes and the characters in the dream seem different from the dreamer. As one wakes up from the dream, the scenes and the characters disappear into him. Only he remains as the One. Likewise, through proper comprehension of wisdom, existence as One (with no other) is experienced, where the concept of the other disappears.

The Dimensions



The whole creation is of eight dimensions. The original being non-dimensional - zero or infinity, the other seven are the real (?) dimensions.

- 1. Dimension of Truth/Principle.
- 2. Dimension of Time.
- 3. Dimension of Space.
- 4. Dimension of Ether.
- 5. Dimension of Water.
- 6. Dimension of Earth.
- 7. Dimension of Shape.

These Seven descend from eighth one and ascend into the eighth periodically. The Dimension of Principle or Satya Loka, evolves from the naval lotus of the eternal, causing the Dimension of Time. Thereafter the others manifest in the order and disappear in their reverse order. It is true with the macro and the micro cosmos.

The Trident

The trident held by Sri Guru Datta is symbolic of the triple energy held in an etheric form within the Brahmadanda. The triple energies are referred to as Ida, Pingala and Sushumna. They are the left, the right and the central energy currents. The left current causes the materialisation, the right current causes spiritualization and the central current causes the balance between the two, enabling the existence of the being in a particular plane of existence. Ida stands for involutionary energy, Pingala stands for evolutionary energy and Sushumna stands for the yogic energy which balances at every level the spirit and the matter to be in existence in that level.

Astrology also speaks of a zodiac of 12 sun signs, which are essentially pairs of 6 sun-signs. These 6 sun-signs represent the 6 centres in the etheric current Sushumna, which are explained by the yoga science as the Shad Chakras. From Ajna to Muladhara, they conduct the being in all the 6 planes, that is, from mind to matter (mind, akasha, air, fire, water and matter). There is the descent of the being through the Ida current, the ascent through the Pingala current, with the Sushumna current stabilising the being at the needed level, as per the requirements of the work.

The materialisation and spiritualization currents function in such harmony to give the related existence at a particular plane. These currents are like the current of the flowing river. Man feels the existence of the river while it is in eternal flow. There is water that comes in and water that departs at any particular point and in that ever-flowing flow, the existence of the river is felt, but in truth, it is the poise relating to reception and dispersal of the water flow. Such is the situation with every form in creation.

The two flows of Ida and Pingala in the opposing directions are also depicted by the sun-sign Pisces. Pisces is the Alfa and Omega of the creation, it

has the beginning and ending in it. Not only that, the beginning has the ending in-built in it, and the ending has the beginning in-built as well.

This principle of the opposing flows in total harmony with each other, is esoterically called by the Vedic seers as Ganga, which is called Ganges in the western languages. GA is the sound for movement. In between two GA there is the cipher, which is the source of the two and the balance of the two as well. For this reason the sound Ganga was considered most sacred by the Vedic seers. The one who is in the middle, is the poised one, the equilibrated one, the fulfilled one, who can experience the bliss in every state of awareness. This is called synthesis. This synthesis is promised to be bestowed by Sri Guru Datta. His holding the trident is indicative of such promise.

From the Teacher's Pen Questions and Answers Inter-Racial Marriages

Question: Dear Master, do you encourage, inter racial-marriages?

Answer: Each race has its distinct quality and characteristics be it Asian, Arabian, African, European or the yellow race. When inter-racial marriages happen it is like two powerful streams of different quality and characteristics integrating into one. It has its necessary upsurge, conflict and confusion. Such marriages are now contemplated to form a new race of humanity where there is an admixture of all races. It is undoubtedly an experiment which has its unrest in the initial centuries.

Imagine two powerful streams enjoining each other. At the place of their joining there is much visible disturbance. After due coursing they settle down into one. The initial troubles are inevitable and that should not be overlooked. The inter-racial marriages are truly brave decisions. The persons who decide upon it should be able to accept directly opposing currents and neutralize them. It requires great patience and tolerance.

The American continent is presently the experimental land upon which the admixture is experimented. It takes a few more centuries before all racial qualities find their equilibrium in the human kind.

5. The Electric Fire The Eye of Shiva 2



But when we become an adept of the 5th ray, then we have an eye opened, which is the higher bridge in us. You take the Ajna Centre as the basis, where you have the first bridge built. Then over the Ajna Centre, there is a point, where the third eye of the human being is there. Up to that point, we can evolve. That is what we call 'the higher bridge'. The centre which is called the 'eyebrow centre' and the centre on the forehead - the bridge is built between the two – then the third eye is said to be opened. When the third eye is opened, then the past, the presence and the future are known. The Plan is known. How it has worked out in the past, from the beginning, is totally known in details. And how it is planned for the future by the devas is also known in details. When you have already known to function as a soul, that means, if you have already become a soul-infused personality, then you are already tuned to the Plan. But the details are given from time to time. That means, a weekly time-table is given, you work for it, and then the next week's time-table is given. 'Week' in that sense means: a few cycles. Don't take week in the sense that Masters are giving only a program for seven days. It is much more than a week that is known. That is what is called 'knowing the Plan and working for it'. But when the third eye is opened, the total Plan is known in its details. And they try to work out according to the Plan of the Devas.

But there is another third eye in us, which is at this point (where the hair begins), which is not our eye. It is the Eye of Shiva in us. The Eye of Shiva in us is different from our third eye. Sometimes, He opens and looks at us. He opens and looks through us. It is like sending a thunder into our being. It is like a lightening arising out of the thunder. And in split second, it passes through the whole system only to make proper adjustments.

And the energy between our third eye and the Eye of Shiva, in between

this passage, contains the secrets of our slipping into sleep and awakening every morning. That is why Master Djwhal Khul suggests, i.e. orders us – all that Master Djwhal Khul suggested to the disciples are orders, you have no compromise with them, if you wish to grow in light. And if you don't grow in tune with the Plan, then the Father will come. So, let us better follow the suggestions given by the Master. Understand them as instructions and orders. That is why in Patanjali Yoga, the Master of Yoga, says: "Asa yoganus asanam", meaning 'Now the instructions of Yoga' – not suggestions for Yoga, they are all instructions. You have to follow them, if you really want to be a Yogi. You cannot fancy to be a Yogi without following the instructions.

Bharata Varsha 1

Parasara continued: "The area to the north of the ocean and to the south of Himalayas is called Bharatha Varsha. The generations living there are termed Bharatiyas. The area of the whole land is nine thousand yojanas. It is the land where live those who are on their way to liberation. There they have to discharge their duties before attaining liberation. Also those who are on the way to the heavenly pleasures have to discharge their pious duties there. Those who do good things for their results are bound to the heavenly pleasures that are exhaustible. Those who discharge their duties for nothing are on the way to liberation.

Seven great hills form the nodal points of the land. They are

- 1. Mahendragiri;
- 2. Malayagiri;
- 3. Sahya;
- 4. Sukthiman;
- 5. Riksha;
- 6. Vindhya and
- 7. Pariyatra.

From there is the way to heavenly pleasures and from there is the way to the grand liberation. From there some go into the animal kingdom and some go to hell. (Those who indulge in animal pleasures will inherit animal bodies. Those who inflict pain to others enter hell, the plane of suffering.) From there some go to heaven and some attain liberation. From there some live in the middle plane and some live in the bottom level of

consciousness. (Liberation is life that is not conditioned by birth, death or self-imposition. Heaven is the enjoyment of the fruits of good deeds. Middle plane is the human level of consciousness, in which the average human being lives his life. It is a chain of incidents and the equilibrium of the chain actions of cause and effect. The bottom level of consciousness is that which governs the biological and nuclear states of existence.)

To those who live and die in other regions of this globe, their Karma is not decided on this earth. (Karma is the infallible law that governs the chain actions of the earth planet. Beings born in regions other than Bharatha Varsha will not yet attain the continuity of consciousness which makes them understand the law of Karma. They may be intellectually and scientifically greater than the sons of Bharatha. Yet they do not know what is before and what is beyond the journey of their life. As they reach that point of evolution they are brought to Bharatha and take birth there. It is a geographical, geological and planetary truth which needs no discussion. Any doubt or discussion is the result of some psychological or inferiority complex. Just as the poles have their climate, just as the equator has its own climate, the geographical demarcations of the earth have their specifications in nature.)

The Two Techniques for Meditation 4

2. To link up the outer man with the inner man

The first technique is useful to some people, while the second technique is useful to some other people. The first technique is called 'head oriented technique'. The second technique is called 'heart oriented technique'. Each one can decide which is more convenient to him according to the soul quality. Some like the first process and some others like the second process.

These are the two ancient most practices that would cause alignment of the outer man with the inner man. For example, Buddha followed the first technique, Christ followed the second technique. Master C.V.V. followed the first technique, and Master E.K. followed the second technique. Sri Aurobindo followed the first technique, while the Mother followed the second technique.

As per the soul's inclination, you can try observing the thoughts and reach the light, which you are. Or you can follow the second technique and reach the source of light and experience light. In both cases, the final experience is the same. You have the gradual gaining of peace, inner poise and also the related cool effect. The earlier in life you gain it, the better it is, so that you meet the outer challenges with poise, and you will respond to the outer events with cool. Your energy is not agitated regardless the outer events.

That is the beauty of those who have accomplished meditation. They are aligned persons. Their outer is aligned with their inner, and as a consequence, the inner projects through the outer, and the inner being light, all projections would be projections of light. That's how the technique of meditation builds bridge between the mortal man and the immortal man and

through this technique many have gained immortality.

Their identity changes from their name, their status, their nationality to their original status. They no more believe that they are Spanish, German or Indians. They are not conditioned by the thought that they are male or female. They only have one understanding of them, that they are light and all is light. If people see other things, it is because they have projections.

That's how they live in light and they transact with light. They either live in light when they are subjective and they transact with light when they are in the objective. Hence, to them, life is joy. You see one of the statements of the invocation: "May we transact Light in terms of Joy." Krishnamacharya about different topics of spirituality.


