UTTERANCES OF LORD KRISHNA





THE GARDENER

Unfortunately the humanity runs after desires emerging from the senses and their attraction to sense objects. Fulfilment of desires and accumulation of wealth and power to protect the wealth has become the predominant activity of the humanity. Very few look back, introspect and reverse the process.

It is not enough if you are righteous. You need to offer your life and your resources as much as possible to the benefit of the surroundings. Do not entertain any motive for goodwill work. Causeless action puts one out of the vicious circle of cause and effect. When there is no cause in your doing things there is no effect on you as well. Effect exists when cause exists. When cause and effect cease to be in your actions you stand the chance to get uplifted from the Earth.


Our stay on Earth is causeless. We are here as examples for causeless living. We live in Brahman and yet live on Earth.

We remind you not to fall into the rat race money, sex and power. Look within, introspect in retrospection, repent, retreat, review and rectify to overcome the puny dimensions of Earth. Recollect Sambala, bow down to the Lord Sanat Kumara, and tread the path of Lord Maitreya, the World Teacher.

The followers of the path of Buddha in their most sacred scripture, *"Kalachakra Tantra"*, refer to Sambala. They name the king of Sambala as *"Manju Sree Keerti"*. The Chinese mention in their tradition about Sambala. They name the king of Sambala as *"Rigdan Tadpa"*. The Hindus in their Puranas mention of Sanat Kumara and Maitreya as the heads of Sambala.

In Kalachakra Tantra a prophecy is scribed as under: "When the world is filled with avarice, when wars tend to be frequent, when humanity is totally in unrest, to dispel the darkness of ignorance the king of Sambala along with his army emerge and eventually establish the Law".

This is an understanding.



SARASWATHI DEVANIDO NIBARHAYA PRAJAM VISWASYA VRUSHAYASYA MAINAHA UTAKSHITIBHYO AVANIRA VINDO VISHAMEBHYO ASRAVO VAAJINIVATHI

Oh! Mother, Saraswathi! Deter those that deter the Devas. Scorch them through your power of Sound. Let not illusion and ignorance prevail. Let not the flow be feeble. Let the flow pass over the ups and downs of the field.

There are some who deter the devas or the angels. We must deter them; then the devas can work. For example, we have to prevent those who prevent us from the work of goodwill. We should prevent those who prevent our proceedings so that the proceedings continue. Those who prevent the devas from working are the asuras or the devils. It is their work, and they are born from the same source as the devas. This is the beauty of Creation, the synthesis of wisdom.

We seek from the deity of the Word to deter those who deter the devas. The devas and the asuras are born to the same Father. What kind of father is this? He gave birth to light as well as to darkness, then told them: "keep fighting" and that is Creation. He gave birth to male, he gave birth to female and then said: "interact with each other, then there will be children".

It is like having AC and DC currents, that is, positive and negative. They emerge from the same source. So, why should we deter those who are deterring the devas? Because the asuras step upon the devas. They tend to overstep. They are aggressive. Night has its duration, day has its duration, but night has the tendency to expand into the day. The diabolics are the dominant ones, they are aggressive because they carry the quality of rajas or dynamism. The devas carry the quality of poise or sattva, they are taught forbearance. Thus, one is taught forbearance, the other has aggression. What will happen? The aggressive one keeps aggressing the forbearing one. That is why help should come from higher planes to balance the aggressive ones. The devas look to Mahadeva, the Father in Heaven. It is like the story of the two sons where one is poised and the other is aggressive, he overdoes, oversteps, and is covetous. Like the two sons of Adam, Ebel and Kain, or the two categories of children of Kasyapa, the Eagles and the Serpents, or the Sons of Light and the Sons of the Blind King.

A thief enters a dark room and feels the various articles therein.



If we don't have health, we may blame the doctors, saying that doctors are commercial, and are not giving us the right attention. But let us check inside, within ourselves. Why did we reach that state of illhealth? Then we may find the means of rectification. When our approach is correct, we also find the right doctor outside.

There are many such incidents in everyone's life where we find the right doctor after a lot of trial and error. After many doctors experiment on our body, ultimately we find the right doctor who tells us the right thing, but before that, we did not contact the right doctor. It is the conditioning of our karma through time. We can ask ourselves, "How could we finally contact a doctor that cured us?" It is a good exercise to retrace and find out why we did not get into contact with him before and why we found him later. This is an aspect of Saturn. He will not permit us to meet the right person, until the right approach is made and the right time arrives. Time holds in its folds the solutions to the problems.

THE QUALITIES OF SOUND MIND (From the Laws of Right Relationship)

PSYCHOLOGICAL PROBLEMS AND THEIR SOLUTIONS

Psychological difficulty is universal and not unique, and to get at its cause we have to learn the real nature of that which is directing us and conditioning us. With many it is their associates, or popular opinion, or circumstances; with most it is some aspect of the personality. The personality is a problem, which we, as souls, have always to face, for the unredeemed personality and the soul have different objectives. Until the liberation from the personality is attained there is nothing but complexity, difficulty, psychological problems, disease and death. This must inevitably be when the many conflicting forces in our environment and in us are brought into relation.

Our problem is essentially that of learning to handle the personality, of destroying the hold, which it may have over us, and of making it the agent of the soul. Where the spiritual nature controls many difficulties disappear, but such control is only seen in those who have reached a sufficiently high point of development. Spiritual will, love and intelligence are necessary to govern the personality, and in the average human being these qualities are either latent or only in the process of development; hence the intensity of the human conflict. To be victor over the personality requires endurance, the control of the emotions, right understanding, and the steady shift of the consciousness to a higher plane. Then we will attain spiritual power, usefulness and health.

THE TEACHER

47. SUKSHMAKARNIKA MADHYAMASTITA VIDYUDADI VIBHASITAM Settled in the innermost chambers of the subtle stalk, shines forth as electrical light

The subtle stalk referred to is the sushumna. Sushumna itself is within the brahma danda, the vertical column of energy. This vertical column is within the vertebra, the cerebrospinal system. In the vertebral column there is the flow of cerebrospinal energy. In the column of that energy there is the sushumna. Within the sushumna there is the flow of the essential energy of Atman as awareness and light. This most interior flow is also called chitrini. Chitrini means the flow of chaitanya (consciousness). The consciousness of the being flows in the most interior regions of the cerebrospinal system which is the subtlest energy. The Teacher is settled in it. He moves from sahasrara to mooladhara in this energy. He shines forth in varieties of colours like a rainbow, commencing from electrical blue.


It is common knowledge to the students that the basic colour of Atman is blue, and in different centres it shines forth in different colours. These seven centres and seven colours have seven sounds. Man is thus compared to a seven-stringed musical instrument upon whom the Divine plays the music. A Teacher is one who is identified with the Divine, and he, too, plays upon the human instrument and brings about the Divinity into expression in different planes.

Thus, the Teacher is in the deepest chambers of the swan and gently, subtly conducts differently with different students. The innermost energy is enveloped by layers of sushuma of brahma danda and of vertebral column and through certain centres, which are called the chakras, it expresses out. Energies expressed through the chakras function through the plexuses of glands. In the case of the Teacher all glands secrete appropriately. The difference between the Teacher and a normal man is the difference between the functioning of these chakras and their related secretions. The purpose of all yoga practice and discipleship is to enable the manifestation of the flowing consciousness chitrini via its envelopes and finally via the glands. This makes man a perfect being. When the awareness passes through the centres, the centres transform into lotuses. Before such an expression of consciousness they function as whirlpools of energy and are therefore called the wheels or the chakras. When the lotuses form, the secretion reaches out into grosser planes.

The Teacher is thus visualised as the electrical flow of energy within one's own

chitrini (by saying this, it is not meant to say that chitrini can be owned; chitrini is the very core of the being, the most sublime part of the Self which one is).

Very early in the morning I recollect the holy sandals of the Master in the inner chamber of my heart.

4. Engage the mind in what is to be done. Do not allow it to graze upon the future results or even upon the current results. What needs to be done is to be done regardless of results. Results cannot decide duties. Comfort or lack of it also cannot decide duties. Duties are such that they need to be done regardless of comfort, profit or success.

5. Draw near men of goodwill and also drive near to them. This enables strengthening of goodwill in you.

Be compassionate to the weak-willed ones. Frequently, weakness in others is mistaken as evil. Compassionate approach enables overcoming such mistakes. Where evil is cognised, better it is ignored than confronted. Confrontation at the same time should not be avoided when found inevitable.

6. Be friendly among equals. Respect elders and be generous to youngsters. These relations should not be mixed up. The elders stand for those who carry more wisdom, strength, love and silence. The youngsters stand for less love, wisdom, strength and silence. Equals should be friends. Equals are friends. But the converse is not true.

Our planet came out of water in its sixth stage of existence. Water marks the beginning and the ending of the manifest creation. Water forms the path of incarnation through involutions and evolutions (Cancer and Capricorn). The ascent and the descent of waters (which are eternal) are the periodical cycles of either the planet or the groups of planets. The solar centre reflects in the waters without being polluted to see that the water is drawn up through its beams and poured down through the clouds.

The path of waters is mainly divided into three parts (Tripadaga) namely (a) Devas (b) Martyas (Earth beings) (c) Nagas (The beings of the nether world)

These beings are respectively, eternal, changing and timebound beings of each solar system.


The eternal waters (Devas) when drawn downwards (involution) are localised as rivers. They assume the form of moving waters (changing) and when they reach the ocean they are bound (meaning the loss of flow). This is astrologically explained as the downward path of waters from Cancer to Capricorn. Capricorn is the dawn of the year cycle when the upward journey begins.

The downward path of the waters is poetically explained in the Puranas as the effort of the king of Solar Ray (Bhagirath) who brought down the celestial waters down to Earth as Ganga (the sacred river of India), the activity of Leo. The upward path of waters from the ocean is also equally expressed as the act of Agastya (a cosmic personage of Aquarius principle) who drew up the waters, to liberate the bounded beings.

Meditate upon downward and upward path of the waters. Meditate upon its threefold existence. The cosmic sounds identified with the cyclic process are NA and RA, while the path of waters mean ayana forming the eight syllable mantra.

FALSE TEACHERS 1



The Guru who does not reveal the Path to Truth is not a Sat Guru. He may be a guru relating to a concept of wisdom, a branch of wisdom. There can be gurus who promote concepts and thereby gradually control and possess people. The false gurus exist as much as the Sat Gurus. The existence of false gurus is a clear proof of the existence of Sat Gurus. How can there be a counterfeit unless there is the original?

According to the sincerity of purpose and the degree of purity, one is attracted to a Sat Guru or a false guru, "birds of the same feather flock together" is a popular saying. Beings of the same quality group, gather, under a big manifestation of that quality. If one is looking for Truth sincerely and has a fairly pure life, it is likely that the intensity of sincerity would lead him to a Sat Guru.

Prahlada, (the foremost of the world disciples mentioned in Srimad Bhagavata) says as under:

"Those who are not Sat Gurus conceive and contrive ways and means to enslave the followers and fulfil their individual agenda. They do not pave the way for the followers towards the Law, the Truth, and the bliss of self-realisation. They are to be discarded at once. The Sat Guru leads his followers towards the Truth, the "all permeating consciousness" who presides over the creation, having created it. He would lead his chelas towards immortality and eternity. He would lift them up from the wheel of birth and death"

THE PRAYER 4

Rudra THE LORD OF COSMIC WILL AND VIBRATION

Advent of Rudra (First Logos) 1



The purpose of Fire ritual is to eliminate impurities in us and to eliminate the weeds that hinder the growth. The weeds and seeds are within every man. The weeds are of ignorance while the seeds are of knowledge. Knowledge leads us to right action. Ignorance leads us to false attractions. An intelligent truth seeker should eliminate weeds and nourish seeds. Fire helps destroying the weeds. The seeds and weeds are what we carry as our good and ignorant traits. Through Fire ritual one can seek burning up of the weeds, elimination of false attractions and protection from dubious paths. This is a major work of discipleship.

Worship of Agni should enable one to function with right attitude in the world. One should be able to establish right human relationship. The practice should also enable withdrawal of senses from the sense objects of the world, at will. The disciple who can withdraw at will from the activity of externalisation through senses in compared to, the Sun that withdraws his rays. When the rays of the Sun are withdrawn the Sun globe is visible. Likewise, when externalisation from senses is withdrawn, the Soul is visible. Sun is the Soul. The Sun globe appears like a golden disc when the rays are withdrawn. Likewise, the disciple also experiences his golden form when he suspends the activity of senses. This golden form is the subtle body which is immortal and divine.

Unless the first prayer of suspension of sense activities happen, the second step of experiencing the solar disc is not possible.

In the beginning of the creation (which is a doctrine by itself) the third Logos (Brahma, the Creator) emerged. He was initiated by the Lord Absolute to create. As he thought of creation, four Kumaras came out of him. The Creator advised them to cooperate with him for creation. The Kumaras smiled and remained silent. The purpose of emergence of the Kumaras was different from what was visualised by the Creator. These Kumaras are the Sons of Will and of Yoga. About these Kumaras, Madam Blavatsky elaborately writes much in "Secret Doctrine". Madam Alice A Bailey also described them in the book "Treatise on Cosmic Fire." They are also referred to as *Agni Shvathas* in the Vedas. The beauty and the splendour of the Kumaras is again a doctrine by itself. They are the most sublime beings that constitute the Yoga Hierarchy. They form the four avenues of the Lord in creation to enable the descent of the Creator's plan, but to work for the Lord himself. The third Logos became angry at the disobedience of the Kumaras.

When the third Logos became angry due to the disobedience of the Kumaras, he tried to contain such anger. The fire of anger, however, opened up a centre in the brow and Rudra, the first Logos, emerged from there. As he emerged, he was blue and red together. He was therefore called *Neela Lohitha*. The quality of Rudra was blue and the power that encircled him was red. The power of red made way for creation and the bliss of blue permeated into the creation. Such is the beauty of the emergence of Rudra.

Question: Dear Master, will you please give the right understanding of education as it is intended by Manu Vaivasvata and by the Hierarchy of Masters?

Answer: Dear Sister, the question that you have asked concerns the whole humanity. Education is deeply a spiritual enterprise but not a commercial and mundane activity. Today education is seen as a means to riches, to prestige and power. The activity of education today is driving man into imprisonment of spirit. It is tending the human for selfish pursuits. A small percentage however is always an exception which utilizes the knowledge to benefit the humanity as a whole but not to amass wealth, power and prestige.

Education should never be in the hands of any church or of any sectarian philosophies. Today mostly educational activity is carried out by philanthropic organizations whose founders are Gurus and religious heads; in all such cases the education is coloured as per the philosophy of the Guru, of the religion or of the sect. Education in the hands of such sects would only spell disaster. Education by catholic churches, protestant churches, Jewish or Islamic prophets or Hindu gurus is bound to be tainted by reactionary attitudes.

Education should finally find its freedom from all the prevailing isms of the society. It should make man a thinker and an open-ended thinker but not a prejudiced one. Through education a child should attain "adult manhood".



The One with the Three Eyes 1

I told you how the sounds happen from the sacred word, when I was explaining to you the fire by friction. Similar happening takes place along with the working of the 2nd Logos and also the 1st Logos. So, the 1st Logos works with the 1st part of the sacred word, the 2nd Logos with the 2nd part of the sacred word. And the 3rd Logos works with the 3rd part of the sacred word. And I told you how the 3rd part of the word manifests as five sounds, and I also suggested you to go through the books of Sir John Woodroffe in that context.

Yesterday we have understood to some extent, how the First Logos or the Cosmic Will or Shiva functions in emergency to restructure the system, whenever it is necessary. Another understanding of the electric fire or the 1st Logos is: The 1st Logos is the power of the 2nd, and the 2nd Logos is the splendour of the 1st. So, the 2nd Logos works with splendour and carries the centre as the power. That means, the beauty aspect of the 2nd Logos is an expression from the centre which is the 1st Logos. That is why the central point is the 1st Logos and the 1st circumscription about the 1st Logos is the 2nd Logos. The 3rd Logos is an emanation coming from the two. In fact, the 2nd and 3rd Logos are the two eyes of the 1st Logos who functions through His own 3rd eye and hence, He is called 'the triple eyed-one'.

The Meditation Process 4

If one appreciates the importance of meditation, he will find time for meditation every day. If the lower three chambers are very irregular and agitated, the person throws himself away from respiration and from meditation. If a student says, "I am not able to work with respiration and meditation", the Teacher understands that he needs more preliminary exercises than working with respiration. He therefore suggests to work with sounds, or colours, or symbols, or some rituals, or some physical service, asanas. He sees where he is stuck and tries to help the student from the point where he is stuck. People may be stuck with irregular habits of eating or stuck with excessive critical speaking, or stuck with the sensuous aspects of life, or stuck with emotions like jealousy, hatred, or stuck with negative thoughts. Every person has some points where he is stuck. The Teacher tries to give the related work to him, so that he is released from the point where he is stuck. To some he suggests silence. To some others he may suggest reading of certain books. That's why, in a course of self-transformation, you find all these techniques at work - rhythm of life, discrimination in usage of senses, study of Scriptures, observation of silence, recitation of some sound formula, chanting of mantras, asanas, contemplation upon light, etc. These are the things that you will find in every ashram of every true Teacher. And they try to give food which is nourishing but not spicy. And strong smelling foods are not given.

All these regulations have come to be only to help that man gains a very quiet, stable mind which can reflect the higher. If we wish to link up to that which is subtle and that which is not comprehended now, we need to pick up a way of living which would enable us to regularly meditate. If you do like that for about ten to twelve years, you get multiplied in your capacities, your comprehensions are far superior, you don't only go by the obvious, you see beyond the obvious, and you gain that kind of insight.

That's what I intent to inform you in these ten to twelve days of talks. Many instructions have been given, you can list them out and see what you can follow and see how much you can orient to the work of meditation.

In the whole theme, I have not spoken to you of God, I have not spoken to you about any religion, I have not spoken to you of any Master, I have spoken to you only of you, what man is, what are his potentials, and what are his pitfalls. It is only about ourselves. This is how from ancient most times, man transforms himself, not excessively relying on some outside agency in the name of faith or God. This is there from the beginning. This practice of self-analysis, self-introspection

and picking up the spiritual tools for self- transformation does not require emphasis upon a name or a form which led to a lot of confusion and differences.

The Spheres of the Earth 2

All these seven sons have become the rulers of Plaksha Dvipa. (The Earth has seven harmonious movements which are simultaneous and govern the mental states of the planet.) All these seven sons have their own demarcations of the father's kingdom distributed among themselves. The demarcations have their nodal points which are named as follows:

- 1. Gomedha;
- 2. Chandra;
- 3. Narada;
- 4. Dundubhi;
- 5. Somaka;
- 6. Sumana;
- 7. Bhraja.

Gomedha means the realm of light that falls on the point of rotation at the axis. Chandra means the path of the Moon, which forms the belt of sky demarcated around the Earth above the ring of the Equator.

Narada means the cloudy region where the nucleus of clouds forms in the atmosphere and begins to rotate in whirlpools, sponsored by the differences in the temperature of the sun's rays. They attract the water on this Earth that evaporates and forms into clouds. The word Narada means Nara + da, the giver of showers.

Dundubhi means the drum in space. It means the sound potential in space which is disturbed as the audible sound vibrations by virtue of the wandering winds. It can be termed the radioactive principle or the realm of radiation in space.

Devas are said to take shape as beings of radiation while Rudras form through vibration and Vasus through materialisation. Adityas, Rudras and Vasus, twelve, eleven and eight in number respectively, are said to form the content of a unit space globe that hatches like an egg, bringing out one unit of creation as the chicken.

Somaka is the music potential in space. He is called the Gandharva in the Vedas. He creates the periodicities of the various pulsations which express through numbers operating as units of time.
