



Implicit Following

The Word is the bridge between God and Creation. It is also the bridge from Existence to awareness and from awareness to its subsequent manifestations as the sevenfold Creation and creatures. The Word is also the bridge between the Master and the disciple, between the Teacher and the student. The Word, which is to be transmitted, must be contemplated and received with respect. The Master never gives the Word until he is sure that the student will follow. He first gives many other words to see if the student is willing to follow. The Master must be sure that there is an implicit following, and not an explicit following. Implicit following means that we follow beyond our likes and dislikes. The Word is given only when implicit following is certain, because there is a responsibility in transmitting the Word. Until such a point is reached, the Master gives instructions about physical, emotional, vital, vocal and mental purity. So many instructions are given to prepare the student to be able to receive the Word. The Teacher is not a teaser. He waits until the teaching is followed. When the given steps are implicitly followed, the ultimate Word is bestowed and impregnation occurs. This impregnation will cause the metamorphosis, which leads to acts of goodwill, eliminates the limitations, causes impetus for inner rectifications, motivates right study, unfolds inner potentials, and enables stable service and deeper contemplations. An all-round development occurs in the physical, emotional and mental discipline -the true disciple is formed. The disciple thereafter continues with the work of the Word to gain immortality, he forms a triangle with the Teacher and the Word and accomplishes in due course of time immortality.

Human is Divine



Each human being is an incarnation of his God, in other words one with his "Father in Heaven", just as Jesus, an initiate. "As many men on earth, so many gods in heaven"- is the eternal truth. Yet these gods are in reality One. At the end of every period of activity, they are withdrawn like the rays of the setting sun into the parent luminary, a non-manifest Logos, which in its turn merges into the one absolute God.

The "Father in Heaven" relating to each man, is no other than the soul which forms around itself the physical shell of flesh and blood, of senses, of mind, etc. The man truly is the soul himself, around which a bladder of body is formed to relate to the objectivity. One should therefore relate to this soul within, which is also called the God within. As much as one relates to Luminary Soul within, so much one tends to be a saint - a holy person or a pure man who inturn would be able to help others as well as oneself in the hour of need and produce what are foolishly called "miracles". The soul that one is, is enveloped with a web of life which in-turn builds the bodies. Relating to the soul nourishes this web of life and the byproducts emerging from life as forms.

Thus the soul within which, one is required to relate to know his original state and even this state is withdrawn into its source, after a period of its activity. The soul is more permanent than the web that it develops around itself which has its source in the parent luminary. The parent luminary emerges from the Absolute.

Thus the four-fold man can be understood as under:

- 1.ABSOLUTE GOD
- 2. UNIVERSAL LUMINARY (UNIVERSAL SOUL)
- 3. INDIVIDUAL LUMINARY (INDIVIDUAL SOUL)
- 4. THE WEB OF LIFE and the physical form that grows around the soul

Viewpoints vs Vision



Each one of us sees according to what we are. If I have a business mind, while I am driving on the road, I only see the business establishments and my mind will start thinking, "How much profit must that man be making? How much investment must he have made? Is he making profit or loss? etc., etc." If I am a building engineer, I see the structures, the columns and I imagine the foundations. If I am an architect, I see the design. If I am an electrical engineer, I see the way the electrical connections are made. If I am an artist, I see the sense of arrangement in the establishment. If I am a communist, I see how the workers are. If I am theist, I see if there is a place for the Deity. Likewise, as we are, so we see a place. To a poet all the business activity looks meaningless. To a priest, it is a place of sin, because it is a place of self-profit! But for a true spiritualist, it is all a variety of activities upon the one Background. To him, what exists in essence is what appears. To others, what exists as their personality quality is what appears.

That is why the great Master Shankaracharya said, "All that we see is illusion." Illusion in the sense, we see according to our state of being. We don't see as it exists. That is why the illusion is on account of a viewpoint that we hold. When we live in viewpoints, we don't see the reality. When there is vision, all viewpoints merge and even cease to be. Saturn paves the way from viewpoints to vision to the seekers of TRUTH.

Do you know the story of the elephant and the eight blind men? Each of the eight blind men touches a portion of the elephant. One says, "The elephant is a pillar," another says, "The elephant is a trunk." And the third one says, "The elephant is like a rope." This is because each of them imagines only a part of it according to their comprehension.

The Qualities of Sound Mind (From the Laws of Right Relationship)

Balance

Balance is one of the qualities of intelligence and is ever a major guiding principle, objective and problem. Balance indicates the expression in perfect proportion and harmony of both the life of the soul and of the body, the two phases of one great unity. This brings equilibrium and detachment from the grip of the form. Balance has to be brought about and preserved so that the path of right action can be safely trodden. In the average person there is still no normal and true balance between the spiritual and the material life. The lower forces are still potent and the higher are still frustrated. This is the greatest disaster that can overtake the human unit, for the expression of the divine nature is the highest necessity in the life of every soul. The result of such frustrated expression is spiritual failure, sorrow and trouble.

Just as there must be balance between the spiritual and the physical so must there be balance between the reason and the heart, between thought and feeling. Thought without feeling, feeling without thought, leads to evil. When reason contends with the heart, the heart must be the final arbiter of the decisions of the mind. This produces equilibrium, not reason alone. In rounded-out individuals head and heart function with equal power. It enables them to see truly, judge rightly, and not run to extremes of any kind. When soul and body, mind and heart are functioning as they should and in right relation to each other there you will have wholeness and strength, understanding and vision, goodness and wisdom.



The Teacher 35. Abuddhikam Not with Buddhi or Wisdom

The Teacher by himself is not with wisdom, he remains Atman and steps down into the buddhic plane to give wisdom to the followers. To him the body of wisdom is a facility. He may use it when needed, otherwise he may stay either as an Atman in samadhi or in the state of ananda (bliss) or even in the gross physical plane. The Teacher has more than one house to reside. Since his work is generally teaching, he may move in the body of ananda and of buddhi, but he is not bound by them. He chooses a variety of possibilities that are available to him. He need not even stay in any of the houses (bodies), he may stay out of them all as a pulsating principle in space.

Many times the student witness that the Teacher is abroad, is away, while he is seemingly with them. It's an absorbing experience to the students to see how the Teacher arrives and departs subtly at will. Though the Master exists in the form of the intellect, he also stands beyond it. Form is a facility for him, but he can exist as a principle of pulsation beyond the shape. In the universal consciousness, the Master exists as a point of pulsation. He works through the intellectual, mental and physical forms. He does the works related to those planes from the corresponding bodies. He has no need to use the bodies when there is no work. So he exists as a pulsating principle beyond them.

The Path 1

The body we hold is the product of the Nature with its three qualities (inertia, dynamism and poise). We function through the body of triple nature. It is our work instrument; our form to function through. The body is an aggregate of principles of Nature and Force described in the previous chapter. It is not an item by itself. Just like the factory that carries out a process is an aggregate of items which are different to each other, the body is an arrangement of forces and matter in a state of equilibrium to function through. The person who functions through the body and dwells in the body is not attached to the experiences of the body namely, the pairs of comfort-discomfort, pain-sorrow and profit-loss. They belong to the Nature but not to the person. Person is immutable while the Nature mutates in his presence. The only characteristic of the person is that he remains at all times, in all and without all. He has no transformations like the Nature. He has no triple qualities. He remains, immutable while in his presence everything mutates. Sun in the sky while reflected in waters remains stable. According to the movement of waters, the reflected Sun seems to be undergoing mutations. They are mutations of water only while apparently the Sun seems to be moving, changing shapes. Our planet moves around Sun, while it appears to us that the Sun rises and sets. Just like everything in the Solar System moves around Sun, the forces and matter of the body move around the person, the central, neutral energy of the body, whose very presence enables the former to move.

The joy is in right action towards the cow, which is symbolic of the planet and the creation. It is for this reason, the cow is considered sacred and is respected, worshipped, protected and fed well before one uses its milk. Though he is intellectually advancing, there is a very tangible and perceptible fall in his understanding of life and the delicacy relating to it. Fire
Sacred Trees 1



I would like to inform you that the sticks of fuel (Samidha) prepared from the sacred trees enable us to have a better impact of the flame on us than any other wood material. The flame relating to the sacred sticks of fuel is qualitatively different from the flame relating to the wax. No doubt that the candle made out of wax gives the flame. Gas also gives the flame, but qualitatively the flame that comes from the sticks of sacred trees have a different impact. For example the sticks of the Cedar tree, Ceiba tree, Pine trees, Ficus Religiosa, Banyan tree (Ficus Bengalensis) and Fig tree are beneficial. The smoke generated has healing impact. The flame causes uprising of energies when looked at. The colours of the flame have relation to the etheric centres of our body. The Banyan tree is said to carry the First Ray energy, the Ficus Religiosa is said to carry the Second Ray energy. We can also use the sticks from the Mango tree, it is also considered sacred. The best among them is the Sandalwood tree, which of course is very costly.

(These trees were verified and found extremely useful by the seers of ancient time. Any ritual done with these sacred trees has a great impact on the person). The secret of the sacred tree is that it carries abundant Fire in it which is not so with other trees. Again Fire generated from vegetable kingdom is considered superior to Fire generated from the mineral Kingdom, such as petrol, gasoline, etc. Even meditations carried out under the shade of these trees have a great impact. Water in which the roots of these trees are soaked carries a great healing effect.

There is ever increasing traffic and the congestion is very high around the cities. Likewise the mind is also in congestion. It is stuffed with many thoughts, more thoughts than it can bear. It is all the more necessary now than before to sit and think for a while "WHO AM I? What am I doing? Am I doing what has to be done or doing anything and everything? What is the purpose of this life?" Sit for a while daily and question yourself. Disintegrate from the world and even from your personality. Stay as I AM and overview your personality, activity, and your worldly involvement. Persons who regularly pray and worship are busy with their own prayers and worship, therefore are not proposing those questions to themselves. From the Teacher's Pen Questions and Answers

Question: Dear Master, There are some people like Nostradamus who had previsions. We also hear of Veerabrahmam in your state of Andhra Pradesh who also had many previsions, these previsions by and large come true. What is the psychological phenomenon involved in this?

Answer: Dear Brother, this is an aspect of human consciousness, which has for long baffled the psychologist. Men are curious of this prevision and the related prophesies. The ability to foresee and foretell with accuracy has been demonstrated in human history from time to time. This should be seen as a state of evolution of the human through whom such prophesies came through.

From the stand point of the soul, such faculty is but normal but for the stand point of psychology, it is seen as a gift of nature for certain persons. There are several ways in which prevision can be developed in the race of men. They are:

- Adopting oneself to the eight fold path of yoga to gain soul contact. In the advanced state of meditation such previsions can be possible.
- Through scientific study of the science of astrology, coupled with intuitional faculties, the prevision can be gained. But in this case such previsions are available for individuals more than for groups, nations and continents.
- In ancient times there were soothsayers, whose tradition continuous to exist in those countries where there is no modern developmental impact on the people. From father to son, from master to pupil, these traditions continue in underdeveloped areas. This is mostly in support of the masses who are otherwise ignorant.
- For the New Groups of World Servers Master Djwhal Khul gave vo-

luminous information in terms of spiritual Esoteric Psychology, Esoteric Astrology, White Magic and Letters on Occult Meditation. In these volumes adequate means are given for refining the human psyche. When the needed refinement happens previsions become possible.

The key to prevision is the merger of the past and future into the present.

5. The Electric Fire Awakening from Sleep 2

Many times in the talks I spoke: "We do not know, how we wake up from sleep, and how we slip into sleep" If we know this, we know the way to the Lord of the 1st Logos. The path from the 1st Logos to 2nd Logos is a great secret. We know things only, when we are awakened, and when we are not awakened, we do not know that we are existing. And the more and more we know, the more and more we are awakened. So, the state of existence always gets into back steps, the more and more, you get into awareness. To progress in awareness means to that extent that the existence also takes a step backward. But it can be experienced in the last steps of Yoga, where the path is formed between that which we call sleep and that which we call pure consciousness.

We have not yet understood, what pure consciousness is, because we are conditioned by our thoughts, as we get up. Instead of remaining like a soul, which is represented by a circle with a central point, we quickly become a triangle with thought. Even this is a good situation, in case the thoughts are in a pattern and in tune with the time and the place. More often our thoughts have forms, which are not triangles. They can be of any form. If you eliminate in the thought, that which is not necessary, the triangle is there, and the soul is there, and the spirit is there. Even the irregular thought has the basis of the triangle. Can there be an irregular thought without existence? It means, the 1st Logos is there in it. We cannot have any kind of thought without existence of spirit. And unless we are conscious, there is no question of thinking, and hence, the 2nd Logos is also there. And then, the thinking process is also there, which is the triangle. Only the pattern is not so good.

The father divided the whole Earth among the remaining seven and made them inherit it in the form of the seven islands. (The seven islands of this Earth symbolically represent the seven tissues of the bodies, in the case of the biological kingdom of this Earth. Hence the remaining seven sons are the presiding angels of the construction of the seven tissues. Apart from this there are the seven divisions of the Earth globe which are called the seven islands.)

- 1. Jambudvipa was given to Agnidhra;
- 2. Plakshadvipa was given to Medhatithi;
- 3. Salmala island was given to Vapushman;
- 4. Shaka island was given to Bhavya;
- 5. Kusha island was given to Jyothishman;
- 6. Krauncha was given to Jyuti;
- 7. Pushkara island was given to Satya.

Agnidhra, the Lord of Jambudvipa, had children who were equal to the Prajapathis. They were: Nabhi, Kimpurusha, Hari, Ilavrita, Hiranmaya, Kuru, Bhadrashva, Ketumala, Ramyaka.

The father divided his land, Jambudvipa, among his sons.

- The southern bit, named Hima Varsha, he gave to Nabhi.
- Hemakuta Varsha he gave to Kimpurusha,
- Naishada Varsha to Hari.
- Ilavrita got Meru Varsha,

- Ramyaka got Nilachala Varsha.
- The northern bit called Swetha Varsha was given to Hiranmaya.
- Srungavat Varsha, which lay further north, was given to Kuru.
- Bhadrashva inherited the eastern bit of Meru.
- Gandhamadana Varsha was given to Ketumala.

Thus the father divided his land into nine parts and gave it to his nine sons. After distributing the land among his sons, Oh Maitreya, the father retired to the sacred place called Salagrama. All nine parts of the land, beginning with the land of Kimpurusha, were ruled by the accomplished ones, whose accomplishments resulted in happiness without any effort. No one suffered from any turmoil, nor old age nor fear of death. They knew neither law nor lawlessness since everything was natural. They knew no distinctions between superior, inferior or mediocre. The differences in the Yogas causing the differences in the statures of the beings did not exist to them (1).

3. A Stable Vibration

You have to train your mind that you don't get into peaks of the mountains and the valleys of the mountain range. Not to live in extremities of thought, you have to even out and find the middle point between the peak and the valley. Try to maintain a range of vibration. It's a range, meaning, it's not the same, it may go up a little and go down a little, but it will not go up too much and go down too much.

To maintain such range of vibration is another ground rule. If some difficulties come, you don't have to get depressed, and if some joy comes, you don't have to get to the skies. You may say why not, when the joy comes, why not we go to the sky, because that joy is momentary. There are momentary joys and momentary sorrows. If you can have that height of joy all the time, you can stay there. But a joy that only takes you up to put you down is no joy at all.

You take four pegs of whisky. A peg is a measure of drink. Four pegs without water or soda water, you take straight. You rise in your spirit much better than with the meditation. But once the effect of whisky is over, you become so dull, totally down and you look like a fused-off bulb. When you are on whisky, you are like the shining bulb. When the whisky is not there, you are the fused-off bulb. It does not stop there. It will slowly affect your liver and gradually poison the body. A joy that leads you to calamities is no joy. Likewise, there are momentary joys and momentary sorrows. You can witness them.

There is a saying that every moment of joy is followed by a contrary moment and every moment of problem is followed by a moment of gift. Like the beauty of life – it flows in-between the contraries. No life is exception to it. There cannot be any person who only experiences happy events and

no unhappy events. And also, there cannot be any person who only experiences unhappy events and no happy events. Happiness and unhappiness alternately come and go. You can't depend upon the transitory happiness. You can develop a detached attitude. Go through the momentary happy events or unhappy events. You are better off, if you know that things come to pass by. Good things come to pass by. Uncomfortable things come to pass by. We don't have to sink with the uncomfortable things and again mount up with the comfortable things. Then you have to always climb up the mount and go down the valley. You get tired soon. This tiresomeness doesn't make the journey enjoyable. So, we should hold a range of uniform vibration. After all we are all humans. We are affected by a comfortable or uncomfortable event. We can't say we won't be affected. That would be speaking only theoretically. But the impact should not be deeper. Frequent encounter with discomforts or displeasures will slowly enable you to build the strength to meet the discomfort without excessive disagreement. Likewise, the comfort is not permanent. So you take to a position where you are affected, but not deeply affected.

This is another ground rule which through exposure to life, you have to learn. I will come to the other ground rules. A theme has developed. I wish to give you the ten ground rules for self development. Three are now given. Seven I will give.

They started pondering on which path they should take to further their travel.

Intrigues against Diplomacy

Among the diplomats of 15th to 18th century, he was the best. He neutralized many conflicts in Europe. He did his efforts secretly and selflessly. He used different names. His most known name is Count Saint Germain. Saint Germain had rescued the life of King Louis XV of France, when the king was attacked by an assassin. So Count Saint Germain was respected at the French court. France and Austria wanted to make peace (1760). The French minister of war, Marshal Belle Isle, sent Saint Germain as one of the parliamentarians on behalf of the king to The Hague, the place of the negotiations. The marshal knew that foreign minister Duke Choiseul hated Saint Germain and would not approve of this mission. The duke tried in vain to prevent Saint Germain from being received by the empress of Austria and he used many tricks to damage the reputation of his enemy. When the co-parliamentarian complained about Saint Germain, Duke Choisseul took his chance. He convinced the poor king, Louis XV that Saint Germain would act without permission. He declared Saint Germain as a traitor and requested the government of the Netherlands to arrest and to extradite him to the French justice.

Count Saint Germain escaped and went to England. Unimpressed by obstacles he worked for peace in Europe. He returned to France and tried to warn Louis XVI and his queen of the imminent revolution. In vain. When the king, his queen and innumerable people of nobility were executed, Saint Germain was near and lightened their burden.
