
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Prayer of the Year 2023-2024

Scorpio - the Sign, the Person, the Mysteries

Scorpio is the eighth sign of the zodiac. It both hides and reveals the Ageless Wisdom mysteries and teachings. Of all the twelve signs (except Pisces), Scorpio is the most veiled, concealed, hidden, unknown and buried in secrets and misunderstandings. When encountering a Scorpio, meaning someone with Sun or Moon or ascendant in Scorpio, there is always a subtle aura of mystery, an intrigue as something is transmuting and transforming. 

Shambala 66: Group co-operation

Recollect Shambala, bow down to the Lord Sanat Kumara, and tread the path of Lord Maitreya, the World Teacher.

Between Shambala and the worlds that are subtle and divine, there is a firm cooperation. With the vital plane (Pranamaya loka), Shambala has a deeper association. The healing devas of the vital plane are favorable to the members of Shambala. In the recent times, Master CVV worked out such co-operation which he stabilized in himself and further bestowed such eligibility to the mediums who follow his Yoga. To seek the co-operation of the devas in treatments for restoration of health, is being recognized by the present age. Students with a pure heart and a clean mind, who have submitted themselves towards serving in the vital plane (in the work of healing), are enabled with the co-operation of the healing devas by Shambala. When such an arrangement is worked out, there is a possibility of 'Ateetha Kaya Kalpa Chikitsa'. (This is a subtler procedure of rejuvenating the body cells through transmutation. Chikitsa means treatment in Sanskrit.) 'Ateetha Kaya Kalpa Chikitsa' has a special place in the yoga given out by Master CVV. Master CVV worked out an agreement with Shambala, and the planes that are divine and subtle. He conducted acts of transcendental healing to rejuvenate the body. This has been noted by certain historians of the time. To cause rectifications in prana is seen as a state of accomplishment in Yoga (a Yoga Siddhi).

The members of Shambala carry an ability to cause rectifications to the prana (vital body). Co-operation of the healing devas to the disciples is also made possible. Shambala enables such co-operation of the devas to the ones engaged in healing activities among the new age groups. They are conducting the work of healing through prayers. Outwardly, medicines are also administered. However, it is by the application of will, that they bring about rectifications in

the vital body. Using this approach as a new age technique, Shambala works to bring about restoration of health in co-operation with the Hierarchy of Masters. This is a secret not known to many.

Saraswathi Suktam 8 Beyond anyone's possession 3



- 12. a huge tree with shadow giving branches sprawling around

- 14. a table of a mountain which is generally inaccessible for human habitation Also these signs given by nature are enough hints for you to become extra alert and get silent to relate to the energy of an ashram. When you encounter such places, such skies as stated above, you will have to stay quiet, contemplate and relate to a possible etheric ashram.

The yantra of Vishnu is a 6-petalled Lotus, that of Vasudeva a 12-petalled lotus and that of Narayana an 8-petalled lotus. Normally books present the lotuses in a two-dimensional manner. All lotuses are three-dimensional. The lotus of Vishnu with 6 petals is but 3 petals in each layer with 2 layers. The lotus of Vasudeva is also of triangular petals in 4 layers. The lotus of Narayana is 2 petals in 4 layers.

On Healing

2. The Fundamental Understanding 10



The divine qualities function through soul and the bodily qualities function through mind, the reflection of the soul in the body. Soul carries light and mind carries logic. Soul carries love land mind carries emotion. Soul carries will, while mind carries desire, the selfish will. When the qualities of the soul superimpose upon the qualities of the body, the process is complete. Logic is the dim-light of the mind, which can be substituted by the brilliant light of the soul.

Likewise the muddy water of emotion can be distilled to gain the pure waters of love. Similarly the separative, selfish, individualistic will can be supplemented by the will divine. The process is called 'building up of Antahkarana Sareera'. In the future lessons we shall know in details that constant application of mind upon the soul makes the process easier and quicker.

Another understanding we gain in this context is that the soul qualities are immutable, unchangeable and eternal through creation, while the body qualities are ever changing. They are in mutation. The Light, Love and Will remain, while the desires, emotions and logic change. The soul remains but the body changes. If we observe carefully, there is a part in the human being that is eternal and immutable and there is another part, which is eternally mutable. One is stable. The other is changing. The stable one is called the Man, the Soul. The changing one is called his body. Man, the soul remains, but the body he functions through changes.



Rudra The Lord of Cosmic Will and Vibration

A few dimensions of Rudra 58 Lingam 2

The Lingams range from mud lingams, sand lingams, stone lingams, sacred stone lingams, precious stone lingams, precious metal lingams and crystal lingams. A Lingam is a Lingam in whichever material it is. It is the shape which is more important than the material. The depth of devotion enables the transmission of the blessing from the Lingam.

In India, the Seers conceived 12 most auspicious Lingams where the Lord Rudra can be experienced in an effulgent egg form of light. They are called Jyothirlingams. In China and South America there are huge stone formations in a perfect form of Lingams, which are amazingly beautiful and vibrant. The peaks of mountains are also seen as forms of Shiva Lingams. Pyramids are also seen as forms of Shiva Lingams. A double pyramid is a complete Shiva Lingam with sharp angles. When the angles are rounded up, it is considered to be more beneficial. Hence the original form of Shiva Lingam is the most auspicious.

Sree Sistla Rama Krishna Rao 1




Sree Sistla Rama Krishna Rao is popularly known in the world as a nail artist. He is a well known artist that scribes with nails and has scribed images relating to epics such as Ramayana, Mahabharata, Bhagavatam, etc.

Sree SRK Rao hails from a simple Brahmin family of Parvathipuram, in the Northern part of Andhra Pradesh, India. He is a simple house holder, holding normal responsibilities of the family, consisting of his wife and daughters. His lady is a staunch devotee of Lord Hanuman while Sree Rao minded the normal life, attending to his employment, to his friends and to his hobbies which included Saturday parties. He was accustomed to alcohol, as was normal with his friends and colleagues on Saturdays. As his children were growing in age, he was avoiding the family on Saturday evenings. His lady suggested to her husband that he may stay at home with his friends and enjoy his party and that she, along with children would go out to a temple of Hanuman or to the market for the household goods for the week getting into the down town. Sree Rao agreed to do so since he had immense love and even respect to his lady for her righteous and theistic practices. Days passed by until his 40's.

Once on a Saturday, Sree Rao was alone at home. Not a single friend turned out. He waited for a while. He thought he would conduct a party for himself on a solo basis with nuts and alcohol. He set up the articles on a table. He arranged bottles of aerated waters, a bottle of alcohol, a tumbler, an ice box and the nuts (peanuts and cashew nuts). In tune with time, everything emerges, grows, retreats, and merges. That is why we have time aspect also along with the aspect of awareness emerging. Paths to Shambala 7: Shambala. The Powerful

The focus of the Roerich's five-year journey through Central Asia was Shambala, the institution that, in the background, guides and protects humanity and is the mirror of its impact on people's culture, beliefs and experience. In "Shambhala - The Secret World Centre in the Heart of Asia" (1930), Nicholas Roerich collects his experiences as if in a kaleidoscope. In his opening narrative "Shambhala - The Radiant One", a person from the West questions a Buddhist monk of high rank about the existence and tasks of this world center.

After having been convinced of the credibility of his counterpart, the Lama is now ready to tell something about Shambala.

This ashram is well informed about all the happenings in the world. It not only has a high tower to observe what is going on, but also owns instruments suitable for this purpose and disposes of invisible powers to guide people and bring them help if necessary. The head of the ashram is called Rigden-jyepo by the Buddhists. Out of reverence, the Lama refuses to confirm that it is Lord Maitreya. The great Lord sometimes appears in human form at sunrise in a monastery. He speaks to a gathering of Lamas who listen to his prophecies with great reverence.

At the insistence of the questioner, the Lama confirms that the ashram has shifted its location from near Shigatse to various places, even unknown to him. Also, the Great Ones and their staff no longer showed themselves in public as they used to do it. But the messengers of Shambala "work along with great speed" and are constantly ready to "fulfil what has been ordered by the Great Wisdom".

In his exchange with the Lama, the interviewer mentions the upcoming events and the importance of Shambala for the New Era. The Lama confirms the assumption: Shambala is preparing. It has a vast army that is getting ready to fight in order to support the work of the planets for a New Age. Humanity is

threatened by the fires of the earth and air and Shambala, in union with the good forces of humanity, is trying to prevent a catastrophe.

"Is it true that new energies are being given to humanity?"

The Lama confirms this information. Shambala is establishing a "kingdom of righteousness" and is also giving new energies to humanity for this purpose. Inevitably, he says, there will be undesirable events when dealing with these forces. The armies of Shambala are gathering to put the enemies of righteousness in their place and to free the earth from dark forces. For this purpose, there is a strict separation between the followers of darkness and those of light. This requires a great effort of goodwill: "Everyone who wants to help in this great task will be rewarded a hundredfold."

Picture to the Month Scorpio - Fusion of Individual, Groupal and Planetary Kundalini








