
Prayer of the Year 2020-2021



Many aspirants are emotional and claim that they have the presence of a 'Master of Wisdom', and that they have had the experience of the ashram of a Master. Whosoever makes such a claim cannot be believed. In fact, their claims have to be discounted and discarded. A disciple, who claims entry into the ashram of a Master, never speaks of such an entry. Only a transcended one can find an entry. Transmutation and transformation are but necessary for such transcendence. An aspirant must offer himself for immediate transmutation and transformation. One has to put oneself to the process of change. It is truly a chemical change that happens in one, when one follows implicitly the given regulations.

On Secret Doctrine

Maimonides, the Hebrew philosopher says "whoever shall find out the true sense of the Book of Genesis ought to take care not to divulge it."

This is a maxim that all sages practiced and repeated to their students. According to Maimonides, if one knows the true meaning of the work for six days, with utmost respect to the work he stays silent on the seventh day. Today, the work has lost its value. Work only means an activity for self-profit, covetousness and aggrandizement. Work is but karma, meaning action, which has to be carried out for the welfare of others. Today we call such work as work of goodwill - God knows how unselfish is the goodwill work these days carried out by many groups all over the globe. The symbology and esoterism of the Old Testament was thus confessed by one of the greatest Jewish philosophers, but the confessions with regard to the New Testament are a totally different drama where the blind guides the blind.

The mysteries of Jews were identical with those of the Greeks and the Egyptians who borrowed such mysteries from Chaldeans, who in turn got them from Aryans and Atlanteans and so on. Each one claims himself to be the origin of the mysteries while everyone borrowed from his preceding race. There is a statement in the Vedas which says, "He got it from his father, he got it from his father and he got it from his father" which means that the wisdom was passed on from the preceding generation to the succeeding generation in utmost confidence and trust in the succeeding generation. In this context, it is foolish that any school of thought or religion claims that they are the original. There is only one original manuscript of which there are many copies in existence. A copy claiming to be original is blasphemy.

When the urge to know the hidden sense of things and of writings is missing, what remains is but false claims and one-upmanship. There are millions of such idiots found in our age of enlightenment; they deny their past, they deny their

moorings and they even go to the extent of saying that they are unborn of any female yoni and so on and so forth. Curse is on such bi-gods who deny their parentage. This is on account of the wise of kali age where acknowledgement is not given. Its due place and gratitude is a forgotten faculty. Let esotericism be approached afresh by a true seeker by turning inward where he would eventually find the teachers that eternally exist and teach.

The Dawn in Capricorn 1

The raising of man involves Capricorn also. Capricorn is the sun-sign at the beginning of which there is the increasing day and the receding night. The 22nd of December is the longest night, after that, the night reduces and the day increases. Capricorn is called 'the dawn of the year'. Aries is called 'the noon of the year'. 'The evening of the year' is Cancer, because in Cancer the night starts to increase and the day reduces. The 22nd of June is the longest day, and 22nd of December is the longest night in the year. From the longest day on 22nd of June, there is the reduction of the day and growth of night till 22nd of December. From 22nd of December again it is more day and less night till we reach 22nd of June. These are the two arches of a solar year. The beginning of the arch is in Capricorn, which is the dawn of the year, followed by Aries, which is the mid-noon, then by Cancer, which is the dusk, and then by Libra/ Scorpio, which is the midnight of the year. That is how we have the four aspects of the year.

Man is liberated from the cycle of birth and death in Capricorn under the rulership of Saturn. Cancer brings man down to Earth, where he has to face trials, tribulations and learns the lessons of Saturn in the lower levels. In Capricorn, man is bestowed with consciousness having its centre as the Hierarchy. Jesus Christ rose to that level and played His role as Saviour under the highest influence of Saturn.

Glamour and Illusion 3

The glamour of aspiration is seen in those who aspire to spiritual goals without moving towards them. The glamour of self-assurance conditions those who believe that their point of view is entirely right. The glamour of duty leads to an over-emphasis of the sense of responsibility. The glamour of environing conditions leads to a sense of frustration, or of futility, or of importance. The glamour of desire leads to a constant condition of turmoil, negating all peace. The glamour of sentiment brings about a lengthy imprisonment and imposes obligations that do not exist. Those glamoured by the mind believe in its capacity to deal with any and every problem. Those glamoured by devotion see only one idea, one person, one authority and one aspect of truth.

Other common glamours are the glamour of physical strength, of personal magnetism, of popularity, of being busy, of creative work without true motive, of warfare, of musical perceptions, of knowledge, of superiority, of organization, of creeds, of fanaticism, of the physical body, of sex, of the mysterious and the secret. Fear is the most fruitful source of glamour. It is the seed of the glamour of depression, of self-pity, or suspicion, of criticism and undue analysis. There is the glamour of independence, of the family, of ties and relationships, of dominance or control over others. In the glamour of spirituality, we have spiritual ambition and spiritual service, selfishly expressed, self-centred, aggressive and assertive.

The Formless One

The Master consciousness is formless, but it functions through form. The formless one functions through the formations. For example, one cannot see what electricity is. But one can feel its existence through an electrical instrument. Likewise, one cannot see the basis of sounds that one produces, only sounds are perceived with oneself as the basis. He is the unuttered sound upon which sounds happen. He is the musical instrument upon which the music is produced. Similarly he is the background light on the basis of which all is seen. The seer cannot see the basis of the seen, for he constitutes the basis. One can see the Sun, the Moon, the Fire, but the basis of the illumination of Sun, Moon and Fire cannot be seen. A Teacher is one who realizes that verily he is THAT and THAT is the basis for the manifestation of light and sound. Another example is the thought of I AM which one feels in the awakened state. But the basis of such an awakening is not seen. It can be only realized that one is the basis of all that is and that one is the ONE. When the ONE expresses, the varieties are the parts of the ONE. It is an age-old statement that the part can never comprehend the whole while the whole can comprehend the part. This thought process is brain-teasing, but the one who realizes is the ONE. He feels "THAT exists as I AM". THAT is undefinable. It is formless, colourless, soundless and is beyond all comprehensions. It is for this reason a student would do well to adopt to the instructions coming from the Teacher than try to comprehend the Teacher, for THAT is beyond all comprehensions.

One can be a channel to THAT like a flute, like a hollow bamboo stick, which produces a variety of music. A Master of wisdom is one who is like a flute. In him only THAT flows. But once he is the flute, he tends to miss that which is flowing through the flute. In every Master it is the Master consciousness that flows and his form is a flute. Generally, students identify with the form of the flute which is the basis for flute music, but the Master that functions through the flute is the formless one functioning through the form.

There is always a question, "Is it the instrument or is it the invisible one that functions through the instrument, which is more important?" The answer found is that it is both. That is the synthesis relating to a Master whose form is respected and whose energy is experienced.

Very early in the morning I recollect the holy sandals of the Master in the inner chamber of my heart.






Sound

The Double Triangle 3

In so far as we know how to work with the Throat Centre, we are in a position to link up the Higher with the Lower, to link up the unknown with the known and to link up that which is imperceptible with that which is perceptible.

Linking up that which is called "Noumenon" and that which is called "Phenomenon" and remaining in the centre, we can experience both the aspects. The Scriptures say that the Noumenon is the Father, the Phenomenon is the Mother and you are the Son or the Soul. In any way there are three parts: that which is perceptible, that which is not perceptible and you, who are there to experience both. Basically, the double triangle as it is presented in the Theosophical symbol, speaks of this aspect.

The Higher Triplicity is located in the body, and the middle point is the sound; hence, sound is the most important thing for anyone who would like to understand the complete truth. Sound stands between material and spirit. In so far as one works out this key in life, he will have the facility to move into the kingdom of heaven and the kingdom of earth, or that which is above and that which is below.

The consciousness of man exists as a spark. It is a spark in terms of light, and a point in terms of geometry. It is a point not in space but in mind. On the background of mind this point always exists and whenever we exist this point is located in the mind. Even in the absence of mind (during sleep or death) this point exists in us, but to the ordinary consciousness, it can only be located as geometrical centre of the mind. Whichever part of the physical body is active, this point exists there. Then the local activity is nullified by submitting the mind to the Master. The spark ceases to exist locally and retraces its relatively original position called the heart.

Meditation is a process of spending time existing in this spark as consciousness without mind. The process of meditation elongates the spark into a vertical line. (The point becomes a straight line by a series of repetitions of the point). In the beginning when the mind is active, the student has to locate this vertical line within his own vertebral column. Even in the development of embryo, the vertebral column descends as a line of consciousness and all the sheaths are materialised around it. Through the process of meditation when the mind merges in the vertical line of consciousness the objective world is gradually absorbed into it. The objective world exists as long as the mind exists. The merging of mind makes the objective consciousness merge and also the space globe around us merge into subjectivity.

Space and Time are the co-ordinates on the squared-paper of mind. They are nothing but the projections of mind on the background of All- Consciousness. The All-Consciousness is the pool of experience which is infinity to itself and a globe around any point within itself. Wherever and whenever this point manifests as consciousness, the globe exists around it as a space globe. This globe rotates as the consciousness moves within itself. This rotation causes the

cycles which we call Time.

The time cycle exists as a circle around the observer and hence it is measured on the circumference formed by the Sun's path of daily motion by the beings on this earth. Thus, time exists along the path and conveniently divided into 24 equal parts called hours. Hours exist to our mind according to the position of Sun in the sky, though they operate in us as our thoughts, expressions and actions. When the spark of consciousness is traced as a vertical line, the time divides the diurnal ring into two semi-circles.

As long as the mind exists the sense of time and sense of space operate in us, as two diameters of circle crossing one another at centre in perpendiculars. Thus, the sense of space and time exists in our mind as cross within the circle. The horizontal line indicates space and the vertical line reads time. When mind begins to rotate through 90° and finally merges in the vertical line, then the sense of time and hours of division go to a sense of simultaneity. The sprouting of a plant, the elongation of the roots and shoots, the emerging of leaves, buds, blooms, fruits and seeds take a chronological order in the future, but in the totality of existence of the tree, all these incidents exist in simultaneity. Such a state can be experienced only when mind merges in consciousness.

At this stage all the hours of rotation come into central vertical axis and arrange themselves as the external principles of the periodic units of time. The units are periodical but their principles are eternal. When man merges in principles, the state is "AXIS ARRANGED HOURS".

Answer: Dear friend,


- Know that money is tainted by greed, by jealousy and by material desire.

Vishnu Purana Chapter XXVII

Position and Magnitude of the Sun and other Planetary Bodies 3

Since the Earth tilts sidewise twice in the year, the northward and southward journeys of the Sun are created. The beginning of the northward journey is the beginning of the zodiacal sign Makara (Capricorn). Then it enters the signs of Kumbha (Aquarius) and Meena (Pisces). After it goes through these three signs it enters the speed of Vishuvath, the vernal equinox, when night and day are equal. Then the night begins to decrease and the day to increase. After leaving Mithuna (Gemini), it appears in Karkataka (Cancer) and starts its southern path. Just as the potter's wheel is again and again accelerated by the potter, so also the Sun's speed is increased when it enters Karkataka. Then day is converted into night. The night of the day of the Devas which we call the year begins in Karkataka. Hence the sign Karkataka marks the sunset of the Devas. From that point nights begin to increase. Since time passes easily during those days, the duration of the whole day is a little bit less than the normal day. During its southern journey, the Sun gains time by 12 subdivisions of a Muhurtha. From sunrise to sunset it covers 13 ½ Nakshatras and from sunset to sunrise another 13 ½ Nakshatras. During the northern journey, the Sun appears to pass slowly. Hence it takes a bit longer than the normal time. At the highest point of the northern journey, it takes 18 Muhurthas to complete the journey between sunrise and sunset. The same measures as above are reversed during the southern journey. The centre of the potter's wheel is the same which we call the axis of the poles of our Earth. Towards the two extremities of the northern and southern tilts we find the duration of the day and night more and less long respectively, due to the speedy and slow apparent movement of the Sun. As the day decreases, the length of the night is speedy. As the night duration increases, the movement of the duration is slower. Of course, the real speed of the Sun is the same always, but it seems to vary due to the tilts of the Earth.

On the whole, the Sun witnesses all 12 signs during one unit day. Since the signs are only 6 during the night and 6 during the day, and since the duration of night and day are unequal, the signs have different lengths as seen from the Earth. Some signs prove longer and some prove shorter due to this phenomenon. The duration of each sign during night or day is experienced as unequal due to this fact. During the northern journey the night signs go speedy and the day signs go slowly. During the southern journey it is reversed. The night ends with Usha and the day ends with Vyushti. The midpoints of Usha and Vyushti are called Sandhyas. The duration of Sandhya belongs to the Rudras and it is really fierce (for those who take delight in copulation).

"Do you sleep well?" is the fundamental question that the physicians of the past enquired. The depth of sickness is known by the quality of the sleep. The physicians try to correct the state of sleeplessness for they know that the sleep is rest. It is no doubt rest for the dense body. 2. Young and Wise



Picture to the Month of Gemini Gemini - Gateway between Unity and Separation




