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

Message of the month of Sagittarius ≯

Sagittarius is the disciple, the eternal striving human being, searching for the truth. To help those who seek, the teacher will appear. The teacher shows the way, the way to I AM.

The ultimate teaching from Mandra Gita is the simple phrase by Lord Krishna: "Surrender to ME". The simplest is often the most difficult for us.

To help us, the path has been told by many teachers, in many different languages and in many different parables or ways to facilitate an easier access to the truth. From the teachings of Master HPB, Master DK, Master EK and Master KPK, we know about the Antahkarana. The building of the Antahkarana is the advanced process of the transformation that we refer to as the internal alchemy. I will give you an understanding of this process.

The whole process called discipleship can be seen in two parts.

Firstly, we start with a shift in our personality from the lunar principle to the solar principle. We start to focus on giving to the surroundings and reduce the receiving attitude in our personality. The lower triangle of Saturn, Mars and Moon has to be superseded by the upper triangle of Venus, Mercury and Sun.

During this process, we develop virtues and abilities which are reflected in the first two steps of yoga by Patanjali (Yama and Niyama). The next step in the yoga process (Asana) prepares the platform for the further development as the foundation has to be very stable.

Secondly, we arrive at the advanced part, the building of the Antahkarana. Here, we have to develop seven centres in us which we call lotuses, which supersede the chakras. This is due to the shift in the nature of the energy that is now represented by the solar principle of giving instead of the lunar principle of receiving. This is done during the next three steps of yoga (Pranayama, Pratyahara and Dharana).

When the process is complete, the personality, which is a flower on the tree of life, has been transformed through a magical process in nature into a fruit, which we call the Antahkarana, and the Master is born in us in the sign of Capricorn.

Aim and set a target. Realise to reach it. Transcend to radiate and shine forth.



Shambala 67: Evolution

Doctrine of Eternal Presence

Introduction to Srimad Bhagavatham 17



The stories relating to them are to be studied to reaffirm ourselves the truth of the eternal Presence. This doctrine of eternal Presence that is once again explained in the book Mandrajala, 'Music of the Soul' by Master EK. The teaching of Bhagavatha is trying to live in the Presence of the Lord. And the one accomplished is called a Bhagavatha. He is an embodiment of 'Bhagavat-tattva', Lord himself in the form of Bhagavatha Purusha . A Bhagavatha Purusha remains to be a medium of the Lord. He no more lives for himself. He has no life for himself. The Lord lives and he experiences the Presence of the Lord in him. He experiences the acts of the Lord through him. He extols the grand acts that the Lord conducts through him. He remains in him. The Lord remains in the 'Bhagavatha' and the 'Bhagavathamurthi' remains in the Lord. They become nonseparate. Non-separateness with the Lord within and around is accomplished. The Bhagavatha Path continues.

No Thought 3

We are not independent. The monster of our thoughts makes use of us throughout the day. But the one who has consciously walked into the internal being familiarises himself with the triple principle of IDA, PINGALA and SUSHUMNA. The triangular activity as is happening in Space through Time can be visualised when man familiarises himself with the functioning of the Triple Principle. This Triple Principle is the higher triangle in us, when properly contacted it reveals the plan of action. The revealed plan of action can then be conducted through the lower triangle.

We gain the mastery over the triangle of thoughts; then, instead of a thought propelling us, we propel a thought, direct it and manifest it. That is white magic. A person who is propelled by thought can never think of being in the "Lodge of the White Magicians". A person who is rid of the conditioning of the lower triangle of thought and who is associated with the higher triangle of thought, is the one who handles the thought and sees that it is manifest.

There are tree leaves and plant leaves with triple leaves and double leaves which can be arranged like the aforesaid lotuses to gain proper understanding. In the Vedic rituals, such leaves are used for worship. There is Bilwa dala (Bael leaves) that has 3 leaves as one unit of leaf.

Likewise there is Tulasi dala (Oscimum sanctum leaves) which is in pairs in right angles. These are used to worship the deities.

It is generally believed that Narayana is deeply pleased when He is offered a 'Tulasi dalâ (a stalk of 4 leaves). Narayana or Vishnu or Vasudeva or Krishna are generally worshipped with a 4-leaved unit of Tulasi, which is a sacred plant.

Meditating upon the lotuses with their related shapes and colours is a science by itself. But for those who are devotional, chanting and listening to the sound of the mantra is enough. The colour blue can also be visualized. More than this could be too technical a practice.

2. The Fundamental Understanding 11



The mind, the senses and the body put together is called body by the knowers. This should not be lost sight of in our study and understanding. The body has its growth and decay. It has the stages of birth, growth and death. It goes through infancy, youth, adult and old age during its growth. It begins with birth and concludes with death.

The indwelling man has no such stages. He is made to believe that he has such transformations. The child is told that he was born on a particular day. He believes so. He is told later that he is no more a child and that he should behave better. He believes so. Later he is told that he is old. He believes so. Someone tells him that he dies. He believes it too! The indweller has no birth and hence has no death. The electrical appliance may wear out but not the electricity. The expressions may cease but that which is expressing ceases not. When people refer to you as young or old, they are only referring to your body but not to you. Your body can be young or old but not you, the eternal one. The health or disease is to the body only but not to you.

To think "I am sick" is ignorance. To think "My body is sick" is knowledge. The body has birth, growth, health, sickness and death. The apparatus has vulnerability to repairs but the energy functioning through has not.

Vishnu Sahasranama

Stanza 6, 1-2

अप्रमेयो हृषीकेश: पद्मनाभोऽमरप्रभु:। विश्वकर्मा मनुत्वष्टा स्थविष्ठ: स्थविरो धृव:॥

Meaning:

Prana - life force, part VII The triple quality of consciousness 1

Prana is fivefold in its manifestation corresponding to the five states of mind. Mind can be in the blissful state of Ananda which relates to the sky and it can be in the state of ideation / intuition which can be correlated with the state of air. Mind can be in the state of thought which is correlated to fire. Mind can also be in the emotional state which is correlated to water. Mind relates to the matter when it is in interaction with the objectivity. These five states of mind are supported by five pranic pulsations. Mind contains the principle of consciousness and experiences the five states with the help of the fivefold pulsations. Without the pranic principle the consciousness and supports the activity of consciousness. Since prana is an offeneet of consciousness the triple quality of

Since prana is an offshoot of consciousness the triple quality of consciousness also have their impact on prana. The three aspects of consciousness are:

- over active consciousness, called rajas;
- under active consciousness, called tamas and;
- poised consciousness, called satva.

The triple consciousness brings out the triple qualities even into prana, which can be noticed in the pulse of a person.

Paths to Shambala 8: Shambala. The Protective I

The focus of the Roerich's five-year journey through Central Asia was Shambala, the institution that, in the background, guides and protects humanity and is the mirror of its impact on people's culture, beliefs and experience. In "Shambhala - The Secret World Centre in the Heart of Asia" (1930), Nicholas Roerich collects his experiences as if in a kaleidoscope. In his opening narrative "Shambhala - The Radiant One", a person from the West questions a Buddhist monk of high rank about the existence and tasks of this world center.

Shambala protects its faithful and punishes the malicious ones. The Lama gives examples of this.

One painter created incomparable pictures of Shambala's saints. Another painter became envious and defamed his righteous colleague in order to harm him. Then the defamer's house caught fire and, in an attempt to save his possessions, he burnt his hands so that he could not work for a long time.

A rich man used his possessions for the common good. An envious man tried to destroy the wealth. Then, within a day, he lost his own possessions and was forced to maintain his livelihood by begging.

Shambala supported the 5th Panchen Rinpoche in his escape from Lhasa.


The once significant centre of the Buddhist faith was in decline due to corruption and superstition. Even among the faithful, respect for its institutions had sunk to a low point. Only the highest dignitary, the Panchen Lama, followed the ancient traditions of all great Lamas and was held in high esteem, even abroad. Panchen Rinpoche foresaw the downfall of Lhasa and decided to flee. His pursuers were close behind him. A lake hindered the escape so much that evading its banks would have meant the end. It began to snow. The Panchen Lama began to meditate and ordered his followers to spend the night on the lakeshore. A heavy frost set in and the lake was frozen the

next morning. Rinpoche was able to cross the lake with 300 followers by the shortest route. By the time the pursuers reached the lake, a thaw had set in and the fugitives were safe because they were far ahead.

During their journey, the Roerichs were also under the protection of Shambala. In a stone desert, days away from human dwellings, the caravan could observe a large black vulture circling low over their camp. It was followed by something brilliant and beautiful, accompanied by a lovely scent. When Nicholas Roerich tells his interlocutor about it, the Lama explains to him that the vulture is the embodiment of the enmity that wants to destroy the Roerich projects. The shining ball is a materialization of the power of Shambala, which offers them protection even when the protected ones do not perceive it.

Sagittarius - Alignment from Individual to Universal Consciousness





The Evolution of the Consciousness of Man




