


The truth about the law of rebirth or the law of opportunity is a very mysterious and opaque theme.

Savitri and Satyavan



Saturn is called the 'Lord of Death' who lives in the nether worlds. Sun is called the 'Lord of Truth' (in Sanskrit, Satyavan which means Lord of Truth) who is destined to die into the carbonisation of the body. When we take oxygen inside it is destined to end into the carbon, otherwise we don't live.

The Sun rises every morning and he is destined to set in the West. In between there is the sunlight which comes down to Earth. It is called, the maiden Savitri in the scriptures. The story goes that she wanted to marry Satyavan, but it was predicted that he would die after marriage and Saturn will take him away to the netherworlds. But she wanted to marry him. She married him and Saturn at the time of sunset took Satyavan away i.e., out of the body, and she followed him into the nether regions.

And it is said that the god of the nether worlds asked her to go away. "You cannot take him back; it is not possible". She said, "Wherever he is, I should be there". And the Lord of the netherworld discovered that the two are inseparable and said, "You take him again into the next dawn".

That is how the story goes. It is magnified into the modem scripture of the twentieth century named "Savitri" by Sri Aurobindo in English. Of course, the story is there in the ancient scriptures but he has made it into a full-fledged scripture with all the symbolism worked out. Just this is an example.


Saraswathi Suktam 7 Light and sound 2

Ashram Regulations for Entry

The cave 5



Regular practice enables establishment of a habit. The habit of sitting is to be inculcated first. The habit of sitting at the same time for the same duration is very important, without which not much can be achieved. It is recommended that such habit of sitting for the same time and same duration is setup twice daily or thrice daily. For an overactive mind five times daily is also recommended. For not so active mind three times daily is recommended. For a normally active mind two times daily is sufficient. What is important is to be able to sit quiet and apply the mind upon the respiration. This is the first step. Though it is not difficult, many find it difficult to do so. Therefore they cannot enter into the cave. Hence, they disable themselves the initiation.



On Secret Doctrine

Manasa Putras



At the beginning of the human stage of the fourth round on this globe, they "ooze out" their astral doubles from the "ape-like" forms, which they had evolved in round III. And it is this subtle, finer form, which serves as the model round which nature builds physical man. These "Monads" or "divine sparks" are thus the "Lunar" ancestors, the Pitris themselves. For these "Lunar Spirits" have to become "Men" in order that their "Monads" may reach a higher plane of activity and self-consciousness, i.e., the plane of the Manasa-Putras, those who endow the "senseless" shells, created and informed by the Pitris, with "mind" in the latter part of the Third Root-Race.

For ages, the human monads did not have a mind. They developed like in a dreamless sleep. In order to awaken the thought principle in these beings, the Kumaras - also called Manasa Putras, Sons of Brahma, the cosmic mind - descended onto the planet in the third root race.

The Manasa Putras, mysteriously also called the cosmic rebels, came down under the guidance of Sanat Kumara, in order to extend their helping hand.

The Manasa Putras set a great hope on the human evolution, and they never give up on this hope, in spite of all adverse human behaviour. The human intellect cannot grasp the compassion and patience of the Divine.²

In order that humanity can consciously make experiences, a group of beings called Manasa Putras (Sons of Cosmic Mind) or Agnishvattas (Lords of the Flame) decided to awaken the mind (manas) in man. The human beings should get self-awareness and learn through experience, that freedom means responsibility. This happened 18 million years ago.³

Sam - The Key to Saturn

Three qualities



The whole creation is but a fabric of the triangular activity of Consciousness, Force and Matter.

- 1. The nature of Consciousness is Poise (Sattva).
- 2. The nature of Force is Dynamism (Rajas).
- 3. The nature of Matter is Inertia (Tamas).

The eightfold nature builds a triangle with consciousness, force and matter. Each triangle is different from the other in the sense that either matter or force dominates each other disturbing the equipoise of the three qualities of nature.

For example:

- 1. In the plane of gross matter, matter dominates force and consciousness.
- 2. In the plane of water the force dominates matter and consciousness.
- 3. In the plane of fire, the force dominates even further.
- 4. In the plane of air, the force of air dominates the matter and consciousness.
- 5. In the plane of akasha, the matter and the force find their equilibrium. For this reason, this plane is considered stable, quiet, tranquil, and peaceful.
- 6. The mind which is in 6th plane could be either of poise or of excessive dynamism or could be inert depending upon the triangular combination of matter, force, and consciousness.

That which is all over enters through the nostrils becomes inhalation and through exhalation when it crosses through the throat it utters forth itself into letters, into words, into sentences, into discourses, into scriptures and into so many details. That is how the One beyond utters forth Himself. All that comes out of Itself remained to be its vehicle. At best it can cease to be the vehicle. So even the Creator is uttered forth to utter.

Inhalation and exhalation 1

The importance of speaking need not be elaborated beyond this point, because the interior sounds can manifest when we stop uttering the exterior sounds. There is a method to practise it. That is, to speak when it is required, to speak pleasantly and not to deviate from facts when you speak. This is the minimum required. Thereafter, develop an attitude to listen. When you keep listening, you will listen in the beginning to so many words which are a combination of consonants and vowels.

Every consonant is supported by a vowel keep listening to the undercurrent of all exterior sounds. Gradually you will find only one sound manifesting as many. If you sit in a park of a big city where there is much car traffic, and you listen to the undercurrent of the sounds that are made by the cars you will find only one sound like "weeeee...". In us also there is a sound like that which continuously happens. Without that undercurrent within us we cannot utter, not even vowels or consonants. There is something in us which enables an utterance. We will grow aware of that by converging from various sounds into one sound.

The centre

Man's dependence on medicines is all-time high now. He eats as much medicine as food for maintenance of his body. The prohibition to eat and drink is much more today in prescriptions than before. The modern man chalked out a way of life, where stress, competition, speed, covetousness have become essential ingredients to life with the consequent by-products namely: tension, jealousy, hatred, anxiety etc. He is tending more and more towards man-made world drawing himself away from the serene world of nature.

In contrast, the ancient Seers studied and developed a way of life, where cooperation instead of competition, loving understanding instead of jealousy, suspicion or hatred and contentment instead of covetousness prevailed. Thus, the student becomes an insider, indweller. Such indwellers receive more attention of the Teacher. They receive greater measure of light as also the magnetic impact, which should enable them to get deeper and deeper into oneself. He gets into experiences, which are hitherto imperceptible and intangible. It slowly leads to an understanding that the indweller has access to the subtle world for experience, whose joy is many times more than that of all experiences of the gross world with the help of the gross body of outer mind, senses and body. The gross body is then seen as a vehicle for the outer work. During times of contemplation and meditation the outer vehicle is parked and the inner vehicle is taken for inner experiences. In the subtle, one experiences with the help of the subtle body. In the gross, one experiences through the gross body. The subtle body is the replica of the gross and vice versa.

The presence of the Teacher enables this transformation faster. Likewise the Teacher subtly imparts teaching and training to enable the student even to shed, to park the subtle body and enter into causal body. Thereafter even the causal body is parked to experience just as soul. At that state the experience is only of THAT. THAT I AM is the experience of the soul. For this reason the soul is called the vehicle of the Spirit. The soul in turn can function in the causal plane with the help of the causal body, in the subtle plane with the help of the subtle body, and in the gross plane with the help of the gross body. Such is the facility of the Teacher's presence through which he would lead the sincere student to go through these transformations.



Seventh Ray and Magic

The incoming of the 7th Ray

Shambala has made a direct impact on humanity, the third major centre of our planetary Logos. The impact has been made to bring about certain adjustments to match up to the divine intention.

Shambala's direct touch to humanity is not so much on account of the point of evolution that the humanity has managed to reach. It is because our Planetary Logos is preparing Himself for certain higher initiation. Such initiation requires reorganisation of, and rearrangement to the energy flowing through His third centre. Mother Anasuya, Jillellamudi, 1



Mother Anasuya lived for 62 years in a village called Jillellamudi, near Bapatla, a town in the Guntur District of Andhra Pradesh, India. She was an embodiment of abstract wisdom, Brahma Vidya. Even from her third year, she demonstrated transcendental state through her meditations. Even before she was born, she appeared in a dream to her father and said, "I take to a form of Mother of all and be amidst people in the world. Know that I am Brahman and that I am born of self-will. I shall give presence and help beings as a Mother." Even from her third year, she was frequently getting into meditations for long durations. She showed little interest in food and even as a baby, never cried for milk. She seldom ate and even when she did, she consumed very insignificant quantities. Yet, she carried a huge body all through.

For 62 years she lived in a female human body. She married and had children like every other woman. But mostly her function was 'To Be'. She was mostly witnessing Brahman, within and around. Her normal life was more a happening than doing. She believed in witnessing the 'One' - within and around. Common functions happened in life in a normal way.

She never indulged in teaching nor did she suggest any practices to realize Truth. Yet she allowed people around her to conduct whatever practices they carried out, out of their own inspiration. She was only happy offering food to as many people and animals as possible. The only practice witnessed is her long durations of transcendental meditation - Samadhi.

She is little known to have slept. Her sleep was in very short and insignificant durations. She frequently used to say "Forgetfulness brings sleep. I do not sleep since; I am mostly in the state of awakening. I do not also forget any event, big or small. At all times I remain 'I Am That I Am'. The only activity I like, is to feed as many beings as possible. Since I am a Mother, I am happy seeing beings fulfilled with food."

She was daily counseling hundreds of persons that visited her and was also feeding them. She fed at-least one morsel of delicious food by herself and later directed them to the dining hall to have stomach full of food. Her kitchen and dining places were ever active. Every person that visited her for a second time, she remembered them by their family name and also remembered, what dish (of food) she had fed that person previously. That was amazing to many. She was known to be "A Mother that never forgets."

- 2. "Soul, the Supreme" means the Lord's Presence in each living being. This Presence is the spirit that exists, to whom the soul forms the pure ray.
- 3. The Lord is the highest path and goal of the liberated ones. Liberation includes the process of resolving the riddles of the matter, mind and senses which form the changing nature of a living being. At first, this starts with the first recollection of the Lord by the individual. The approach is made possible in four alternatives.
 - a) The afflicted being struggles to get off his affliction. During the struggle, he begins to hit at the Lord by way of prayer and worship.
 - b) The one with curiosity peeps into the nature of many things. Gradually he hits at the Lord as the Cause of all causes.
 - c) The one who is crazy after getting his things done runs after everyone to achieve his selfish ends. He seeks and seeks in various persons and incidentally feels the Lord in all.
 - d) The man of knowledge knows Him directly. This is the path prescribed by the Lord and made available for the living beings struggling in the bondage of self-conditioning. Liberation is the result.

Introduction:

The Vedas, which are considered as the foremost scriptures of the world gave many clues relating to this energy, especially Rig Veda and Atharva Veda.

Prana exists in the gross, subtle and causal worlds and its emanation is right

from the emergence of root matter called Prakrithi. It is the chief intelligence that causes motion to the creation. Air is its primary vehicle. Air exists in all and therefore Prana exists in all. 
persons (592 pages).
