

## Shambala 65: Transcending the personality

Recollect Shambala, bow down to the Lord Sanat Kumara, and tread the path of Lord Maitreya, the World Teacher.

Beings that function according to the personality are stuck in the world. Transforming the personality into a divine one when they mount upon it and conduct acts of goodwill, beings are not conditioned by the world. They ensure welfare of the surrounding life. Such ones receive the co-operation of the Hierarchy of Masters from the subtle planes. The entry to the ashrams is to those who have worked their way out of bondage of the personality life. The one who can drop the personality traits at will, gains entry to the ashrams and is enabled to move around freely in the ashrams. These insights are given through the teachings of Master Djwhal Khul.

The vibrations of the personality have their impact upon the environment. Even among the ashrams, there is a variety of a very fine nature, in their vibration. Due to this variety, there is an obstruction caused to the subtle vibration, even when the personality is aligned to the divine. 
Saraswathi Suktam 8 Beyond anyone's possession 2



### Tanmatras - rudimental principles



In Sankhya philosophy, the Mahat, the Ahamkara and the five Tanmâtras are called the seven Prakritis (or Natures), and they are counted from Maha-Buddhi or Mahat down to Earth.

In the words of "Vishnu Purâna": "The first creation was that of Mahat (Intellect), the second of Tanmâtras (rudimental principles), and the third, that of the senses (Aindriyaka)"



The five elements are represented by the five "Tanmâtras". Tanmâtras means the "rudimental principles" in Sanskrit.

ELEMENTS	TANMÂTRAS	SENSE ORGANS
MATTER	SMELL	NOSE
WATER	TASTE	TONGUE
FIRE	SIGHT	EYE
AIR	TOUCH	SKIN
ETHER or AKASHA	HEARING / SOUND	EAR

This is how the five elements are experienced through the five sense organs on account of the five Tanmâtras. That which is beyond Akasha descends through sound into four grosser states, which are the touch, the sight, the taste and the smell.

At the time of creation the Tanmâtras allow us to perceive the world around us. Thus, ākāśa or ether has sound potential while vāyu or the air, has two qualities sound and touch, tejas or fire has three qualities śabda (sound), sparśa (touch) and rūpa (form that is visible), aapah or water has four qualities — śabda, sparśa, rūpa and rasa (taste) while pṛthivī, the earth or matter, has five qualities—śabda, sparśa, rūpa, rasa and gandha (smell).

### Introduction to Srimad Bhagavatham 15



So from Lord Narayana to the Creator, Bhagavatha was discoursed. The initiation of Bhagavatha happened. And from the Creator to his mind born son, Narada Bhagavatha was once again initiated. And Narada initiated Vedavyasa, Vedavyasa initiated Suka, Maharshi Suka initiated Parikshith, the king of Kurur. That is how there is one hierarchy of the seers of the path of Bhagavatha. Bhagavatha Hierarchy is Narayana, Chaturmukha Brahma, Narada, Vedavyasa, Sukha and Parikshith. That is one hierarchy.

If there is a hierarchy, it facilitates the process of enlightenment. But the Lord need not necessarily function through the hierarchy. He can function independent of the hierarchy or through the hierarchy. The Hierarchy cannot bind the Lord. The Lord himself once again gave Bhagavatha to Lord Maitreya! That is how Krishna initiated straight away Maitreya into the path of Bhagavatha, into the path of Presence, of synthesis.

In fact this path of synthesis was given by Parasara both to Vedavyasa and Maitreya. But somehow it was not the time to be. Neither of them got initiated into it. So Narada had to redo it for Vedavyasa and Lord Krishna did it for Maitreya, and Maitreya gave it to Vidura. So that is another Hierarchy of Bhagavatha.

## **OM Namo Narayanaya**

## Narayana Gayatri 1



There is a Narayana mantra in the metrical form of Gayatri, which is as under:

OM

Narayanaya Vidmahe

Vasudevaya Dhimahi

Tanno Vishnuh Prachodayat<sup>1</sup>

This mantra is called Narayana Gayatri or Vishnu Gayatri. Meaning:

- Narayanaya Vidmahe: To realize Narayana
- Vasudevaya Dhimahi: We contemplate/meditate upon Vasudeva.
- Tannaha Vishnuhu Prachodayaat: May Vishnu support/help/assist/stimulate us.

"To realize Narayana, the cosmic essence, we contemplate upon Vasudeva, the indweller of the forms. May Vishnu help us for such realization."

This mantra has 8 syllables for each line and 24 syllables in all. For every mantra, OM is prefixed and even suffixed in Vedic tradition. For effective fulfilment, the mantra is chanted in multiples of 6 or 8 or 12. This is because, the mantra of Vishnu is 6-syllabled, mantra of Narayana is 8-syllabled and mantra of Vasudeva is 12-syllabled. The related lotuses also carry the respective number of petals.


## On Healing

### 2. The Fundamental Understanding 9



Many times we express not but our qualities do. When the qualities express, the basis for their expression is again the soul! This is the insight we need to gain so that the qualities and their affect on the body are seen vividly. The sum total of our qualities is called personality. Personality expression is different from the expression of the person. The person is the soul and the personality is the quality aggregate. When the person speaks of himself unasked and speaks ill of others he is mostly expressing his personality. The love of personality is the hindrance for soul's expression and hence equally a hindrance to healing.

Healing is the act of the soul quality. Soul's quality is that of light, love and power. Healing is transmission of light, love and power to set right the form and its qualities. Man has the potential for the divine qualities of Light, Love and Power for he is essentially the Soul. But the qualities of the body should align with the divine qualities for expression of the latter through the former. When this alignment is absent, the Soul energy cannot flow and healing cannot happen.





# Rudra The Lord of Cosmic Will and Vibration

A few dimensions of Rudra 58 Lingam 1


Lingam is a symbol. It is the basic symbol of Creation. It is the basis for all other formations. All forms are Lingams and Shiva Lingam is the basic symbol. It is the symbol of an egg with the potential of number 10. Number 10 is a perfect number and the egg is the perfect shape for manifestation. From the sphere to the egg, from the egg to the Cosmic Person and from the Cosmic Person to the fourfold creation, Cosmogenesis is conceived. The worship of the Shiva Lingam is considered as the worship of the Cosmic Egg. The Cosmic Egg contains all conceivable creational intelligences. For this reason the Vedic tradition worships the Lingam. All other forms of God are subsequent to this tradition. In later times, the base for the Lingam is seen as the female aspect, while the Lingam is seen as the male aspect. The original understanding was different. The Lingam represents all in one, including the female form. The Lingam is the potential of

all that Is and manifest whatever the worshipper seeks from it. Every conceivable cosmic, solar and planetary deity can be invoked from this all-inclusive symbol. Every other symbol is understood to be incomplete compared to the Lingam, since it is the Cosmic Egg. Such is the importance in the Vedic tradition for the Lingam. It is called Shiva Lingam because it is a symbol of auspiciousness. It is the most auspicious symbol of the Vedas.

Man needs to gain synthesis between:


- Inner and outer.

#### Paths to Shambala 6: A real place?

The focus of the Roerich's five-year journey through Central Asia was Shambala, the institution that, in the background, guides and protects humanity and is the mirror of its impact on people's culture, beliefs and experience. In "Shambhala - The Secret World Centre in the Heart of Asia" (1930), Nicholas Roerich collects his experiences as if in a kaleidoscope. In his opening narrative "Shambhala - The Radiant One", a person from the West questions a Buddhist monk of high rank about the existence and tasks of this world center.

The Lama holds sacred the knowledge of Shambala and its members and seeks to protect this knowledge. Therefore, he rejects the questioner. The questioner insists on the existence of Shambala on earth as a link to the heavenly one. He himself had already seen one of the outposts of Shambala. The Lama then admits that this place exists on earth. The Lama describes the place in the way Hilton had described it in Shangri-La: protected by high mountains and labyrinthine paths, a place with a mild climate, rich vegetation and warm water. But since the Lama fears curiosity as the inquirer's motive, he warns against approaching the place without being called. He says it is protected by poisonous gases and psychic barriers. No local, even the tour guides through the mountains, are willing, under risk of losing their life, to enter the forbidden area. Those who nevertheless tried could disappear or suffer some other misfortune, like the Romanian explorer Csoma de Körösi, who suffered many misfortunes in his life, or the German explorer Grünwedel, who went mad. They were curious and not interested in the deep meaning of Shambala. Shambala exists as a real place, but the only way to approach it is by means of the inner connection with its leader Rigden Jyepo (Maitreya) and to follow his instructions.

Experienced Lamas have many stories to tell about the inaccessibility of Shambala.

A man searches for Maitreya Buddha for twelve years in vain. He becomes angry and gives up his faith as a figment of his imagination. Then he meets a man who is trying to pull a horse's hair through an iron rod. As he does so, he keeps muttering to himself, "Even if my whole life is not enough, I will sew through this thing." The unbelieving seeker becomes thoughtful: what did twelve years mean in the face of such steadfastness. Then Lord Maitreya himself appears to him and says, "I was always with you, but you did not see me, rejected me and spat on me. We will make a test: go to the bazaar. I will be on your shoulders." The man went to the bazaar in a joyful mood, expecting that the people would be pleased to see him with the Lord. But the people shrank back from him. He asked why. They replied, "Because you have this foul-smelling dog full of boils on your shoulders." People only see what is of value to them. Or was it a mere reflection of the viewer's desires, feelings and motives?

On 2022 the English YouTube channel



## Your Birthday Gift





May he lift up the earth to the kings of beauty.


The sons of men are one, and I am one with them. I seek to love, not hate. I seek to serve, and not exact due service. I seek to heal, not hurt.
