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



Note that discipleship is not a path of bounties, treasures and valuable gifts. It is a path of thorns, of fire and of pain.



Our feeling of separateness is due to the circumscription around us and it is the worst demon. This demon of encirclement is called Vritra in the Vedic Scriptures. Vritra means, 'the one who causes illusion, circumscriptions, encirclements, veils'. Saturn is the planetary principle relating to it. Nevertheless, concept and limitation are needed in order to manifest. But to get absorbed into the Universal Consciousness once again, the release from encirclements is necessary.

One should be able to walk into a concept and out of it with facility. Normally when we walk into a concept, we get imprisoned and then we think of destroying it. "Do not break a concept, know how to exit from it".

As we evolve, all these concepts help as a grand ladder, where we realize, that even we are concepts! That is what is to be realized. We are just a concept, according to how we define ourselves. As we define, so we are. Blessed is the one who doesn't define himself and realises his own relativity. Such is the state of Divine playfulness.

The speeches have to be:

Not all humans know how to speak. Speech has to be cultivated to ensure initially that the above said qualities are in it. Only then the throat is fit to utter forth sacred sounds. Generally, many seekers utter forth many sacred sounds, mantrams and stotrams and so on, and at the same time they utter forth speeches of darkness as well. Such ones are like the pigs (pardon me for saying so), who take bath in a sacred pond of water and immediately settle into the dirty and filthy puddle.



On Secret Doctrine

The Trinitarian Man

One cannot attain adeptship unless one links himself indissolubly with the immortal God within oneself. One realizes in that state - 'Aham eva param Brahman' meaning 'Verily I am the Supreme Brahman'. In an adept, this truth prevails and lives in the heart and also in the mind. It is this which helps a mystic to become One. One must recognize within oneself one's own immortal principle and then only one can enter the kingdom of heaven. It is like the personality and the soul aligning with the immortal principle which is called God. Even while one functions as a soul, he should know that there is the super soul or Father presiding over him. When the work relating to an incarnation is done, the one that functions as soul utters 'I shall now rise and go to my Father with whom I have been in association'.

Man is not only a dual but a trinitarian man. There is the eternal and immortal principle from whom springs the man and who develops his personality as the third dimension. To align the three in one and feel the one in three is the state of an adept.

This is what the doctrine of Buddha is and the teachings of Bodhisattvas. This is a pure and simple presentation of the path. When the personality is infused by the soul and the soul is in integration with the immortal principle, such personality functions as a Temple of God, where the soul becomes the image of the invisible deity. Jesus the Christ says to his followers, 'Be perfect as your Father is perfect'. Tracing perfection therefore in every dimension of life is but part of the discipline. When Jesus says so, he refers to the Father as the highest principle in man above the material and astral man. When the most high principle in man functions through man and his personality, his work stands as a work of a temple; otherwise, one remains a prisoner of one's own personality. Mundane man is but personality man; he should be reborn as soul in himself. He should again be reborn as the super soul in him. This rebirth is

what is called in occultism as reincarnation because it is a re-born state. One needs to rise from mundanity to realize oneself as soul. One needs to contemplate upon super soul to regain one's original status. Thus, within oneself there are rebirths. Sometimes it may take numerous physical births to get through the two states of transformation.

The Qualities of Sound Mind (From the Laws of Right Relationship)

Glamour and Illusion 2

Glamour is illusion on the emotional plane. Every individual, without exception, is subject to personal, group, national and racial glamour. To believe we are untouched by glamour is just another glamour. Glamour affects the daily life and all relationships. They are closely connected with an individual's environment, sex life, ambitions, desires, dreams, ideas and ideals, visions and aspirations. People are as they are because their individual glamour conditions their thinking and reactions. This renders them set in their ideas and creates an impenetrable fog, which distorts all contacts and prevents the Truth ever reaching them. They do not see life or surrounding conditions truly or clearly. It makes right discrimination difficult or impossible.

The number of glamour is legion. Most individuals are subject to the glamour of materiality. They idealize and seek to identify themselves with the material world and to find satisfaction in purely physical pleasures and pursuits - in sex, food, money, material possessions, home, comfort and beauty. There is an intense glamour of preoccupation with them, with what concerns them, with what they like, with how they feel physically and emotionally, with their reaction to people, environment and the material aspects of daily living. They whirl at the centre of their daily life, seeing nothing of reality, hearing nothing but the reverberations of their own thoughts, and - consequently and inevitably - getting no true joy out of life.

The Teacher

76. Ruchipurakam

The Teacher is the fulfiller of light and knowledge

As much as one comprehends, so much he feels the one light in all that is. The work of the Teacher is one continuous transmission of that light. It is not that he transmits knowledge as an act, in his presence knowledge happens. When there is a magnet it is but natural that it magnetises, but in truth it is not carrying out an act of magnetizing. The presence causes magnetization. The Teacher is the one who lives in the one eternal presence and therefore the presence transmits through him and fulfils the beings. The fulfilment happens in the gradual comprehension of the layers of nature. All layers of nature are but light. The presence of the Teacher enables the student to see this light. It enables him to be in that light and get enlightened. Enlightenment is a natural phenomenon to a student who is oriented to the presence of the Teacher. Strictly speaking the Teacher is not enlightening but the student feels enlightened due to the orientation.

For this reason, doing away with learning and being oriented to presence is what is strongly suggested in the East. The more the student walks into learning the concepts of wisdom, the more he would start confusing himself for he cannot feel the presence due to the concept of presence. An intelligent student knows what is presence and what is its concept. Concept is secondary, presence is primary. The latter is magnetic, the former is much ado about nothing. The more one is engaged with doing, the more one gets away from BE-ness and from the presence. The student walks into a loophole of awareness when he gets into the mental exercise of knowing.

In a dark room, however much one tries to know, not much can be seen. But in the lighted room all is visible. The lighted state is but the state of presence which is beyond the triplicity of activity.

The Teacher fulfils more and more through presence and things get revealed for the student from within. Revelations are the key but not the acquisitions

of concepts. In the presence of light many articles in the room are revealed. They are already there, they are just revealed. There is no labour of acquiring and one cannot acquire what is not there. What is there in the room, when revealed, one feels enlightened. The Teacher dextrously leads the student to the facility of being in the presence, not so much in the concept of presence. There can be a concept of taste, one can speak volumes about that concept. But it is just not equal to the very tasting. The one who knows the taste is the one to whom the knowledge reveals from within. This is a fine key that challenges generally an intellectual student. One's own intellect becomes a threshold for direct experiencing of what is to be experienced. The difference is so vast - one is like speaking truth while the other is speaking about the truth. There can be millions of concepts of TRUTH, what is relevant is to experience the TRUTH but not gathering its concepts. This is what a Teacher does by filling more and more the light of comprehension through his presence.

Very early in the morning I recollect the holy sandals of the Master in the inner chamber of my heart.

2. Do not speak untruth to be pleasant

Only to be pleasant many people speak that which is not true. Just to please another person, we do not hesitate to speak that which is not believed by us. We say: "I am very happy to see you today". But, were you really happy when you said it or have you said it only to please the other person?

Many speeches that we make, we make them just to please others, but they do not carry much truth in them. No one expects you to flatter. If you praise let it be true. The Sanskrit instruction is: NAMBRUYAT SATYA MAPRIYAM. It is called business when we speak pleasantly without being truthful. We speak for the sake of gaining goodwill, but we do not believe in what we speak. We cannot speak untruth just to be pleasant. We cannot speak truth and be unpleasant.

The other preliminary steps are very clear to us, that you shall not speak untruth, and that you shall not speak untruth unpleasantly. We have all agreed to try to speak truth and to speak pleasantly. Never sacrifice truth in your attempt to be pleasant. Don't sacrifice being pleasant when you speak truth. It is a real challenge for persons to practice these instructions of the Scriptures. It is being skilful in speech. Do not speak that which is not intended, speak only that which is intended. There is no question of speaking in any other way.

This is the royal instruction relating to speech. In so far as it is practised, we don't speak many things which we do not intend to speak and we don't make many smiles which we do not intend to make. For nothing we try to present some kind of pleasantness which we do not carry inside. It only develops a split personality. You are not pleasant inside but you want to be pleasant outside. You are a hypocrite to yourself and you suffer from the conflict of it.


Meaning 2



As awareness springs up from Existence, it does not remain static. It indulges into activity of thought. Just as we awaken from sleep, thoughts keep happening. Thoughts keep happening almost immediately as awakening happens. Thought leads to action and action results in creating something into objectivity. The state of thought is the third state and the state of action is the fourth state. Thus, there are four states of Existence.

- 1. Existence Pure
- 2. Existence Awareness
- 3. Existence Awareness Thought
- 4. Existence Awareness Thought Action

Without Existence, the other three cannot be. Existence is in all the successive three states. Without awareness, state three and state four cannot be. Without thought, action cannot be. The state of action is the fourth state which is dependent upon the hidden triangle of thought, awareness and Existence. Therefore, all activity, which is in its fourth state of Existence, is depicted as a square which is supported by a hidden triangle.

Time Expand

What time is to mind and senses is not time to the experience and Buddhi. Time is only the succession of actions to the mind. Mind knows time through two incidents. Between the two incidents, man thinks that there is time. But in fact, there is only himself. Incidents occur in the objective world and in between two incidents there is only the observer, who is in fact, the silence. Mind is not capable of experiencing silence and hence it sees time as an outer layer of silence. When mind is absorbed, for example, when one is experiencing music, time ceases to exist to him. When the music is experienced for one hour the hour is noticed before and after the experience. During the experience there is no hour, minute or second. This is only the time sense of the mind. What is time to the mind will expand as the experience of existence. Then there will be only a continuum of present tense or experience without sense of future. Past and future belong to the objective consciousness and hence to the mind. Present belongs to the subjective consciousness or experience without mind. This is the reason why the majority of people mentally live either in the past or in the future and continuously miss the present.

Listening to the Invisible Master 1



I am asked to dwell upon the sublime theme "Listening to the invisible Master". I do so with utmost humility.

Master (Eswara) or Antaryami is the basis for the creation which is both visible and invisible. He is called by many names and is worshipped in many forms as per human conception. Acceptance by a Master

Question: Dear Master, how do I know that I am accepted by a Master of Wisdom?

Answer: Dear friend, it will be known when it is to be known. Do not preoccupy yourself with it. Instead, engage yourself totally in the work of goodwill. The occult law is that an aspirant goes forward more or less blindly. He hopes but does not know. He expects some visit of a noble being. He looks for a tangible assurance. He acts upon the assumption that he is being watched of his words and actions.

Proceed with the work of goodwill, intensify the meditation, translate knowledge into action. Mostly the Master appears when the aspirant has forgotten himself in work of goodwill and in meditation. It can happen suddenly.

Star 23: Dhanishta



Dhanishta means "wealthy wind", it is also known as the "constellation of symphony". Dhanishta is the twenty-third constellation and number 23 has always been known as the royal number. It is a number associated with majesty. It represents the king of

beasts, namely the lion. Dhanishta stands for wealth.

Dhanishta is insightful, perceptive and brave. The natives of Dhanishta earn good living. They are charitable and thrive well in foreign lands. They are both spiritual and material lovers. They enjoy music and dance. They have great organizing abilities and are ambitious. They are skilled in astrology and have a mystifying effect on others.

They are intelligent and have all-round knowledge. They would not like to trouble others on their way. They do not express their disagreement with others. They wait to pay



back the help received. They are good in holding secrets. They are experts in the work which they handle. They live as per their calibre and effort; they do not lean on others.

They make good scientists and historians since they have insight into the work on hand. Their intelligence is generally not questionable. Success comes to them in the twenty-fourth year. They are good administrators and have a happy married life. They care not for personal health until they are dragged into some severe sickness. They are liberal in their disposition and have a congenial home atmosphere.

Dhanishta is a good constellation to begin any activity. The gods of materialization emerge from these constellations who are directly working under the domain of Lord Nataraja. The natives of Dhanishta are instinctively

drawn to the energy of Lord Shiva. The grandsire Bhishma of Mahabharata emerged from this constellation.

The planetary ruler of this constellation is Mars. Therefore, worship of Lord Subrahmanya by the natives of this constellation would be very beneficial. This constellation stands for ability, confidence, stability, dependability, hard work and benevolence.

The natives of the Dhanishta constellation have a wide range of interests and personality skills. They are sociable and adaptable. They love good life to the point of luxury. They share their facilities with near and dear. Dhanishta natives are not self-centred; they are group- centric. They are adjustable and adaptable to the changing needs of their environment. The Greeks call Dhanishta as Delphinus, symbolic of Delphi, the sacred place of oracles from where all their wisdom originated. It is called Draco, meaning the friend that guards the tree of golden apples. The Dhanishta native is a very reliable friend and a friend who is always uplifting in spirit. Natives of Dhanishta have well-structured movements. They always plan to move forward and upward.

According to Vedic astrology, Mars and the Moon are mutually friendly to each other. It is believed that

Mars takes good care of the Moon, while the Moon parents Mars. Therefore, this constellation is as much beneficial to the Moon as it is to Mars.

Saturn slows down Mars of Dhanishta and regulates it, while Mercury is catalytic, Venus is role defining, and Jupiter is a good preceptor.

Dhanishta is known to be the constellation of symphony, for it gels well in all situations. The worship of Trimukha Ganesha, meaning the Ganesha with three heads like that of Lord Dattatreya, will be very beneficial to the natives of Dhanishta.

But with the help of Wisdom, cooperation of the Hierarchy and with the support of the group, one can face and transcend the crisis. During the crisis the scorching experience causes the needed transmutation of body cells, which enables transcendence. It is common knowledge today that mankind is walking from crisis to crisis with insignificant intervals. Unconsciously mankind is put to initiations. See this subtle dimension amidst the confusion and chaos of the crises.

Please remember: Isolation of oneself is the curse of Aquarian Age. Separatedness, isolation, keeping oneself aloof and away from the general flow of life is the curse of Aquarian Age because Aquarius speaks of group relation. Love - the Basic Tool



When we observe the regulations relating to speech and continue to do the practice of Pranayama, then slowly we move upward even from the Vishuddhi, gaining the concurrent knowledge and ultimately reach the brow centre. By this, the purpose of the fourth Prana is completed.

The inhalation and exhalation find their termination in Samana Prana.

Samana Prana leads us to the upward moving Prana which is called Udana Prana. Udana Prana leads us up to the brow centre where we are proximate to the sun centre in us in Ajna.

That is where we have to settle.

That is an important step, which we have to reach.

In the process as we pass through the Gemini centre up to brow centre, we dissolve the activity relating to Gemini. We no more divide the world into right and left. We see it as one Whole in spite of variety of dimensions. We don't take to the right wing and to the left wing, we are in the centre of the column where we see the appropriateness of the acts of knowledge and the acts of ignorance happening around us.

Group Activities 1

The common group activities consist of full and new moon meditations; since 32 years the group meets every Thursday for a water ritual followed by healing meditation and reading of scriptures by Master KPK about different healing methods.

- A married couple informs in their healing practice about the latest nutritional findings and the effect of vibrational essences on our health.

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• They also consult self-help groups on quantum physical healing techniques.

- Besides, full and new moon meditations for patients regularly take place in their rooms.
- For 15 years, one member has been taking care of a self-help group "Caring relatives of people suffering from dementia and Alzheimer's disease" in a pharma-cy academy once a month in the evening.



The World Teacher, Advent of Lord Krishna




