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

Shambala 60: Transcendental travel

Recollect Shambala, bow down to the Lord Sanat Kumara, and tread the path of Lord Maitreya, the World Teacher.

Sudden deaths due to accidents, natural calamities or massacres, should be seen as a phase of constructive adjustments or rectifications in the subtle planes. When a family member departs, it disturbs the physical, vital and mental planes of the members of the family group. They find a new equilibrium in due course of time. There is a temporary respite to the departed being. When a being dies (physical), first thing one experiences, is an inexplicable state of comfort. Exiting the confines of the skeleton is the reason for such comfort. There is a feeling of sorrow in one's vital and mental planes, in the memory of one's family members. One is relieved of such suffering in a week's duration in that plane, which is about seven months in physical earth plane. Death can be seen as a phase of emancipation for the beings. The comfort that a being experiences after death is much greater than when taking to a form! Physical body is like a cage. The being that exits rejoices the unbound state, as much as a bird let out of the cage rejoices. Teachings are given at Shambala, about the process of death, the experiences during the death and the transformations that follow. To the knowers, death is seen as a change, and a process of transformation.

There is no fear of death to the ones that have received the touch of Shambala. They do not invite death, but as it approaches, they are courageous and are prepared for the transcendental travel. Thus, the approach is unique. Such is the touch of Shambala!

The Lord of the World



Just as the ice block made up of water floats in water, the physical body of the human being exists distinctly on the basis of inner man. Thus, there is the body on the physical plane distinct from its presiding intelligence (known as the inner man). Here the physical body is the world and the inner man presiding over it is the Lord of the World. The ice block when melted becomes one with water. Similarly in the subtler planes, the planes and the Lords of the planes remain as one. Each plane of existence is a body or vehicle to the Lord that presides over it. When ice block is turned into water the existence of the ice block is absorbed into the existence of water. When water turns into steam, the existence of water is absorbed into existence of steam, when the steam is absorbed into the air, the former loses its existence into the latter. Thus the grosser is absorbed into the subtler planes and in each and every plane the Lord of the Worlds exists with the respective planes as his body.


## The precision of utterance 6

There are schools where a bell is used to help people to get into contemplation and deep meditation. The sound of the bell is in many cases better than our throat. In Buddhist temples, the bell is used very effectively. This is a reminder that one day our throats should reverberate like the bell producing the necessary vibrations. Such should be the strength of the voice. One should have a metallic, magnetic and vibrant utterance. The hymn hints at it.

When we do so the darkness of ignorance and doubt are dispelled in us. The 'golden saw' cuts into pieces the lump of ignorance hidden within us. It enables the liberation of the utterer from bondage.



## Ashram Regulations for Entry



#### The cave 11

There can be a practice of three respirations and an interval to experience pulsation. Like that nine intervals can be experienced with nine sets of three respirations each. This set of 9x3=27 respirations together with the 9 intervals is called one unit of practice.

Three such units of practice can be carried out in each sitting. Thus in all, 81 respirations are practiced in 27 sets and the pulsation can be experienced 27 times during the intervals. Then one sitting of practice is complete.

Likewise, if three such sittings are made with an interval of eight hours in a day, the practice is completed for a day.

If this practice is continuously done in this manner for 2 1/2 years or 30 months, the student can find himself in deep association with the pulsating principle. This pulsating principle is the basis of respiration.

#### On Secret Doctrine

#### Maruts 3



The Vayu Purâna shows, and Harivansa corroborates, that the Maruts — the oldest as the most incomprehensible of all the secondary or lower gods in the Rig Veda — "are born in every manyantara (Round) seven times seven (or 49); that in each Manvantara, four times seven (or twenty-eight) they obtain emancipation, but their places are filled up by persons reborn in that character." What are the Maruts in their esoteric meaning, and who those persons "reborn in that character"? In the Rigveda and other Vedas, the Maruts are represented as the storm gods and the friends and allies of Indra. They are the "Sons of heaven and of earth." This led to an allegory that makes them the children of Siva, the great patron of the Yogis, "the Maha-Yogi, the great ascetic, in whom is centred the highest perfection of austere penance and abstract meditation, by which the most unlimited powers are obtained, marvels and miracles are worked, the highest spiritual knowledge is acquired, and union with the great spirit of the universe is eventually gained." In the Rig Veda the name Siva is unknown, but the god is called Rudra, which is a word used for Agni, the fire god, the Maruts being called therein his sons. 1

Unless Vayu is favorable, you cannot experience any plane of existence; be it material plane, vital plane, mental plane, buddhic plane, the plane of bliss, the plane that which we call the plane of atman or the Soul or Paramatman, the Universal Soul. Vayu is the basis. Vayu in its seven-fold aspects are the seven Maruths.

Vayu or the cosmic intelligence of air, is one of the fifteen cosmic intelligences. If Vayu does not function well, there will be connection and

disconnection. The seven Maruths conduct seven winds and have their source in cosmic intelligence, Vayu.

The Vayu emerges from Rudra - the chief intelligence of the cosmic person.

The hierarchy of Maruths is

Cosmic person;

Rudra;

Vayu;

Maruths.

That is how it is four fold.

The cosmic person come from the cosmic egg. The cosmic egg has come through the twenty-seven elements that emerge from the cosmic nature.

The cosmic nature comes from Parabrahman or absolute God. .1

Sri Krishna statue installed by Master KPK in Wermelskirchen, Germany



Thus Narada opens the eye (of comprehension) and asks Vedavyasa to see with his (Narada's) eye, where he finds the whole creation as Krishna. Until then his comprehension of Krishna was different. After Narada's initiation his comprehension was complete and total. That is why if you see certain narrations in Mahabharata and the narrations in Srimad Bhagavatha, written by the same grand seer Vedavyasa, there is a difference.

There are people who utter OM but they don't listen. The next step for them is to listen to that which they utter. When you utter OM you can listen provided you have developed the faculty to listen in the day to day life. If we really utter OM and completely listen to it, by the time we utter it three times, we are already within and forget the outside.

Our mind is very inquisitive and tries to trace the source from which the sound is coming. When we are uttering OM, where is it becoming audible in us? The mind would like to know. That is how the mind goes inside to trace the origin of the sound.

When you trace the origin, you will find that it is being uttered even after you have stopped uttering it physically. It is a happening and on that happening there are many periodical manifestations of sounds. We have to try to identify ourselves with the imperceptible sound that is happening within. That sound is what we call the sound ANAHATA.





#### Sree Satya Sai Baba 2



Suppression of disease

The orthodox medicine ignores this natural functioning of the vital system and straight away deals with the sickness. In doing so the cause for sickness remains unaddressed and the sickness is suppressed. The suppressed sickness emerges through other ways in a more powerful way. Today there are many sicknesses which are getting tougher for cure. In the medical field it is viewed that the medical system is not appropriately addressing the sickness, and that the sickness reappears in different forms. Such was the understanding of visionaries like Paracelsus, Hahnemann and the like, who saw the futility of the allopathic approach to cure.



## Master EK Vishnu Sahasranama

Stanza 4, 1-5

सर्वश्शवं श्शिवः स्थाणु भूतादिः निधि ख्ययः। संभवो भावनो भर्ता प्रभवः प्रभुरीश्वरः॥

#### Meaning:

Invoke Him as all and everything; as Siva, the Lord of auspiciousness; stable as a rock, the origin of all beings and as the unspendable hidden treasure and contribution of all. He is the Lord of occurance, the source and the goal of imagination, the one who maintains all. He is the Lord of emanation and the Lord of all and everything as well as the Lord of splendours.

#### Explanation:

1. All means that the Lord pervades all. Here all includes creation and beyond creation.

- 2. Sarva means the Lord of the dissolution or merging of the creation.
- 3. Sivah means the Lord who is the embodiment of auspiciousness. Realise gradually that whatever occurs contributes to the ultimate well-being.
- 4 Just as the rock is stablest of all, that is on the physical plane, the Lord is the stablest of all the creation. He forms the very content that stands eternally. On His surface, everything floats.
- 5. The origin of beings is the monad which descends as Jeeva or permanent atom (refer Secret Doctrine by H. P. Blavatsky).





Paracelsus Health and Healing

Prana - life force, part IV Devas of golden hue and sunlight 1

The relation between the Devas of golden hue and man is very close. These Devas are powerful and are highly beneficial in nourishing man's life, once the process of their reception and assimilation by man's etheric body and distribution to man's physical body is scientifically understood. Indiscreet exposure to the rays of Sun is highly dangerous. Unprotected, man lies at the mercy of the solar radiation resulting in the menace of sunstrokes, sun burns and sun spots. Man should be intelligent enough to protect himself from the dangers of solar radiation and yet receive, daily, the solar energy through the golden rays of the morning and evening sun. #### Paths to Shambala 1: Understanding Cosmic Life

Despite great challenges, people from all over the world have been trying to reach a mysterious place in Tibet and its mountains since the mid-19th century. In the tradition of Asia, it is revered as the abode of great beings who protect and eventually save the humanity. Due to the theosophical movement, this knowledge had reached the West and the question of the real existence of the place motivated the curious, the adventurous and the spiritual, alike. Humanity longed for change, the end of the dull materialism of a dark age full of hatred, competition and warfare.

Before Lord Krishna left his body 5,000 years ago, he secured the protection of the divine law by appointing Lord Maitreya as the protector of the purity of the doctrine and inspiring the assembly of Rishis. He also appointed Master Morya as the guardian of the spiritual administrative law of the earth. For these guardians, Master Morya established inaccessible abodes that became known as Shambala and Kalapa.

Chinese tradition calls the Kunlun Mountains, the "Abode of the Gods." It was there, 1000 years before Christ, that the then reigning Chinese emperor was said to have met Kwan Yin, the Goddess of Mercy. And Lao-tzu had referred to the mountains as the headquarters of the Great White Brotherhood. There were several places where the "Abode of the Gods" was believed to be - all the way to Shigatse near the ancient Tibetan capital of Lhasa.

This was also the environment in which Jesus had taught and lived after his crucifixion and resurrection: in Leh, a town on the southern edge of the Karakoram Mountains - the locals knew.

Tibet bordered the spheres of influence of many states, including three great powers: India, which was dominated by the British, the Soviet Union and China. They observed a state ruled by monks. The rivalries between the great powers

caused their intelligence services to react neurotically to any stranger who even approached Tibet. As if the geological and climatic challenges of moving into Tibet were not obstacle enough, the political conditions made access almost impossible. Madame Blavatsky failed twice in the mid-19th century despite all her efforts, and it was only the company of her Master that enabled her to reach Shambala (1868).

So, what motivated Nicholas Roerich and his wife Helena to travel through Central Asia? Were they seeking the path to Shambala? Although their journey, which lasted almost 5 years, is well documented (diaries, letters, cash books of the material expenditure and - last but not least, the records of the secret services), the Roerichs confused friends and enemies with statements of the most diverse motives, which caused headaches for their biographers.

Even the chosen itinerary seemed less that of spiritual seekers than that of adventurers. They started their journey south-west of the Himalayas and encountered the first challenges of their journey in the Karakoram Mountains, in front of the Kunlun Mountains from the south. Through Turkestan, via (Moscow!), they passed Siberia from west to east, then turned south again, through Mongolia to Tibet. They endeavoured to enter Lhasa, the capital of Tibet, as their final destination. Why did the Roerichs travel over 5,000 kilometres through Central Asia if Shambala was their destination? A journey over 35 inaccessible mountain passes from 14,000 to 21,000 feet in altitude, through sandy deserts and according to experiences - as Roerich notes "without the conventional sentimentality", they saw "much light and justifiably harmful darkness". A journey that not only pushed them to their physical breaking point, but also put their trust in their spiritual guide, Master Morya, to a severe test? They had understood his instruction:

The experience of travelling gives the best key to understanding cosmic life. The true traveller ... thinks about the path that lies behind him and clearly expresses the desired direction. He will evaluate future circumstances and anticipate the better possibilities." (Adapted from: R. A. Drayer)


