≫ MESSAGE OF THE MONTH OF SAGITTARIUS

A rider on the white horse with bow and arrows in either hand is the inspiring symbol of Sagittarius. The white horse indicates a life dedicated to the path of light; the bow indicates attunement to the super-soul and the arrow indicates manifestation of goodwill in action. Sagittarius is the true symbol for an aspirant who intends walking the path of light or the path of discipleship. True aspiration lies in dedicating one's life to the path of light and love. It happens to the human being through evolution. The impulse to dedicate life for the path of light is seen as grace but not as self-will. Through time such impulse happens which is called grace. As one decided to walk the path of light he needs to reinforce himself with skills and abilities, virtues and rhythms; these can be gained through daily attunement to the divine which is within and around. To impart this technique of attuning to the divine a teacher appears in life; he is seen as Jupiter in Sagittarius. The teacher guides and the student follows the technique and slowly and gradually attunes to the divine within and around. With the will to walk the path of light the aspirant now gains further enforcement through attunement. This attunement is representative of the bow. Thereafter the man has to incessantly work to benefit the surroundings through acts of goodwill. Every arrow that he releases with the help of the bow should manifest some measure of light on earth.

Idle worshippers crazily wait for the avatar but the truth is the avatar is around and is willing to work through every true aspirant. The one that attains the state of Brahman is untouched by illusion.


The one that attains the state of Brahman is the stablest one.

MASTER MORYA - MARUVU MAHARSHI -RIGHT ORIENTATION



But the humans are so deeply stuck with matter that they cannot see the various dimensions of the teachings. Man resides in matter but is not of matter. He is the master who relates to matter with the help of mind. Master, mind, matter is the order of Hierarchy.

The Earth's matter is the densest of the planetary matters. Hence effort is needed to recollect oneself from mundanity. The matter in other planets is not as mundane and dense as that of the Earth. The seers who preside over the matter descend from time to time to help the mundane men, for they know that the men by themselves cannot overcome the conditioning of the matter. The seers also know that planetary existence is but a punishment for beings, and the beings would do well to repent and to retribute. Their work is to rectify themselves when men are sent to prison the message is to retribute and rectify. Looking for joy in prison is silly. Men on earth should overcome this childish dimension of tending towards joy. They would do well to retribute, to repent and to rectify themselves.

Recollect Sambala, bow down to the Lord Sanat Kumara, and tread the path of Lord Maitreya, the World Teacher.

In Sambala, time is regarded as God. God is time and time is God. Even the scriptures speak of time as God. But in due course of time fire is seen as God substituting time. As time passed by the Sun is seen as God substituting the fire. Later came many symbols, names and forms of God which totally obscured the very original dimension of God.

Sambala accepts time only as God; it accepts not worships of any variety. According to Sambala comprehending time and functioning in tune with time is primary. Worshipping time is also seen as a deviation. Equinoxes and Solstices are to be comprehended and are to be attuned to; instead on such days if worships are done it is a distortion, according to Sambala. When you attune to the dimensions of time you realize the original state of your own being.

The full moons, the new moons, the various phases of Moon, the Sun's transit through sun signs are to be observed more for attunement than for other activity. *Tapas* is the other name of attunement. *Tapas* stands for deep contemplation, meditation and attunement. Such attunement enables to realize one's own being and also to realize the purpose for which one is on earth and further realize the potential of the given equipment (body), to fulfil such purpose.



SUKTAM 3 DEVAS AND ASURAS 2

There are people among us who are very covetous. They want to conquer and dominate. The soft one never oversteps or causes aggression. Instead of fighting, he connects to the Father who is the basis for the two. He tells the Father: "Father, look at my position". He doesn't even complain that the other is causing problems. He simply links up to the Father. Then, the Father has to come down to set the matters right. Therefore Avatars come to see that the aggressive ones are set to order. The Father does not annihilate the aggressive ones. There is no such word as annihilation in the dictionary of the Father, because both of them are his sons, and are asked to do different jobs. One does the given job, and the other tries to do what is not his.

We always like other's job more than ours. If each one of us were to be asked: "How is your profession?" we would say: "I do not like it". Other's vocations are more interesting to us. What is given to us is what we have to do. If we do other things, we lose the right order. Thus, when the aggressor does something which is out of order, the Light from higher sources has to come to set things right. Lord Krishna teaches in The Bhagavad Gita to Arjuna: "Do your job. You are from the kingly class. It is your duty to protect the Law and fight the Lawless. It is your Dharma. Do not speak like a saint, whose duty is to pray and invoke. The saints are to pray and invoke. Kings or governments are to protect the Law and social order. The business class are to do business. Others are to work as employees".

Today everything is out of order. Nothing behaves as it should because there is a complete transgression of the ordained duties. That is Kali Yuga. Today religions/priests are business like. ON SECRET DOCTRINE

PARENT STARS AND SISTER PLANETS



Only two kinds of people can attain to Self-knowledge:

Those whose minds are not encumbered at all with learning, that is to say, not overcrowded with thoughts borrowed from others;

And those who, after studying all the scriptures and sciences, have come to realise that they know nothing.

PRACTICAL WISDOM

Healing the mind is superior To healing the body. Every world has its parent stars and sister planets. Earth is the adopted child of Venus. But Earth's inhabitants are of their own kind. The inhabitants of Earth are sentient beings. There is no comparison between the beings of Venus to the beings of the Earth. Every planet breeds its own men, animals etc., and no one has any resemblance to its sister planet. Each planet carries its special progeny. Between all the beings of all the spheres, there is something common but something totally different. The spiritual essence is the same but the envelopes that are built around emerge from the planetary spheres.

The nucleoles are eternal and ever-lasting, while the surrounding nuclei are periodical and finite. Their periodicity and finiteness is akin to the quality of matter relating to the planet. The nucleoles form part of the absolute, while the nuclei carry the light of the spheres that they belong to. It is that light which condenses into forms, the nucleoles. Such condensed form is called Atma or Pratyagatma meaning separated entity or Jivatma. From trinity to the normal mundane beings all are Pratyagatmas in whom the absolute remains the same, but the gradation of light matter is different.

Thus there is but one Absolute Upadhi in the spiritual sense, form, on, around which, are built for Manvantaric purposes the countless basic centres on which proceed the universal, cyclic and individual evolutions during the active period.

The informing intelligences, which animate these various centres of Being, are referred to indiscriminately by men beyond the Great Range as the Manus, the Rishis, the Pitris, the Prajapati, and so on; and as Dhyani Buddhas, the Chohans, Melhas (fire gods), Bodhisattvas, and others, on this side. The truly ignorant call them gods; the learned profane, the one God; and the wise, the Initiates, honour in them only the Manvantaric manifestation of THAT which neither our Creators (the Dhyan Chohans) nor their creatures can ever discuss or know anything about. The Absolute is not to be defined, and no mortal or immortal has ever seen or comprehended it during the periods of Existence. The mutable cannot know the Immutable, nor can that which lives perceive Absolute Life.

Therefore, man cannot know higher beings than his own "progenitors." Nor shall he worship them, but he ought to learn how he came into the world.



SATURN

TIME Time Cycles 1

The elongation of time is an aspect of Saturn. We make many experiments before we reach the ultimate solution, this is also an aspect of Saturn. That is where the time sense works. There are certain things, which happen according to time. When we try before, they don't happen. Master E.K. always used to say, "Whenever an incurable disease is cured through me, it is not me, it is the time. At that point of time, when the disease is to be cured, you came to me. Even if you had come to me before that time, you may not have found the cure."

To the one who can really understand the working of time, life is a play. That time sense can only be understood when we have a proper understanding of Saturn. Obstacles are our own impressions of an external agency, which prevents us from what we regard as progress. Through that process man gains experience and learns to wait. He realises that his expectations are not according to how it is, but according to what he regards as how it should be. We always feel, "It should be like this," but it is otherwise! It is an aspect of time. We have to wait.

THE QUALITIES OF SOUND MIND (From the Laws of Right Relationship)

PSYCHOLOGICAL PROBLEMS AND THEIR SOLUTIONS 2

The spiritual technique of dealing with psychological difficulties regards these conditions as the result of the personality not being controlled by the spiritual nature. The individual should take his attention away from his feelings, complexes, fixed ideas, and undesirable thoughts and focus it upon expressing the soul qualities of will, love and wisdom. The same attentiveness and potency of thought, directed to things spiritual, will free him from his self-induced miseries. An inner change for the better ever involves an alteration in direction, a change of method, and a different attitude toward life, circumstance, people or us. Wrong psychological conditions are disastrous and dangerous if they are permitted to exist. They lead to unhappiness, conflict, failure and a vast number of problems, difficulties and absurd extremes. They gently complicate human living and destroy many spiritual values. Most psychological problems are of emotional origin, not mental. Emotion and thinking are so closely interrelated that it is not easy to separate them. The most common forms of psychological difficulty are hate, inferiority complex, suppression, frustration, sense of futility, fanaticism, obsession, homosexuality, fear, depression, glamour and illusion, faults and evil. 48. PANCHA PANCHA HRISHEEKADEHA MANAS CHATUSHKA PARASPARAM Interrelates in a fourfold manner with the fivefold body

Pancha pancha hrisheekadeha -

The body is ruled by the principle of five. There are five organs of actions, five sense organs, five sensations, five pulsations and five elements. Thus, the body is composed of 5 X 5 principles. All these 25 principles are but 5 principles only in their detail. Their relationship is given in the table hereunder.

The body is thus a bunch of five and in each of the five there are again five subprinciples. These five constitute the five layers into which man descends. It is the presence of man that enables this body to animate, to move and to conduct the purpose of life. It is necessary that this anatomy of man, which constitutes the structural and functional part of the human body, is well understood.

manas chatushka - quadruplet including the mind

Quadruplet is three plus one. This three plus one relates to the fivefold body. The three are God in man, man in God and discriminative will. And the one is the mind. God in man is the Divinity in man. Man in God is the ego or separative consciousness. Discriminative will is buddhi.

Parasparam - mutually cooperative

Man is but an image of God and exists in a fourfold manner. God exists in a fourfold manner. Since man is the image of God he, too, exists as fourfold. He steps down to relate to the surroundings as an individual entity. With the help of buddhi he interacts with the surroundings. For such interactions he steps down into the fivefold body to monitor it as the mind. The mind is the link to the fivefold body. Beyond the mind in the buddhic plane he is not conscious of the body of flesh and blood. In that plane he has only the body of light. As Pure Consciousness he is light without a body and as Pure Existence the entity of light is merged into totality. These are the four states of man. Without a mind one cannot relate to the world. The mind and the three preceding it function together with the body as their vehicle.

The body will not function by itself without the fourfold man in it. Man cannot function in the world without the body. They are mutually supportive. For this reason it is said parasparam. One supports the other.

All the above three function through the mind when one is a Teacher. For mundane man the mind and the ego function, buddhi functions off and on and the Divine is at rest.

The four are imperishable, the five are perishable. When one refers to man we should necessarily refer to the imperishable part which is eternal. The other perishable part is the vehicle of man. The man and the vehicle are so intertwined. The gullible therefore do not see the eternal and the transient parts that are intertwined. The composite constitution is referred by them as man.

Very early in the morning I recollect the holy sandals of the Master in the inner chamber of my heart.

- 4. Purity of sex relationship and
- 5. Lack of possessive instinct.

Niyama includes:

- 1. Contentment
- 2. Fiery Aspiration
- 3. Self-study of scriptures
- 4. Purity and
- 5. Surrender to I AM in all.

Accomplishment of these virtues enables mastery of senses and sense organs and thereby the mind.



FALSE TEACHERS 2

Men with common sense, introspect, before they plunge into any action. It should be so even in relation to the Path to the subtle/supermundane world. Sat Guru creates the taste towards the Truth. Through his teachings, he inspires the pupils to follow the Law. He also encourages self-study, self-analysis, self-introspection and inaugurates the will for self-transformation. He gives the contemplative and meditational techniques to enable the pupil to dip into the super-conscious layers of him from the superficial layers of his mind. He does not encourage people to gather around him all the time. He would not also encourage them to publicise him and proclaim him as the great one. He remains simple and teaches simplicity to the followers, for Truth is simple. Aggrandisement of one's personality is foreign to the quality of the Sat Guru.

A guru that aggrandises himself gathers around him people of similar quality who aggrandise themselves in association with him. Just as the guru tries to accomplish his individual agenda, the followers too, try to accomplish and fulfil their individual objectives. Thus, the community around the one who is not a Sat Guru would be like a social club, people fulfilling their individual tasks through social contacts and related influence. Such false teachers cast a shadow on the true teachers, which is not seen as a sin by a Sat Guru, but as a protection. The light feels secure when hidden from the profane. The Sat Guru knows that all that popular activity around him is like the foam around the water, which does not last long. He therefore does not allow excessive foam and fog to gather around him. In the Age of Kali there are many who proclaim themselves as gurus and distort the most sacred tradition of Teacher-student. A Sat Guru is known by the path he emphasises, by the simplicity he demonstrates and the transformation that happens to the people around him.

Rudra THE LORD OF COSMIC WILL AND VIBRATION

Advent of Rudra (First Logos) 2

Rudra is the foremost of the Devas that are tangible entities emerging out of the intangible and the absolute God. He is the Lord that sprouts as the cosmic fire, as the first spur and leads the Devas for their manifestation. He permeates the three ethers beyond the five elements and brings forth the whole universe from the seeming nothingness. It is again He who withdraws the whole creation into naught. He is the passage between the negative zero to positive zero and again from positive zero to negative zero.

He emerges like a roar and is therefore called Rudra in the Veda. The Vedas chiefly classify the Devas into three categories.

- a. The *Adityas* these are the twelve qualities of the twelve sun signs. These are Lords of Radiation. They are expressed through the rays of the sun globe during the twelve months of the year. The cause for their expression is Rudra.
- b. The *Rudras* these are the Devas of Vibration that transmit force through the ethers. The transmission is through sound and light.
- c. The Vasus these are the Devas of Materialization.

The *Adityas* are 12 in number. The *Rudras* are 11 in number and the *Vasus* are 8 in number. Thus they are 31 in all. With the left and right principles, they are 33. Thus 33 are the Devas that function in all the seven planes and hence the number is 330,000,000. The Vedas call them 33 crores of Devas.

11 is the number of Rudras. It is the number of the Master, and thrice 11 are 33 that bring forth the creation causing triangles with the Devas of Radiation and Materialisation.

Consciousness exists in all that IS. It exists as salty nature in salt, as sweetish nature in sweet. It is the active intelligence in all things that we see. To be able to contact this in things and beings, one needs Sraddha. If one has Sraddha, he can remember himself as I AM throughout the day. He cannot be engulfed by his personality. He remembers himself as the soul and sees the soul in the other. Soul is the other name for the consciousness in form. Seeing that consciousness, enables you to be in contact with it and to transact with it. This is how you can transact in light. Transacting in light is the fundamental training that a Master intends to impart to his students. The students generally see the formations, the envelopes around that light of consciousness. They see sound, colour, form, name and many other things, but do not see the individual consciousness. To be able to see that, Sraddha is the key: to be, to be here and now. To see the Be-ness in others you need to be fully conscious and that cannot come by wishful thinking. It has to be practised. It has to be practised with much patience. Without patience you cannot pursue.

Every day an effort can be made to see the light of consciousness in the surrounding forms. Verify how much you remember the light of consciousness in the transactions that you carry out during the day. Every day is a page in the book of your life. Each page should be well written, and every year is a chapter. Unless you have patience, you cannot practise Sraddha, and unless you gain Sraddha, you cannot transform as light.



FROM THE TEACHER'S PEN QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS THE RIGHT UNDERSTANDING OF EDUCATION 2

CHILDREN'S SECTION

ON SERVICE

May the Server learn to see the One in three and the three in the One.

Question: Dear Master, will you please give the right understanding of education as it is intended by Manu Vaivasvata and by the Hierarchy of Masters?

Answer: Newer techniques and methods must be developed to hasten the process of integrating the whole man. Firstly, the competitive spirit should be eliminated and cooperative consciousness should be introduced. No doubt individual attainments find their impediments in competition but there should be a different way of bringing out the best out of the child. Secondly, a sense of responsibility shall have to be inculcated more than the sense of fear for attainment.

Thirdly, an atmosphere of patience should be created; in such an atmosphere the child can learn the first rudiments of responsibility. The children that are born out are of high grade intelligence, they should be taught to shoulder small responsibilities and duties which will call for much patience. Impatience shall have to be noticed by the teacher and corrective measures be introduced so that the child grows with patience. As much patience settles in the child so much restlessness is expelled from the child's responsibilities.

Another dimension is to create an atmosphere of understanding; authority should be replaced with understanding. The teachers and patients should explain to the child the reason for the activities. They should also be told of the future demands of the society upon them. An enquiring spirit should be encouraged and should not be snubbed by authority.

An atmosphere of punctuality should be created so that the children learn the importance of time and gain the ability to employ time correctly and usefully. Lastly and finally an atmosphere of love should prevail in the schools, kindergartens and colleges where the child feels that he/she is cared for and that they are not punished for petty wrongdoings and other little things which can be ignored. There is much information given by Master Djwhal Khul through Alice A. Bailey for use in the book 'Education in the New Age'. Please refer to it.




BOOK REVIEW

Sumana is the individual mind which governs the programme of the individual existence.


Bhraja means the light that breaks out. It means the sense of objectivity among individuals.

INHIBITION AND HEALING

Healing involves rectifying inhibition, which would neutralise frustration. When frustrations are neutralised abnormalities disappear and normality is restored. Health is the other name for normality. It is time that health workers know man's inhibitions, which are social, traditional, and many times, more superstitious than scientific.

Life is not normally rounded out until all functions of its nature are exercised. Life expresses in man in a threefold manner. It conducts the nature in man, which is again threefold. One relates to the body, another relates to the mind, and a third one relates to the Soul, or the divine part in man. All need to be worked out and experienced. If not, there would be frustrations at any level. Any frustration has an impact on health. Body, mind and Soul need to get fulfilled, and each one should receive its due share. Then, health is natural.

Celibacy as a virtue is never imposed by any scientific religion, because celibacy demands abstaining from certain instincts and functions natural to the body consciousness. Where such natural instincts are avoided, unconsciously frustration builds up, leading to sickness.

There are some people for whom naturally celibacy becomes acceptable. This could be due to the fact that there was excessive sex activity in the previous incarnation. The Soul's journey through lives gives different experiences. Some are experienced in abundance and some others are not. Man comes back into incarnation to experience what remained unfulfilled. Hence, if there was adequate experiencing of one aspect of life he turns to the other. It does not mean that he would not turn back to the earlier experience. Until experiences at all the three levels are fulfilled forever, man comes back.

From this understanding it would be clear that natural celibacy is normal temperament, while imposed celibacy breeds sickness. Many religious ignorantly indoctrinate that celibacy is indicative of spiritual development. It need not necessarily be so.

Fasting, celibacy, abstaining from social activity is not really religious. It is ignorance taking to the glorious envelope of religion and spirituality.
