

Each one of them was given a coconut and was told to break the coconut at a place, where no one is.

The students took up the coconut and went away into the forest at once. They ensured that there were no humans, animals or even birds.

They broke the coconut and returned to the teacher. The teacher saw the students on their return. He found that one was missing. He waited till the evening for the missing one to return; but he did not return. The next day the teacher had to go in search of the missing student. He searched for the student the whole day. He searched the next day in far off places. He even searched on the third day. He did not find the student. The teacher was in great anxiety regarding the whereabouts of the student. A week days after, the student returned to the teacher fully exhausted. He was with his unbroken coconut. The teacher was delighted at first to see the student back and was further delighted to see the unbroken coconut in his hands. He enquired as to what happened and the student explained as under:

"I went away into the forest. No doubt, there were no humans in the forest, but there were animals and birds in the forest. I went beyond the forest to avoid them. #### The Value of Silence



From the very day when the first mystic taught by the first instructor of divine dynasties of early races, the means of communication was between this world and the invisible world. The teaching was from the spheres of pure spirit to the sphere of matter. The mysterious science was thus taught in silence and through silence. Those who could listen to silence could receive the communication in silence and spoke such silence in symbols and allegories. An abuse of such teaching can lead mankind to speedy destruction. One cannot make available explosive substances to a group of children and also give them the matches.

The first divine instructor initiated but a select few and they kept silence with the multitudes. They recognized the God within. Each adept felt the great SELF within oneself who is called by such names as Ishvara, the Atman, the Mighty Lord etc. Once a man knew Him within oneself, he tended to be humble and still small in voice.

From the very initial and primitive days of man described by the first Vedic poet down to our modern age, there has not been a philosopher worthy of that name who did not carry in the silent sanctuary of his heart the grand and mysterious Truth. All sacred sciences were learnt within in the silent sanctuary of heart. "O Man know thyself" has been the commandment of every true philosopher who succeeded in recognizing the god within. But today's priest dances to the tunes of the public opinion for he cares for worldly recognition and not for inner revelation.

The Upward & Downward Path of Waters 3



There is another understanding through the application of the Fixed Cross where the journey is from Taurus to Scorpio and Leo to Aquarius, where the 0° of the 4 sun-signs form the cardinal points. This understanding is specially useful to the students on the Path to Discipleship.

Likewise, there is also the third fourfold division called the Mutable Cross, with the sun-signs Sagittarius, Gemini, Virgo and Pisces, where the Path of Discipleship is tread through the understanding of mutability.

The sound potency for 'the upward path of waters' is called NA. The sound potency by which the Spirit becomes matter is called RA. RA is the sound potency relating to fire, which transforms matter into Spirit and Spirit into matter. 'The path of waters' is called AYANA.

NARA + AYANA = NARAYANA

Narayana is the name of the Cosmic Lord who conducts not only the upward and downward cycles on the planet, but also of the solar system and the created beings. We have a time up to which we grow in matter, that is, from the time of birth up to a point in life, we improve our bodily volume. After a point, the volume is slowly reduced. There is a peak point after which there is no more growth of the body, then slowly it recedes and decays. Thus, there is the expansion and the contraction. There is the increase and the decrease. There is the growth and the decay. Like that, all is arranged in a twofold manner, and so is the case with the human being also. We have the four cardinal points, we have our own morning hour, noon, evening and midnight hour, as childhood, youth, manhood and old age. These are the four stages.

The Qualities of Sound Mind (From the Laws of Right Relationship)

#### Faults 1

The personality of man is saturated with vices - human, animal and lower than animal. He is a slave to appetite, passion and ambition, is critical, separative, selfish and aggressive; he exhibits obsession, hatred and malice, ingratitude, cowardice and treachery. Everyone is still imperfect and has character defects, unconquered weaknesses, faults, limitations, points of darkness, and much inertia. At the same time, we are very pleased and satisfied with ourselves. The tendency to self-defence is strong and this produces an unwillingness to recognize unpalatable truths regarding our faults. In this tendency there lies real danger, for it can prove our undoing. The smallest weakness gives insecurity and often ruins a life. Many an unrealized weakness is regarded as strength and a virtue. The quality we believe we possess proves non-existent when put to a test.

It is seldom that our personality equipment is of a balanced nature. It has in it certain deficiencies or lacks, and over-accentuated traits. One man is too mental, another is too emotional, and a third is primarily physical. One person is strictly material in his outlook on life while another is visionary and free from the sins of the flesh. The diversities are innumerable. The truths of self-analysis are seldom definitely formulated or faced by any. A study of our usual point of daily focus will lead to recognition of inherent trends and limitations. We should attain consciousness of our handicaps, for the man who knows his weaknesses is on guard against himself. The earnest student can tabulate the forces, which he feels control his life and thus arrive at a reasonable and truthful understanding of the forces, which require to be subordinated, and those which require to be strengthened.

The Teacher is mono-sound, mono-colour and mono-syllabled



The sound is OM, the colour is blue and the syllable is again OM.

The Teacher is one who stabilizes himself in immutability. He may take to different colours, sounds and forms, but basically he remains stable and immutable with one colour, sound and syllable.

Paratatva or Gurutatva is existing as one colour, one sound and one syllable. The one sound OM manifests as (A, U, Ma) three, and conducts the Will and permeates and manifests. These are the three aspects of one sound. Essentially the Teacher is blue; when he manifests Will he becomes red. When he conducts Intelligent Activity he becomes golden yellow. The three sounds are but one sound, the three colours are but one colour. The three syllables are but one syllable. He exists as OM in the heart of the beings and is available for contact for every student who ardently enters into the heart and waits there to receive the Master.

The Master seems to be mutable, all his mutabilities relating to sound, colour and form are deeply based on the immutability. He is the stable one who does not totter. This quality of the Teacher enables the student also to gain the state of stability which is the basis for all experiences. Only from the standpoint of BEING, becoming can be experienced. The one who is afloat, experiences the currents of water better than the one who is immersed. The Teacher has such stability and he imparts such stability.

## Sound Subjective and Sound Objective 3

The Head Centre, the Ajna Centre and the Heart Centre are the sources through which the positive sounds manifest. The sounds which we know and the sounds which we produce are from the lower centres; that is, our Base Centre, Sacral Centre and Solar Plexus. Whenever we speak about our viewpoints it is through our Solar Plexus, whenever we speak out our emotions it is through our Sacral Centre and whenever we express our base desires of life it is through our Base Centre.

There is the production of sound from the higher centres, which is positive, and there is the production of sound from the lower centres, which is negative. There are three higher centres and three lower centres in us. The Throat Centre connects that which is higher and that which is lower. Sound which is positive as well as sound that is negative are produced through the Throat Centre.

The Throat Centre holds the balance between the higher and the lower centres of sound. It is for this reason it is said in the Scriptures that a person who masters the Throat Centre is the disciple. It means that he is equidistant to the higher and the lower centres of sound. He makes an excellent work of bringing down the higher sounds to be uttered forth through the lower.


Question: Dear Master, is Britain right in exiting from European Union?

#### The Wisdom of Nakshatras

## Star 18: Jyeshta



Jyeshtha is also known as the "constellation of Governance". Jyeshtha means big, elderly, protective, authoritative and senior. This is the eighteenth constellation and is the last of the second set of nine constellations. Scorpio concludes with it. While Anuradha is the head of the scorpion, Jyeshtha represents the posterior part of the scorpion, where

the tail is. There can be an unforeseen sting. The cosmic deity of this constellation is Indra (Neptune), the celestial king, who governs the creation and who is also known to be manipulative and even deceitful at times. Yet, the natives of Jyeshtha are excellent administrators, governors, able, capable, and unwilling to lose command over a situation. Natives of Jyeshtha carry the psyche, "I know better than others." They are oriented towards material success, material pleasures and care for dominance.

The planetary ruler of this constellation is Mercury. The Neptune-Mercury combination is a double-edged weapon that can cut either way. To achieve the desired purposes, the natives of Jyeshtha can lie subtly which cannot be cognized by others. Never confide or share a secret with natives of Jyeshtha, they are not reliable in holding secrets. Yet, the abilities of Jyeshtha surpass many. They attain high positions, they enjoy high authority, and they are protective of those who submit themselves to them. They enjoy fanfare and following. They are indulgent personalities. Passion of the world runs high with them. If they can control their desire, they can do greatest good and also cause much transformation in themselves and around them. They are enthusiastic, exuberant, heroic and are fearless. They thrive well in difficult situations.

The ruling deity of the constellation is Lord Vishnu, who is also called Upendra. Worshipping Vishnu would enable warding off the negative qualities of Jyeshtha and sets the natives of Jyeshtha to be effective personalities for enforcement of law and order. The planet Mercury also relates to Lord Vishnu.

Vishnu protects yagna, meaning the activity of goodwill. Natives of Jyeshta would do well to associate with rituals and activities of welfare. The animal is the male deer, and the tree is the cotton tree. The bird is the brahminy duck (ruddy shelduck).



Though highly placed and full of authority, the natives of Jyeshtha always remain sober. They do not indulge in praising themselves, but would like others to praise them. They are open-minded and yet they can be stubborn and short tempered. This quality lands them into difficulties.

The body part relating to Jyeshtha is the lower abdominal region; the natives of Jyeshtha may have attacks of cold, dysentery, frequent fevers and problems relating to the prostate gland.

For the natives of Jyeshtha it is important to maintain a glorious image in the society. They do all they can to impress others and maintain the respect of other people. They are able persons and easily command respect from the surroundings. In their effort to maintain their image, they may strain themselves in useless and frivolous activity. They are forerunners in the society and mature quickly, both physically and mentally. They have a well-proportioned body and try to keep their body posture in admirable state. The best feature of their physic is their penetrating eyes.

While they are resolvers of social issues and governors of high quality, they see their personal woes larger than normal.

The weaknesses of Jyeshtha natives are sudden anger, depression, selfishness and infidelity. To ward off the weaknesses, they are recommended to worship Lord Vishnu on a regular basis. Their lucky number is 18 or 9, which are magical. It is pertinent to note that eighteen are the chapters of Bhagavad Gita, eighteen are the cantos of Mahabharata, eighteen were the heroes that participated in the Mahabharata war, eighteen were the days of war in Mahabharata. Eighteen represents the three-fourth of the universe which is imperceptible and divine. Their favourable number is 5. The colour is cream, and the stone is emerald.

The natives of Jyeshtha are good governors, proactive talkers, outspoken, winning in argument, first to arrive, assertive, tolerant of ambiguity, exhibit supremacy, self-reliance, jealous, creative genius, dramatical, influential in

a congregation, not very strong in morals, have good physical stamina, have vulnerability for drinks and drugs, superficially religious, greatly influenced by life partner and a dragon in the public and a duck at home.

To sum-up, the native of Jyeshta represents Indra in the Puranas. Many are his stories of nobility and the contrary.

## Introduction to Uranus 3

Uranus is a principle that is interpenetrating. There is nothing that is not permeable for the energy of Uranus. It can go deep down. It can go even in the darkest corners and bestow light over there. The penetration of Uranus is unparalleled. There is no place which it cannot reach. The gap between 0 and 1, the gap between negative zero and positive zero is filled by the energy of Varuna. It is that gap which bridges the knowledge between invisible and visible. Wherever there is a gap, the seeming vacuum is filled by Varuna consciousness and he works with the manifestations of root-matter into various states of matter up to the dense matter. The alchemy of creation is the work of the Matter. Spirit continues to cooperate at every level. Transmutation of Matter is the main emphasis in the Aquarian Age, and the agent who conducts such transmutation is Varuna. The supra-cosmic principle Varuna is known as Uranus in the solar plane. Only due to the impact of Varuna there is the breaking of the atom and the unfoldment of a vista of knowledge which was foreign to us in the nineteenth century.

Paracelsus Health and Healing

Food and Rhythm

"Disease that can be treated by diet should not be treated by any other means" is a famous saying by Maimonides. This is the age-old principle contained in Ayurveda as well. The Purana Srimad Bhagavata also speaks of it, in its sixth canto. The civilized man of today lost the science and the art of eating. His habits of eating are not wholesome and not even healthy.

Most of the sicknesses emerge from lack of knowledge relating to food intake, work rhythms and sleep rhythms. Work, food and sleep is the basic triangle that has to be set up from man's methodic functioning. Indiscrete, long hours of work, irregular sleep and inattentiveness to food have become major sources of sickness in the modern world.

To be a workaholic is not a virtue, it is as bad as gluttony and unrhythmic sleeping. A modern man walks away from natural rhythms and thereby lands in disease. Each man should be educated to review his/her own rhythms in relation to the three, namely work, food and rest.

Healthy food by itself is not enough unless the other rhythms are also set. One has to look for a balance between work, food and rest. There has to be daily rhythm, weekly, fortnightly, monthly and quarterly rhythms as well. In a week of seven days humanity is accustomed to have one day off weekly. The weekly off is from the regular work, there should also be a weekly off from regular food. The ancient Indians believed in weekly fasting to rest the digestive system. A day is marked to abstain from food and live on clean water. It is like weekly a servicing of the vehicle. The water cleanses and rejuvenates the system for the next week to come. Associating fasting with religion is not what is being said here. Just a weekly off from the eating activity and living by pure water this cleanses the system according to Ayurveda. There is also a monthly off from sleep to set the new rhythm and new chemistry to the body which is

done a day before the new moon.

Thus, Ayurveda speaks of a periodical break in the rhythms for a fresh beginning, assuming that the rhythms are set. In yoga the seer Patanjali also speaks of a weekly off from all practices for a fresh beginning.

These dimensions shall have to be studied for their efficacy and the hidden science behind. They should be re-introduced sensibly by the physicians to ensure better health.

When food can cure sickness, why should medicines be used? A slight adjustment in the food rhythms would enable resetting the equilibrium relating to health. Every person is unique by himself. One should therefore be educated to find agreeable food to himself. Nothing can be generalized in matters of food and given out as a dictum. By observing one's own body with regard to what is suitable and what is not suitable over a short period enables one to find one's own individualized diet within the general diet. Every time the body shows a symptom of discomfort it is only messaging that there is something incorrect in one's own food and other rhythms; one has to find it either by himself or with the help of a physician. Just medicating the body where it is not necessary is an act of ignorance and can be seen as a sin in the field of health and healing.

#### Dimensions of Ancient Wisdom

This fundamental step enables us to find a new taste of relating to the pulsation within us. When you stay put to the pulsation within and when you carry out the needed obligations in due order and do not indulge in outer activities more than that, you develop an inner sense of be-ness. It fairly closes Libra and opens the inner side of the being as a pulsating principle within the cave of the heart. When you are within the cave of the heart by the pulsating principle, you are drawn further to relate to the source from which you have come. It is a natural act to relate to the source, from which you have come.

Therefore, there will be an upward movement of the pulsating principle. Since we close the outer and open the inner and move upward, this is the way described in the scriptures from southwest to west, from west to south, that means from lower Muladhara to upper Muladhara, from upper Muladhara to heart - this is called the south, and from south to east. This becomes possible as much as we lead our life in terms of our effectiveness in the surroundings.

In our daily routine, we should find enough time to relate to this pranic principle within us, which conducts respiration and pulsation. If we find time at least twice daily or trice daily - if you remember well, when I spoke to you all about Katha Upanishad, I informed the need of relating to the respiration and pulsation, trice daily at a rate of 24 minutes each sitting:

Close your eyes. Gently apply your mind upon respiration, observe how inhalation is transformed into exhalation. Thereby contact pulsation.

When the purpose of this satiation is remembered as the upholding of the law and the discharging of duties, then the outcome is the protection of Law and the happiness of the individual. Only then duty, result and fulfilment are in balance.

Through work, people learn to form themselves and to become a group being. The ruler instructs them to do so. If the ruler does so, the result is respect for the law in the state and the individuals experience happiness.



#### The Book of Rituals


