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

Serpent 'K' loosens its skin. The pictures of past Karma on the walls of its skin are peeled off. Karma neutralised.



Taurus has been linked to Lord Krishna since his appearance on this planet. The legend goes that the matter of this planet was not fine enough to be made into a body for Lord Krishna and hence the then World Teacher Parasara made a ritual and ultimately sacrificed himself, so that matter could be created fine enough for the body for Lord Krishna.



The work of today's Hierarchy and the present World Teacher, whom we know as Maitreya or as the Christ, started 5,000 years ago. In that incarnation, Maitreya was a prince of Benares. In his youth he learned about the then World Teacher, Parasara. He met the master in the Himalayas and joined his group of students. Parasara revealed to him the divine plan for the coming cycle. As Lord Krishna left this planet, he gave the magical etheric body to Maitreya who became our World Teacher.

The full moon in the lunar month of Taurus is dedicated to the Hierarchy on this

planet and the legend says that Lord Buddha appears and blesses Maitreya and the Hierarchy for the current yearly cycle.

There is another sublime idea related to Taurus, the Divine Word (Vak), its manifestation in four steps from the subtle to the gross.


It starts from the background consciousness, which is undefined, we call it the Para state (Aquarius) or beyond. Then there are two subjective states called Pasyanti (Pisces) and Madhyama (Aries), representing the idea as an abstract concept and then becoming more manifest into a mental language. Finally, the objective world is reached in the Vaikhari state (Taurus) represented by our vocal speech.

This four-fold division can be applied to our Cosmos (the Milky Way or our galaxy), our Universe (the solar system) and to Man (the mental being living on this planet).

In the human etheric body the zodiacal signs correspond to chakras or a state of consciousness. Taurus and Pisces are located in the physical body in the pineal and the pituitary bodies. A link between the pineal and the pituitary bodies has to be constructed by the disciple as the higher bridge. This is also called the birthplace of Indra (Indra Yoni). The higher bridge serves as the third eye in us. This centre is located above the Ajna centre.

As we walk the path of discipleship, we travel on the reversed wheel from Libra to Taurus and as we reach Taurus we will stand face to face with God, meaning we have vanquished the serpent of Scorpio.

Learn to turn inward at an early age 2

When the building is on paper, the changes can be made easily. Before we make this building, we draw it on a paper. Any changes are easy at that stage. Once it is built, it is possible but with a greater effort and breaking may be necessary. To erase is easier, to break is difficult; difficult for the student but not for the teacher. Therefore it is easier if someone practices to turn inward at a tender age. Tender age is 7 years according to our Scriptures. The later it is, the tougher it becomes. It is possible, though the prayers have to be very ardent and sincere.

Let things be around you but you do not get into them. Let them be free around you. Let them not bother you. You stay above them. There may a very mundane thing around you but it does not matter if you stand out of it. This is what is called Vairagya. One should have a detached attitude towards everything around you including your body. It causes trouble. It is your house. Not all houses are comfortable and if the house is of trouble mostly people sleep in it.

Utterances of Lord Krishna



While sitting also, let the body be erect without tension. Sit perpendicular, and you are vertical. Verticals and horizontals meet to cross one another at the point of contact 'I AM'. Vertical consciousness symbolizes subjectivity. Horizontal consciousness symbolizes objectivity. Let the verticals and horizontals cross one another in a happy blend. Your mind is different from yourself. Yet your mind is yourself. It is the gateway between your subjective and objective experience. Bring yourself to yourself, with the help of your mind. Physical stability may not bring mental stability, but it is conducive. Sit stable. Think of something. Now you want something to visualise and think of. You think of the tip of your nose wherefrom the pulsations pass to and fro. Don't think of any object distant from yourself. Distance is your pervasion as mind. Travel from circumference to centre mentally. Slowly and peacefully, peace approaches you. Remember that the approach is very subtle. The approaches you peacefully. It approaches you as the glowing 'I AM.'

Total absence of objectivity is the total absence of fear. It is new to you. Yet, it is natural with you. It is the culmination of your own nature into you. You are instinctively at home with peace, because you have no instincts by now. Remember you should be a celibate while practising this! Do you think that celibacy is obtained by physical cessation of sex impulses? No woman presence, no celibacy? Childish! There is woman in man as a concept, and man in woman as a concept. Then why talking about physical celibacy? Eliminate the woman in you by a process of transformation. Transform the woman presence in you by the presence of Me in you. Now you are a real celibate. Now you live as a Creator in the Cosmic Consciousness. Dwell in Me, you have controlled your mind. Dwell in yourself while dwelling in Me, and you are already a yogi. (6, 13,14)

Through the ashram of Ibez in the Ameru mountain ranges, Lord Sanat Kumara developed the science of Magic. Chiefly, the science of rituals, science of time and the science of Sound; that enable magical manifestations were taught by the Masters of Wisdom. These sciences were taught to manifest the divine light on the planet and to enable the divine touch (experience) to the beings on the planet.

In the past, the development of humanity was devoid of growth of mental faculties, discrimination, common sense, and a spirit of enquiry. There was a complete surrender to the teacher. In complete faith, life was conducted according to his word. There was no independent thought. Faith was the basis. The approach of the time was faith based, since the development of the mental faculties in the humanity was inadequate. Thus, to bring about unfoldment in the mental layers of the humanity, it became necessary to impart these sciences.

Till recently, it was a method of instruction by the elders and following by the younger ones in good faith. The transformations so far, are very visible if we make a comparative study of the past with the present.

The younger ones following the instructions of the elders in good faith, was the method so far. With the unfoldment of the mental faculties, the children today are of independent nature, enquiring with the elder ones and tending to function with knowledge. Zodiacal Symbols 2: Taurus





This symbol is formed by the semi-circle standing on a circle. This represents the two converging horns of a bull. The Sun passing through this sign is compared with the bull showering down his summer rays which prepare the earth for the fertilisation.

Summer is really the cause of the

formation of the clouds which will rain to fertilise the earth. Through ages this sign is associated with Aldebaran, the Star of the Bull, the rays of which cause rains to this earth. This sign is also associated with agriculture, hence the association of bull with agriculture is a constant one till today. The Fertilisation of the Cow by the Bull causes the beings which till the earth and also which supply milk to mankind.

For this reason, Taurus is symbolised as the sign of food, taste and eating. The semi-circle representing the horns also indicates the Moon who is situated above the circle. Moon is found to be in his exaltation in Taurus. The Bull is allegorised as the Vehicle of the Lord Siva. This means that the creation of food is the cause of the Lord descending into the bodies and living in the form of the many beings.

If we see the way of life of Rama, he was the foremost to greet the other with a smile and was the last to speak. The moment we greet with a smile, the other man also responds with a smile. There is the meeting of smiles, of eyes and the communion of souls. Should there be any further dialogue or conversation, let it start from the other side, not from you.

Friendliness is possible when there is no malice. When we utter the Word, we gain this friendliness and the malice in us is burnt. Then the Law is better understood and followed, we cannot be irresponsible. When the Law is followed irresponsibility disappears. We cannot be irresponsible anymore either in our speech or in our actions or in our movements. The Word enables transcendence of malice and irresponsibility. It establishes us in friendliness and love in the truest meaning.

Once we grow closer, we cannot be irresponsible. We cannot be out of tune with the Law. The Word helps us to gain proximity to the Master Consciousness in us and hence our speeches, thoughts and actions cannot be irresponsible. The invocation of this hymn appeals to the Word so that it may enable us to overcome malice, irresponsibility and to progress like the sun, who succeeds days and nights.

Ashram Regulations for Entry

Pranayama 2



When the mind is applied upon respiration regularly, mind gets absorbed into the beauty of happening of respiration and pulsation. Mind is a doer. Pulsation is a happening. Mind notices for the first time that within the being, there is a principle of continuous happening regardless doing. By inference, mind notices that even while at sleep the pulsation continues to be, while the mind ceases to be. It knows not its state of existence in sleep, while pulsation continues to be, regardless one's state of sleep or dream or awakening. Mind gets inquisitive to observe how respiration and pulsation are happening in oneself. The inquisitive nature of the mind dipping deep through inhalation finds the pulsating principle and engages itself with the principle. The inquiring mind would like to see the very cause of pulsation. It therefore waits at the heart to observe the eternally pulsating principle. It leaves behind the respiration activity and engages itself with the pulsating activity (the related practice is already detailed herein above).

Thus prana and apana (inhalation and exhalation) are relegated into the background and their neutral state of poise is gained at the pulsating centre by the observing mind. The poised state of prana and apana is called samana.

1. Narayana is the 'One' in whom the devotee finds the ultimate liberation of his individual consciousness.

2. There is the first call of everything into existence from the background of the Lord. The background is relatively understood as non-existence.

3. The call is always from within the background. It is called the first stir or awakening. This call is called Vashat, the call for 'vas' or existence.

4. It is the Lord who makes himself live as the creation. He is therefore called 'Vashatkarah' in the 1000 names of Lord Vishnu.

5. The ritualist repeats this before he meditates. This is by way of imitating the work of the Lord. By this, he gets into the awakening of the Lord.



On Healing

2. The Fundamental Understanding 16



The sacred science of healing works up to transformation of the mental and emotional attitudes of those who are affected. It thus has larger area of operation than mere attendance to physical diseases. The chronic physical diseases are the effects for which the causes exist in the thoughts and emotions entertained by a being. Physical discomforts can be overcome by use of physical substances, which are known as medicinal substances. Subtle physical need to be tackled with subtle substances. That is what we see as flower remedies or Homoeo remedies. Subtler and subtlest matter, such as thoughts need to be cured by subtle and sublime methods such as colour, sound and meditation.

The Science of Healing, therefore, predominantly deals with the forces functioning within the body than with the gross physical body as such. The curative methods such as sounds, colours, symbols, meditational techniques are also subtle forces. They attempt at psychical adjustment of the apparatus, which in turn causes the adjustment of the apparatus too. The rectification is from subtle to gross and from cause to effect. The Science of Healing is therefore not far from the Science of Yoga.

Lord Rudra is frequently called Bhola. He is as compassionate as he is fierce. He gets easily pleased with a little observed austerity and gets inclined to bless and help. The term also means that he presides over Dakshina, the South. South in us is the heart centre. He presides over the heart centre and transmits his love and compassion. The Sound Key 2



This knowledge of sound disappeared in the West concurrent to the disappearance of Atlantis. The disappearance of Atlantis is attributed to abuse of the sound key. After Atlantis a chosen few constituting the seed of the Aryans started working with sound. The sounds once again are spreading from East to West in the Aryan race. These sounds are neither Eastern nor Western. All used them in the remote past. Aquarian Age is once again transmitting the sounds globally.

Sanat Kumara instructs to work with sound. Sound enables transformation of body tissues. It generates fire that transforms the body cells. The body is like a tree that bears flowers. Through appropriate utterance of sound and through ardent worship the etheric centres of the body can be transformed into etheric lotuses. The etheric centres function like whirlpools of energy. The movement of energy in a whirlpool is circular. The sounds enable a change in the movement of energies from being circular to be unfolding. Unfoldment of energies from within releases man from the conditioning nature of the gross physical body. The unfoldments gradually lead to building the etheric body (golden body) and causal body (diamond body).

The incoming 7th Ray permeates the world and gains momentum and brings into world the souls that inherit the quality of 7th Ray. Each ray when it comes in, brings with it high souls that inherently hold its qualities. They will initially face resistance and will enter the phase where they face least resistance. Sree Appalacharya Swamy was accessible to all, for advice and guidance. He did not set himself on a higher pedestal as a teacher, Guru or a Master. He remained humble and simple throughout. It was in the year 1993 that the first encounter happened between Saukumarya and Sree Appalacharya. The latter embarked upon publishing Sreemad Ramayana in simple Telugu which is originally written in Sanskrit by Sage Valmiki. Sreemad Ramayana is known as the first scripture of the world and the Sage Valmiki is known as the first author. Ramayana is a very popular epic, in and around the Indian continent and is the most admired of the epics. When the project of presenting a simple translation of the epic in Telugu was introduced, it attracted attention of many. Saukumarya was one of them. To look up in the occult sense is to look in. The two missing states are within you. And you can reach them through a bridge. That bridge is being built by Uranus. Udana Prana again is in its triple functioning as given here under: Just like Vyana is related to Akasha principle, Udana is related to the principle of Vayu (air). Since air emerges from Akasha, the fifth element, Udana Prana emerges from Vyana Prana and exists in the region above and below the throat. All functions of the throat are related to Udana Prana. All foods and drinks are enjoyed through this Prana. It imparts strength to all other Pranas emerging from Vyana - thereby imparts strength to all parts of the body. It enables to swallow from without to within and throw out from within to without. It enables impressive and magnetic speech. It attracts Prana up to the heart and carries it from heart to brain. It enables exchange of energies between head and heart and vice versa. It links subtle and causal bodies. When this Prana is mastered even hunger and thirst can be controlled for long time. Lastly this Prana enables the neck and the body to be erect. Since this Prana emerges from the most subtle side of the human being and merges back into that state it can be seen as the agent for externalisation of consciousness and its internalisation. This gives clue for all the techniques of Yoga of expansion of consciousness into objectivity and contraction of consciousness into subjectivity. Man's head is said to be carrying subtlest energies. The upper torso carries subtler energy. And the lower torso carries grosser than subtler energies. Udana Prana enables linkup between the first two for appropriate functioning of the third. This Prana is by far the most important one for man's evolution measured in terms of consciousness.

The Female Hierarchy



Part 14

The God Absolute, which is beyond creation, is the potential for all that is in creation. When it manifests, the primary manifestation would normally be male-female. There is never a situation where there is only male or only female. This has to be cleared in the very beginning. "In the beginning there was male, and then a female came through..." - all this is a very secondary understanding which does not fall in line with the ancient scriptures. The male and the female manifest at the same time. Therefore, they are equal. This equality is there because the very primary manifestation is male-female. Before that male-female, there was that pure existence, which you cannot call either as male or as female. To call God "he" or "she" is a partial understanding. It leads to lot of biases. There is a bias for the male against the female, and many times in the scriptures God is referred to as he. God is he and she at all times. There is a "he" part and there is a "she" part and it remains together from the most absolute state to the most dense, gross physical state. One cannot exist without the other. In the unmanifest state, it is the togetherness of it which is called IT or THAT, but never he or she. God Absolute is neither he nor she. It is IT, it is THAT. When we say God, already it is biased - there is also goddess.

The God and goddess together should be understood as God. If this understanding is established, there is no bias, and there is no predominance of one over the other. Who is superior, who is inferior, who should oblige whom - all this emerge out a very biased understanding of that energy which we call God. For want of terms we use certain terms and many times those terms distort the very truth. When we say God, we generally get the understanding that it is male. It is not so. When we say God, it is male-female energy. When we say Absolute God, it is IT or THAT, which cannot be called male, and cannot be called female. This is the classical understanding. Therefore, those who

know they do not have this kind of thinking that who is superior to whom and all that. They are equal at all times. The ancient wisdom never place male in a superior position to female, and (never place) female in superior position to male. That should be the first understanding. In male there is female, and in female there is male. When the two energies are equally balanced in us, we have an ideal state of experiencing. If one is dominant over the other either way, the experiencing is not complete. This understanding must be there. Therefore, as much as there is a Male Hierarchy, there is also Female Hierarchy. That is how the Female Hierarchy came to be.


