

For those who overcome the illusion of the separation between male and female, there is no sex impulse. Application of the Key of Sound 1



The second key relates to sound and the related centre is the throat. The regulations relating to the sound are of great importance for transformation. The student is required to follow them.

The key of sound requires observation of silence to start with. The student needs to observe silence in the daily routine and utter the sacred word OM vocally and mentally twice daily. The entire routine has to be done in silence. Initiates, like Pythagoras, also gave this key to their students.

The purpose of silence was to eliminate the noise making habit in the students. While the teachers are of voice, most of the students are generally of noise. Noise brings darkness. Voice is not given to humans to invoke darkness but to meaningfully interact and to invoke light. As a disciple, one cannot create darkness of noise as others do.

The Beastly Man and the Heavenly Man


Every mortal has his immortal counterpart; the former is united with the latter. The former incarnates in the duration of cycles of birth and earthly life while the immortal counterpart, entirely distinct from the lower self, lends presence/support and yet is never earthly. Man, the seven-ladder being, is spiritual with his triad of will, knowledge and activity that reflects upon his earthly sojourn connected by Buddhi namely the self-consciousness. The former three is heavenly while the latter three is earthly and is even beastly. The beastly man is connected to the heavenly man through the discriminative will which is called Buddhi. The spiritual triple is called Sutratma or the shining soul, which is united with the earthly triple consisting of mind, senses and body.

Occultism speaks of teachings which can produce a union of the two in Buddhi which is also called Yoga. By appropriate application of Buddhi, one can cause the union, but it is the actions of man that enable such union. Personal merit alone matters, there is no other way. Occultism does not propose blind belief and faith. It proposes a rhythmised functioning in tune with the laws of the Nature; it also gives a technique of alignment with and meditation upon the spiritual triad within oneself which emanate from the one represented by the symbol of Tetractys.

There is a glamour in the world that some unknown god and his team of adepts will work for humanity. No doubt the team of adepts can cooperate, but they cannot cooperate with all and sundry. They cooperate with those who have time to find alignment with higher triad within them.

Such perfect adepts like Buddha are but true examples of self-purification, self-alignment and attainment. The Path of Narayana

The Heart Lotus 1

Lord Krishna is the embodiment of Lord Narayana, whom we call the Cosmic Consciousness, the Background Consciousness or the Synthesis. HE exists in the background of all deeds as the silver screen, in our own being, in the heart lotus. The heart louts is different from the heart centre. The heart centre is 'the centre of love' and the heart lotus is 'the basis of all Existence'. The heart lotus is above the heart centre and below the throat centre. It is at this centre we are recommended to meditate upon Lord Narayana, the Energy of Synthesis.

The whole process of inhalation and exhalation is Narayana. When we keep working upon the heart lotus, we grow aware of the heart lotus, where the centre of Existence is located. Then we will gradually get absorbed into Existence forgetting other states. We attain that state of Existence by the practice.

This practice is very well recommended so that we are able to get back from the state of becoming to the state of is. In meditation it is recommended to observe our inhalation and exhalation. Then we understand that there is the Narayana Consciousness inside, which breathes out and breathes in. The moment we are aware of Him, we are connected to Him. Awareness is the process of linking up with that centre. When we are able to remain in that centre, through that point, we are connected with everyone as 'I Am in everyone'. Lord Krishna says, "I Am everyone." At that point, it is all One, and it is like one screen and many pictures projected on the screen. The Universe is such a projection.

The Qualities of Sound Mind (From the Laws of Right Relationship)

Faults 3

There are weaknesses of motivation, purpose, technique and personality to be recognized for what they are. The subtler personality weaknesses are not so easily detected, as are the cruder forms; some almost defy detection. There are faults and errors that are not adult faults at all, but those of a child. By studying his effect upon his fellow men, as he thinks, speaks and acts, a man learns the nature of his personality and arrives at self-knowledge. Our limitations, petty points of view and circumscribed attitudes definitely provide a problem for others. It hinders their progress and service, and our own as well. This is a point of great importance and supremely worthy of consideration. When faults are realized and overcome, the result is the establishing of right relations with the environment and with oneself.

We demand perfection of others but not of ourselves. As regards ourselves, we excuse the inexcusable. Conceit makes us unwilling to see or concede any imperfection. No one is what he or she might be, though we are apt to think that we now are what we want to be. As a human being, our complete innocence is far from likely. All should grasp the fact that they are not immune from wrong thinking, wrong speaking and wrong doing. Our imperfections, however serious, usually have no opposition. The least we can do is to try to battle them. Indifference and inertia toward one's faults is the curse of man. Where there is no aspiration for betterment there is no hope of it.

The Teacher

73. Janmakarma vileenakarana hetubhutam

The energy of the Teacher is beyond birth and death, beyond cause and effect and eternally is.

All happens upon the background of THAT, but it is unaffected by the happening. A light in the room enables one to conduct activity, but the light as such is not conducting. In the presence of light beings behave differently according to their causal state. In the light there can be an activity of wisdom, activity of ignorance, activity of conflict or harmony; the light is not responsible for the activity. But without that light naught is done. On the silver screen of a cine theatre a lot of different imagery happens. Imagery is not possible without the silver screen. But at the same time it is not responsible for the varied behaviours of the beings on the screen. The activity of will, knowledge and action, the triple activity of the soul, happens upon the background of the soul. But the soul is unrelated to it. Lord Krishna says, "All activity is a triple emerging from MY nature and I AM not associated with it. At the same time it is based on ME." For example, to the gold it is gold to itself, it does not associate with the ring. The gold does not have ring consciousness. Gold remains gold, be it a ring, be it a bangle or be it a necklace or any other thing.

In other words, this supreme state of BE-ness does not associate with the modifications that happen upon its background. It is called the state of nasatya; it is the state of is and is not and the two together at the same time. In other words, the true state of the Teacher is a state of BE-ness, where causal actions leading to the modifications of nature such as birth and death is and is not. The ocean exists as ocean in the wave. The seeming modification of the ocean as a wave is relative but not real.

The Teacher thus is the one who has neither cause for action nor has the cause for birth and death. All these are dissolved in him, yet he exists in all as the Self but not in its modified state.

In us from out of BE-ness there is awakening and the activity of life. The source of this awareness or pulsating life is eternal and immutable. Modifications relate to the nature in us. When we are able to observe these modifications, we stand beyond as an observer of modifications. One does not experience the modified state when one is realized. This state of the Teacher is most sublime and cannot be easily understood by the students who are stuck in the causal triple activity. This state has to be contemplated and meditated to be the formless and the nameless one and to be beyond all qualities and their modifications.

Very early in the morning I recollect the holy sandals of the Master in the inner chamber of my heart.

Sound Subjective and Sound Objective 5

Those who listen are getting into a process of receiving into. When you are a listener, there is a way to consolidate the energies. When you are a speaker it is normally a way to spend away the energies, until you learn how to speak. Normally, when we speak, we only spend our energies.

Astrologically speaking, the subjective sound is represented by Jupiter and the sound objective is represented by Mercury. In the Eastern Scriptures the subjective sound is called Brihaspathi, meaning the Jupiterian Principle in Creation. The sound objective is called Saraswathi. It is the process of flowing out. The sound subjective or that of the Jupiterian principle, exists beyond Akasha and through Akasha it keeps manifesting. Consequently, there is the descent of the sound through Akasha as colour and form.

The first and fundamental understanding we have to make about sound is that it has two counterparts: 1) that it is subjective; that is, the undercurrent, and 2) that it is objective, which is the familiar sound which we know. To ascend from the kind of sound in which we are engaged in into the sounds of the Higher Planes, there are certain practical instructions given. In so far as these instructions are implemented in daily life, slowly we will be able to ascend into the sound subjective.

purification processes to which they submit for lives.



Star 20: Purvashada



Purvashada also "Invincible known as the constellation", is the constellation of waters. The natives of Purvashada are invincible, proud, and have reflected intelligence. Though positioned Sagittarius, Purvashada carries the power of waters. It represents the anterior rod, which is held in pride. It has the ability to conquer with the help of the rod. It has Brahminical intelligence coupled with the

invigorating power of the waters. Since the goddess of the waters is its deity, it carries attachments towards friends and family. The native of this constellation is very compatible with their spouse. Since the deity of this constellation is the deity of waters, Apas, the ruling number of this nakshatra is 2 (this is the twentieth constellation which also stands for 2). The cosmic deity of this constellation is Lakshmi, the mother of splendour, who is said to have taken birth in the waters in a lotus. The ruling planet is Venus, again a dimension of love, esoteric wisdom and splendour.

The seer is Bhrigu who presides over the ajna centre. Purvashada is feminine by nature. With its ruler being



Venus, number 6 stands as a favourable number. The colour is deep blue as the waters of the sea. The quality of the native is dynamism to the point of hyperactivity. Therefore, the



related animal is said to be a male monkey. The related bird is francolin. The tamarind tree is associated with this constellation since it carries fruits which are of sweetish-sour nature. The corresponding body part is

the thighs. Its symbol is the elephant tusk. The stone is the ruby.

Since water predominates the quality of this constellation, its natives can be impulsive and even argumentative. They can identify with an event and gain the needed comprehension to represent it in a convincing way. They tend to be more advisory assuming that they know and have adequate experience. They are fast in giving advices to others and have no patience to listen to the incoming advices. Since Gemini is the opposite sign of this constellation, the natives of Purvashada are not decision makers, they play an advisory role and do not decide either for themselves or for others. When cornered to make a decision, they make an impulsive decision which would not be beneficial to them.

Since the natives of Purvashada are ruled by Venus, the goddess of wisdom, they are good with education and can be good doctors, teachers, and professionals. They can be easily drawn to the studies of occult philosophy and sciences. They are fond of human brotherhood. They can be good advisors, good parents, good travellers, and are generally lucky with health.

Since the natives are Sagittarians, they carry ambition, faith, exuberance, and an inclination for adventure. Patience is not their best quality. They are aspirers, visionaries, and also sometimes day dreamers.

Honesty is a trait of the natives of Purvashada. Joyfulness is yet another trait. They are persons in whom others can confide.

Purvashada natives are blessed and are lucky. They feel like supporting the surroundings. They can feel the surroundings, as also the pain of those around them. They can be good healers. They have a tender and sensitive heart which gets hurt when ill-treated. They help others and get hurt. They hold high self-esteem about themselves and feel important - a Sagittarian quality. They are freedom lovers and expend life in their own way. They are ever on target and are focused in fulfilling the targets.

The Purvashada natives are tall in figure and broad in head, again a Sagittarian trait. They have a long and well-shaped nose. They have an attractive physical appearance. Teeth, ears, and eyes are orderly and attractive. They are peace loving people who love simplicity and warmth of the heart. They do not like an external show. They are believers and are sincere in their approach to work. The weakness of Purvashada natives is that they fall for flattery.

Sound

The sound of Varuna is V. In the science of Tantra it is VAM. It is not just coincidence that in the mantra CVV the sound is present twice. You may C (see) V V sounds, because C (sea, the sea is cosmic space waters over which Varuna moves on the mystic white dragon, with the trident causing waves of Neptune on the space waters) also means a mirror, a reflective principle. V V, tantrically is VAM VAM. VAM Varunaya Namah. The highest aspect of Varuna is the space waters, meaning the cosmic reflective principle, while its lowest aspect can be the reflective aspect of the sacral centre which enables reflection into objectivity. That is why in Tantra, the science of chakras, the sacral centre is given the sound VAM and the colour, as already mentioned, is in-between blue and white, sometimes even silver grey.

Paracelsus Health and Healing

A Simple Approach to Healing

The most preliminary technique of true spiritual healing is to invoke healing energies and transmit them to the patient as under.

Invoke the energies of healing from the surrounding nature into your Ajna (brow centre).

If you are believer in a Master or Christ or Buddha or any spiritual source you can invoke from that source.

The energies thus invoked into Ajna may be assimilated into you up to your heart centre. They may be transmitted to the patient's Ajna mentally or by touching the brow centre of the patient for few seconds.

Thereafter visualize energies transmitting from the pool of healing energies to your Ajna, to your heart, to the Ajna of the patient and to the area of sickness of the patient via his heart centre.

The energies should also be visualized as healing the sickness and the sick energy is moving away into the ambiance.

This can be practiced on a patient for 16 to 24 minutes. Later the patient may be given a glass of water to drink.

The healer may burn camphor before and after every healing session to burn up the sick energy.

In the advanced stage of healing the healer can diagnose the etheric centre which is responsible for the sickness in the patient and supply energies to that centre proposing right note of colour and sound. This requires knowledge of etheric centres that form the basis for the glands. Man generally disturbs with his behaviour the sacral centre, solar plexus centre, heart and throat centre. They need to be attended through right behaviour, right attitude, right food and right healing methods. The 1st aspects are to be educated and the last

aspect is to be worked out. Thus, the healer needs to teach health and heal.

Dimensions of Ancient Wisdom

8. The Fundamental Law

Prince Parikshit thought about the meaning of sacrifice Lord Krishna had told him. If the meaning is service, why do sacred texts prescribe the sacrifice of animals? Krishna explained to him:

Sacrifice of man means to train man to devote himself to service, service to the life around him, service to the One who is everywhere. Sacrifice of animals means to care for them and use them for the benefit of society. Every being used for the welfare of society becomes the object of sacrifice. If man realizes this purpose, he becomes an embodiment of the sacrifice or Yagna.

A twisted idea of sacrifice has been inserted into the Vedic texts for selfish reasons. Plagiarism and insertions are the method by which man has distorted the Vedas and other sacred texts during this age. A wise man is expected to refresh the holy texts from time to time. For this purpose, he orients himself by the fundamental law that governs nature. He observes how it works: the way a flower bears its fruit, how an animal gets its young and how a human being forms the personality of his child. Thus, he develops an understanding of nature's activity and a guideline as to what is good or bad in his behaviour. He can write down this observation in a book - then he has again an unaltered version of the Vedic text.

No existing text should be taken literally. But there is no reason to reject sacred texts. The tradition should be honoured and at the same time supplemented by a better understanding. This is how Lord Krishna himself exemplified it. He assured Prince Parikshit: "You have the opportunity to experience my presence in your pure meditation. Meditate on me." The Lord pointed out to Parikshit: he himself had given a living example of following the fundamental law of nature.

Book Review




