




Thus, from the Word, life and awareness emerge and from life and awareness the letters and words are uttered forth. Exhalation as the basis, awareness utters forth the sounds of thought as per the language used. So, utterances of speeches should be seen as combined activity of Light and Life. Good utterances improve the ability of Light and Life. Inferior utterances, likewise, destroy the Light and Life in us.

Such is the power of the flow of sound. We need to understand the symbolism relating to the saw. It extends from the throat up to the lips. The saw of the sound cuts the exhalation to produce the necessary sounds. We know the saw as it cuts a log of wood, enabling the log to take shapes. The Sacred Word emerges from within. It is the 'humming soundless sound' inside, which is an Eternal Presence in us. It externalises through pulsation and further conducts the activity of respiration.



# Ashram Regulations for Entry

Similarly associating the mind with exhalation one comes out. Once again associating with inhalation one can move in. Man's awareness is in mind and the awareness now in this practice moves in along with inhalation and moves out along with exhalation. When this practice of associating the awareness with respiration is carried out with certain regularity the awareness develops inquisitiveness to know the basis of respiration. This is the prelude to pranayama. This should not be confused with pranayama. Pranayama is the result of such practice which will be explained later.

Initially an aspirant who intends to enter into one's inner dwelling shall have to apply one's mind upon one's respiration. This, one should do at the same instance of time daily. One is recommended to do it for the same duration, which can be progressively increased. Initially it can be for 24 minutes, which may gradually extend to 48 minutes and finally to 72 minutes.

### On Secret Doctrine

#### Manyantara - Part II



Manu is the head of each Kalpa (eon), which consists of fourteen Manvantaras. Each Manvantara lasts for the lifetime of a Manu and hence there are 14 different Manus.

The seven Manus creates  $7 \times 7$  Manus. There are 49 root-races on the seven planets during each round, then every root-race has its Manu. The present seventh Manu is called 'Vaivasvata' and stands in the exoteric texts for that Manu, who represents in India, the Babylonian Xisuthrus and the Jewish Noah. But in the esoteric books we are told, Manu Vaivasvata, the progenitor of our fifth race who saved it from the flood that nearly exterminated the fourth race of Atlantis, is not the seventh Manu, mentioned in the nomenclature of the Root, or primitive-Manus, but one of the 49 Manus emanated from this Root-Manu.

"Vaivasvata", thus, though seventh in the order given, is the primitive Root-Manu of our fourth Human Wave (the reader must always remember that Manu is not a man but collective humanity), while our Vaivasvata was but one of the seven Minor Manus, who are made to preside over the seven races of this our planet. Each of these has to become the witness to one of the periodic and ever recurring cataclysms (by fire and water) that close the cycle of every Root-race. And it is this Vaivasvata, the Hindu ideal embodiment, called respectively Xisuthrus, Deukalion, Noah and by other names, who is the allegorical man who rescued our race, when nearly the whole population of one hemisphere perished by water, while the other hemisphere was awakening from its temporary obscuration.

Each Manvantara is created and ruled by a specific Manu, who in turn is created by Brahmâ, the Creator himself. Manu creates the world, and all its species during that period of time, each Manvantara lasting the lifetime of a Manu, upon whose death, Brahma creates another Manu to continue the cycle of Creation.

Eventually it takes 14 Manus and their respective Manvantaras to create a Kalpa or a Day of Brahmâ. Thereafter, at the end of each Kalpa, there is a period of dissolution or Pralaya wherein the world (earth and all life forms, but not the entire universe itself) is destroyed and lies in a state of rest.<sup>1</sup>


## Saturn

# Introduction to Srimad Bhagavatham




Srimad Bhagavatha is the ultimate of the Vedic wisdom and for this yuga, the Vedic wisdom is once again given out in the simplest way by the grandest of the seers who is no other than Vishnurupa (embodiment of Vishnu) and who has been a very high soul. He systematised the Vedic knowledge, classified the Vedas and hence is called Vedavyasa.

His original name is Krishna Dvaipayana. He is one of the three Krishnas or one Krishna in three bodies. They are:

- Lord Krishna himself,
- the seer, Krishna Dvaipayana and
- Krishna as the power and beauty of the time, Draupadi.

Mahabharata describes three Krishnas. One is the Lord and another is a dimension of the Lord as the seer and yet another, a dimension of the Lord as beauty and power.

Vedavyasa must be remembered whenever we think of Vedic knowledge be it Vedas, Vedangas, Brahmasutras or Puranas, Mahabharatha, Bhagavad Gita and ultimately Srimad Bhagavatha.




# The mantra relating to Narayana



The mantra relating to Narayana can be meditated upon in the four higher centres in the order in which the sounds are from sahasrara via ajna, throat (visuddhi) to heart (anahata) and can also be meditated in the reverse order from heart to sahasrara which is depicted as under.



Either way, it is Narayana. Contemplate the sound in the four centres visualizing the colour blue. The other way to practice the mantra is in its eightfold aspect, namely 'OM Namo Narayanaya'. When one does so, he may utter OM from above downwards and utter forth the rest of the letters in the seven centres. Similarly one may utter the sound AUM from below upwards and utter forth the seven sounds.



# Rudra The Lord of Cosmic Will and Vibration

A Few Dimensions of Rudra 44 Ugra

Ugra means anger like fire. Rudra's emergence was a fiery expression from the Noumenon (Absolute) through the brow centre of the Creator. In the initial stages of creation when the Creator desired support of the Kumaras for creation, they did not cooperate. Their non-cooperation carried a profound divine purpose, which the Creator could not understand himself. As a result, the Creator was angry for a while. From out of this anger, through the brow centre of the Creator, Rudra emerged from the Absolute. His emergence was not willed by the Creator. The will of fire emerged itself through the Creator, which was in accordance with the higher plan. The Creator Himself was bewildered at the emergence of the Cosmic Will through him, which was fiery. This fiery emergence is called Ugra.

## Proximity to the Teacher 5



The period during which the student stays in the proximity of a Teacher is called the period of internship. During this period the student is within the aura of the Teacher. Seventh Ray and Magic

7 Rays - The Path of Ascent to Super-Natural

7th Ray functioning helps the aspirant working with 6th Ray to focus on manifestation of work on the physical plane which is the 7th plane. It drives the aspirant towards good will at work. As the aspirant is drawn out to service, he dwells in the emotional plane lesser. As the aspirant starts working with 7th Ray, he will, as well, draw the cooperation of 1st Ray in the manner explained in the previous articles. In doing so, the aspirant surpasses the limitations of emotions and sentiments of 6th Ray.

Similarly, when the aspirant works out his path of ascent with 5th Ray. He needs the support of 3rd Ray - Intelligence. To avoid the pitfalls of concrete thoughts and concepts of 5th Ray and getting stuck with them, the aspirant needs to apply the knowledge and express into goodwill work. Only with 7th Ray systematised and rhythmic functioning, the aspirant gets rounded up and gets released from the limitations of 5th Ray through experience.



## Sreeman Ekkirala Ananthacharya 1



Sreeman Ekkirala Ananthacharya was a Vedic scholar, most sought after during his times in the composite Andhra state. He was thorough with Veda and hence with Sanskrit. He was also a practitioner of Ayurveda and a teacher of Sanskrit and Veda. He has written a good number of books such as 'Vision of Aryan Glory', 'Rasayana and Ayurveda', 'Uttarameemamsa', 'Suparna Sukta' and so on. He was born in the year 1897 and passed away in 1979.

Sree Ananthacharya was an embodiment of Vedic wisdom, Ayurvedic practices and Ashtanga Yoga (Eightfold path of Yoga). He treated many complex sicknesses with a combination of Yoga and Ayurveda. He treated many sick ones to recovery from extreme illnesses and in some cases, even from death. A classic example was his own son Sree Ekkirala Krishnamacharya.

When Ekkirala Krishnamacharya was affected by a poisonous fever and was almost about to die, he arranged to procure fresh poison from a cobra. He set two drops of fresh poison on the tip of the tongue, of his son. In a matter of few minutes, the patient regained consciousness and slowly gained the vitality to live.

## Thinking Far Ahead 6



The God-fearing nature is of ignorance. "If we don't pray a form and a name of the God, great evil will fall upon us", is a great act of black magic. The science relating to God, the science relating to the formation of the Cosmos, the science relating to the formation of man, as to what life is, what consciousness is, how consciousness works through brain, how respiration works, what happens at the point of death - these are all now subjects of great scientific interest. It is what is now called the investigation into NDE, 'Near Death Experience'. The doctors are working on it. They are enquiring into patients who have almost died but have come back. What happens to the metabolism during such time is being observed. How consciousness functions and how prana works is the subject of research. Stanza I - 2

- 4. Past, present and future exist on a background which is the eternal presence of the Lord. Even to us also they exist to the mind and they do not exist to the consciousness. Time and states of matter are only the projections of the outer layers of existence. The inner layers form the body of the Lord who is eternal. Hence the Lord is to be meditated upon as the three-headed one in this aspect. What we call past is only our impression of the past, same thing with the other two. Meditating these things as the Lord will remove our impression and lead us to His existence.
- 5. The second stage of creation is the process of objectifying a part of Himself, as an object to create. At this stage the Lord descends as the creator. On his own background He works as the Creator of His own creation. The Lord as the background is called the Father (Narayana). The creator who descends from Him is called the Son (Brahma, the four-faced). The object of creation is called the Word after the commencement of the utterance (Saraswathi). This Brahma is the maker of beings.
- 6. Then the Lord also descends as the maintenance of the created beings. This is the form of food to every living being. The Lord is attracted as food and is eaten by everyone as His own food. In fact, He is not eaten but He eats every living being into His fold of existence by the power of metabolism.

Patient reorganising himself is nothing but healthier reorganisation of his thought and emotion. This is the subtlest method of healing that is the ultimate objective of all healing work. When healing is done through supplementing pranic energy without effecting cleansing of the astral, the effect of such healing is temporary. It does not deal with the cause of sickness of the patient. The second method of healing suggested above does not give a lasting cure until the patient generates will for self cleansing with the help of teaching come from the healer. In the second method the healer is as well cleansing the astral energy with his clear mental force. Until and unless the patient himself generates the will to clean himself astrally he continues to produce the related sicknesses. It is therefore desired that the third method be employed where a kindled soul kindles the soul of a patient and patient cooperates not only to receive pranic energy but also wills to clean himself. As much the cleansing happens by self will so much the pranic force establishes and health gets restored.

For healing work, functioning of the pranic energy and astral energy need to be properly comprehended and the healer has to upgrade himself eventually to function as a soul. He should transform from the state of an average good thinker to that of a student of occult healing and finally to that state of mastery namely, functioning as a soul with a clear crystal like personality.

## Kagemusha - The Shadow of the Warrior 4: Obstacles 2

A man of low birth has to play the role of a Prince. He is taught by servants how to behave. Kagemusha, how he is told according to his role, is deeply affected to Takemaru, the grandson of the prince. The relationship to the 6-year-old child relaxes and enables him to learn easily. "Why is grandfather called the mountain?", the child asks. The servant answers instead of the ignorant "grandfather".

"A mountain is seen by everyone. It gives orientation at every observation point. It guides the clouds and the people, who look up to the mountain. It protects the life around, so that everyone can do his work. In stormy times, the mountain remains unshakeable. Its presence fills people with trust and confidence. The mountain has nothing to do, but just to be there. Therefore, grandfather is like a mountain and the motto of the Takeda Clan is: A mountain does not move.

In the meantime, the enemies of the Takeda-Clan noticed that something had changed. Dreaded attacks and tricks did not happen. This was not the character of prince Shingen. What about the scene at the sea-side, the spies had watched? Had it been the burial of the prince instead of a sacrificial ritual, the Takeda-Clan claimed? They decided to make a test by spontaneously attacking a fortress of Shingen. The reaction would show, if he was alive or dead.

The nobles of the high council discussed how to handle this provocation. The war council of the allies were called to make a decision. This assembly required the presence of the prince. So Kagemusha, shadow of prince Shingen, had to be presented to the Council. Nabukado, the prince's brother, instructed Kagemusha what to do: Nothing at all. His task was to confirm the decision of the assembly by a sovereign nod - nothing more, nothing less. That way, the change would not be noticed.

The council of war was coming to an end, everything went well, the assembly was ready to address prince Shingen to accept their decision. But the son of the prince, Katsuory, intervened. He hated Kagemusha, because he had to bow down to a man of low origin and play a respectful son to him. He turned to Kagemusha, the shadow, and with the intention to pull off his mask he openly asked the opinion of his "father". Nabukado and the men of the High Council froze with fear and got icy faces. Everyone looked at Kagemusha. But he responded the provocation by stroking his beard thoughtfully and, in accordance to the meaning of his role to play and to the wish of the deceased prince, he said: "A mountain does not move." That was the decision. The assembly decided to ignore the provocation.

The members of the High Council were satisfied: the plan of keeping secrecy to the death of Prince Shingen appeared to be possible with the help of Kagesmusha. Since Katsuory's intention had failed, he hardly could retrain his anger.

# Picture to the Month Leo - The Jewel in the Lotus




