

Suktam 4 Spiritual Food 2

There are many occasions when the Great Ones eat large quantities in an untimely manner. If someone is hungry and invokes a Great One, He will ensure that He will eat food so that the hungry man receives the energy. Today this may seem like fiction, but it is the science of tomorrow. The distribution of energy is possible. Sometimes the Great Ones demand great quantities of food at an untimely hour and eat, because somewhere a group of people is in hunger due to the work that they are involved in. If a disciple is engaged in an important work and doesn't have time to look for food, the Master eats for him and the disciple receives adequate energy. This is a higher dimension. This formula cannot yet be adopted by non-initiates. When we shift our emphasis from the material to the spiritual food, we are fulfilled with spiritual food. We do not feel hungry. That is called fasting, not abstaining from food. Engrossed with the Universal Soul and the work relating to the Plan, we do not desire to eat, because the spiritual food nourishes us and satiates hunger. Yogis in the advanced states, secrete a drop from their higher Throat Centre, the larynx. This drop is called Soma in Sanskrit. This drop of Soma nourishes the body for six months. These facilities exist for those who work with the Plan. One cannot demand them. They are accomplished during the process of realizing the Word.

Regular invocation of the Word first causes purification of the Throat Centre Visuddhi. The purified Throat Centre enables the purification of the 3 lower centres: Solar Plexus, Sacral and Base Centres. Secondly, the awareness of man ascends to the etheric plane -the plane of golden Light. Invocations, incantations and chanting, when pursued as per the science

of Mantra, would cause the formation of the body of Light within the body of flesh and blood. The throat secretes the hunger satiating fluids called Soma; thus, the hunger is met from a higher dimension than what the modern, mundane man knows. Later comes the stage of eating for others. Of course, the whole process is oversimplified, for the moment. It has many more details.¹

Application of Sound 'A' 2

Another term for 'A' is IT. 'A', THAT and IT are the terms used in Veda for the TRUTH. The TRUTH is neither male nor female. It is the source of the two. Therefore in Veda, the Omnipotent is never spoken as 'he' or 'she'. The 'Omnipotent One' is spoken as THAT, IT, TRUTH or 'A'.

An aspirant is required to recollect THAT in all surroundings without fail. And when one looks to oneself, one should also recollect oneself as THAT. This is the fundamental practice. An aspirant needs to gradually see THAT as oneself, THAT as wife and THAT as children and so on. THAT exists as foe as well. One should be able to see THAT in anything and everything. Such practice must be attempted so that THAT appears in the first instance, and the quality and form appear as its precipitate. When this practice is fulfilled, the sound 'A' of ashram is fulfilled. With regard to this practice many popular stories exist. One of them is narrated in this context.

The Truth of Fsoterism



The true ideal deity, the one living God in nature, can never suffer in man's worship of the fanciful deities created by men and thrown upon the original deity by the crafty hands of priests greedy of power and domination. There is but one universal deity who would eventually dethrone all other man-made deities, for truth prevails and would have lasted long over the ignorant, childish humanity in infancy. The God of Immutable Law would eventually replace the poor God of Charity. The God of Justice and just retribution would eventually replace the God of Mercy - which is merely an incentive to an evil doing and to a repetition of it.

The greatest crime that was ever perpetrated upon mankind was committed on that day when the first priest of the planet invented the first prayer with a selfish objective in view. Prayers carried out to bless the worshipper and send defeat and death to thousands of his enemies who are no other than his brethren is but a self-deceit.

"Prayer is a noble action when it is an intense feeling, an ardent desire rushing forth from one's heart for the good of other people"; a true prayer is entirely detached from many selfish personal objects. A craving for that which is beyond and holy is natural provided such an act is done to share the related bliss with others. Socrates said, "Our prayers should be for blessing on all in general, for the gods know best what is good for us".

Official prayers for the benefit of one individual irrespective of losses to others are the most ignoble crimes besides being impertinent, conceit and a superstition. Charging fee for prayers is but adding a cherry on the top of a poisonous ice cream.

Moses had initiated seventy elders into the hidden truths and therefore the writers of the Old Testament stand justified to a certain degree. Those of the New Testament have failed to do so. They have disfigured the grand central

figure of Christ by their dogmas and have led people ever since into millions of errors and the darkest of crimes. All is done in his holy name. Except for Paul and Clement of Alexandria who had been both initiated into the mysteries, none of the fathers knew much of the Truth. They were mostly uneducated and ignorant people. They were so painfully ignorant until the name of Galileo emerged on the screen. Pope Urban VIII denied the knowledge of heliocentric system and went ahead to persecute the scientist Galileo. Such ignorance prevails till date in most of the religious establishments who propagate a name and a form of God, denying the universal deity who presides over the laws of nature.

Blunders have been fathered through centuries by the so-called fathers, cardinals and popes for the vital truths were never taught nor were learned by any of these priests that acclaimed to be the truth bearers and the torch bearers. Only select few know that the two great names of Judaism namely Jehovah and Elohim stood for numerical values of diameter and circumference. They are numerical indices of geometrical relations. So are the names of Caine and such other villains of the Old Testament. One would feel great relief to note the fact that the Asiatic wisdom proclaims their esoterism openly. There are no secrets to be hidden. As much as man dwells into himself, the revelations happen. As long as he tends outwards, things remain to be secretive and esoteric. 
The Path of Narayana

The Qualities of Sound Mind (From the Laws of Right Relationship)

Glamour and Illusion 6

The average man over estimates his mental powers. He is characterized by pronounced and developed illusions, by emotional, prejudiced, critical, separative attitudes and by specious arguments. His horizon is limited, his vision myopic, his mind small, non-inclusive, understocked and under developed. Illusion is the mode whereby his limited understanding and untrained mind interprets truth. These illusions then become the truth, control his viewpoint and create a barrier between him and reality. The cure is wider knowledge and mental training, resulting in discrimination, clear thinking, correct perception, and right values. This frees from illusion, negative receptivity, arrogance, separativeness and emotional control.

Man, a spiritual being, is immersed in a physical body. This body is so close to us as powerfully to delude us, and here is to be found another cause of illusion. We do not identify ourselves with the spiritual nature, qualities and objectives, but interpret life in terms of physical, emotional and mental experience. Freeing oneself from identification with the body and identifying oneself with the soul will release us from that realm of illusion. The physical world is not the hole of reality - live more in the world of spiritual realities, it is a truer and more satisfying word. When, restless and unhappy, sensing that something is wrong, we have cultivated true vision, and then we shall have the subsiding into the background of the glamour, illusion and power of the form nature.

70. Chakrarajamanahatodbhavam

The one who expresses through the king of chakras namely the anahata chakra



The anahata chakra is considered the most ideal state for the being to settle and to dwell. All the Upanishads and Scriptures recommend for settlement in the anahata where there is the muse of BE-ness. The Anahata is centrally placed and is therefore considered as the Yogic centre. All Yogis prefer to reside there. There are three centres above the anahata and three centres below the anahata which is known to every preliminary student of Yoga. The centre in the head is the centre for Will. The centre beyond the head relates to receiving the plan of work from higher circles. The centre relating to the throat enables one to execute the plan with the help of sound and also with the help of the mind, the senses and the body. When the work is done one needs to reach home and stay blissful musing with the Divine. The heart centre represents such a blissful centre of BE-ness. It is equidistant to the higher and the lower centres. A student is neither very highly placed nor very lowly placed when he settles in the heart. The heart is not a place for work. It is a place for BE-ness. One can bring the mind to the heart and work out actions of love. When the labours are done, one can withdraw into the deeper chambers of the heart. It is like coming home after labours are done. It is the place of rest, place of musing with the super-soul and is also the place from where one can permeate through the love of the heart.

The centres below the diaphragm are the centres relating to the body and the mind. It is like a vehicle upon which one is recommended to mount and conduct the work; when the work is done, the body and mind can be restituted and one can rejoice integrating with the Divine in the deeper chambers of the heart. Staying in the heart one can receive with facility the plan of the work and conduct it without excessively indulging into the act of doing. Each one of us is a being. Periodically we enter into doing. When the deeds are done away with, one comes back to BE.

For various reasons the Upanishads, the texts of Yoga and Bhagavad Gita extol the anahata chakra. It is the ultimate place of bliss that one can settle into. It's also the true abode of the soul. Lord Krishna says in the Bhagavad Gita, "O Arjuna, in all the beings I AM seated in the heart. Tune up your mind to ME in the heart and experience the bliss of BE-ness."

Every student is strongly recommended to meet his Teacher or Master of wisdom in the deeper-most chambers of his heart and muse with the presence of the Master or Teacher.

When a disciple waits in the heart to receive the Teacher, he stands a good chance to receive the Teacher and experience the bliss of his presence.

In the heart you are neither with the three worlds of material nor are you into the absolute realms of Spirit. Spirit and Matter find their agreement in the heart and therefore waiting for the Teacher in the heart would enable experiencing the Divine and translating the work of the Divine upon earth. This is the major work inaugurated by Lord Krishna through Maitreya, the World Teacher, i.e. to manifest the Kingdom of God upon Earth.

Very early in the morning I recollect the holy sandals of the Master in the inner chamber of my heart.

Sound

Sound Subjective and Sound Objective 2



Sound, as we now understand it, is the disturbance of silence. Whenever silence is disturbed there is sound. But there is also sound beyond silence. Sound exists beyond silence and sound exists below silence. Silence is the gateway for the sound to come through, just like the sky is the gateway for the sound to manifest the Creation. The Sound beyond silence is called "The Voice of the Silence".

That which we know as Akasha or Ether is the silver screen upon which there is the manifestation of the Creation through sound. Silence is the neutral state of sound and there is a sound esoteric, beyond silence. We can make a triangle of the sound and it appears like this:

Silence is the neutral point, sound subjective is the eternally existing sound, and sound objective is what we are aware of. The objective sound is nothing but the disturbance of silence. Each time we disturb the silence there is the sound. That is the sound we are aware of. It is called the sound negative. The sound which is subjective, that is, beyond silence, is called the sound positive. We only know the sound which is negative, but a spiritually realized person knows the sound positive.

Each time such a person speaks, he brings down sounds from the Higher Planes and not from the lower planes. Thus, the sound positive relates to the Higher Planes. This is called the Higher Triangle which contains the sound that comes from the Head Centre, the Ajna Centre and the Heart Centre.

Practically speaking, when the student invokes the presence of the Master with the passwords and proposes to his mind the idea and picture of the Master, the process begins. This process begins in the mind of the disciple with the activity of Master as blessing. One should not concentrate his mind upon the Master or Mantram. One should not repeat the 'Mantram' a number of times with effort. Effort makes a man live in his mind. With increase of effort he gets stuck up in the mind. Propose the Master in the mind and submit the mind to him with ease. Let the mind wander wherever it wants to go, but be observing it passively. Thus, the observer mind learns to keep off from the wandering mind. The Master consciousness fills the observer mind like a railway guard who gets down from the train to set the train in motion and gets into the train after the train is set in motion. This lower mind finally merges into the observer mind. Thus the Master consciousness begins to construct HIGHER BRIDGE in the disciple.

Working with the Seventh Ray


Question: Dear Master, what are the tangible unfoldments as one works with seventh ray on the physical plane?

Star 17: Anuradha



Anuradha is known as the "constellation of success". Imagine an upward moving creeper of stars at the beginning of Scorpio. This creeper is named Anuradha. Anuradha is all about love, devotion and passion that inspires and motivates all actions. Compassion, tenderness, romance, and desire to give and receive affection describe a few qualities of Anuradha.

The natives of Anuradha try to treat others well and expect others also to treat them well. They are truthful in their speech and they uphold the truth. They are disturbed when others utter forth untruth. They hold others to their high standards and expect them to perform as much as they do. They get disappointed generally because they set high standards of performance. They are devoted in their work and often make good professionals. They are committed to work and success is guaranteed when they associate with any work. For this reason, Anuradha is called a constellation of success.

Their truthful speech can become a blunt weapon and hurt others. Though

compassion is their nature, their hurtful words create discord here and there.

Anuradha natives are good ritualists, worshippers and can be good masons. They admire rhythm, ritual, and are generally in a state of muse while in rhythm.

Anuradha stands for Aniruddha, the fourth dimension of the cosmic deity who is considered practical and invincible. The fourth dimension of the deity sits in the mind, while the other three dimensions are posited in buddhi, atma (soul), and paramatma (super-soul). Since Anuradha is awareness posited in the mind, the natives of Anuradha are considered particularly suited to



manifest the work of the higher planes into the lower planes. They are anchors who anchor the work upon earth. The Leonine natives as also the Aquarians find their manifestation through Anuradha, says a Master of wisdom.

Anuradha is in the initial part of the sun sign Scorpio and represents the head of a scorpion. While a scorpion can be spiteful, it is not so with Anuradha, since the poison of the scorpion is in its tail but not in its head. In a snake the poison is at the head; in a scorpion the poison is in its tail (in man it is generally believed that poison spreads from head to tail). People would do well not to stimulate (irritate) a scorpion, because if they do so, they will get stung.

The cosmic deity for Anuradha is Mitra, whose representative on the planet is Lord Maitreya. The natives of Anuradha are ruled by the virtue of friendliness. Through their devotional and ritualistic practices, they gain the cooperation of Mitra and tend to be a good friend, a friend that does not fail. Their friendliness enables them to build bridges between different persons, different groups and even different nations. Their words inspire others to action. The cosmic deity Mitra is known to build the bridges between heaven and earth. Just as Indra and Agni form a team in the Visakha constellation, Mitra and Varuna form a team in the Anuradha constellation to establish order in the society. The natives of Anuradha would do well to relate to this cosmic deity. Hanuman is the lord of this constellation. He has all the invincibility, virtue, knowledge, friendliness, simplicity, ritualism and devotion. The worship of Hanuman is also propitious to the natives of Anuradha.

Since Saturn is the ruler, Anuradha natives commence their life with the karma of the Saturn. They have much family and social pressure. They have heavy duties and responsibilities that they have to shoulder. They should demonstrate good self-governance at all times. Their initial nineteen years are full of hard work, patience, perseverance and disappointments. Success follows thereafter, with Mercury taking over. The Saturn rulership also speaks of caring for the elderly and caring for the works of the departed ones.

Saturn is the ruler of Anuradha and Mars is the ruler of Scorpio. This Saturn-Mars combination brings in more difficulties until Anuradha natives cultivate in themselves the qualities of patience, tolerance and silence. Saturn is an inert, slow moving, passive and pessimistic energy while Mars is dynamic, fast moving, active and optimistic energy. Balancing the two in oneself through patience and tolerance brings the best out of Anuradha which would enable

one to use the double-edged talent appropriately to overcome the situations. The deadly combination of Saturn-Mars tends to be a boon when the native cultivates the needed discipline, patience and tolerance through ardent devotion, ritual and worship.

Saturn in Anuradha gives a regulating capacity and Mars gives penetrating ability. This combination enables Anuradha natives to be good self-governors and governors of others. Anuradha also stands for an umbrella. Many can shelter under Anuradha natives. They give umbrella- like protection, they also enable passage from one state of awareness to another through the upward moving creeper.

With Mitra and Varuna as the cosmic deities and Hanuman as the lord, when Anuradha balances Saturn-Mars through worship, ritual and prayers, the native of Anuradha tends to receive the grace of God. The native of Anuradha would do well by constantly recollecting, "By God's grace I fulfil and in God I live, I move, and have my being."

Kundalini Yoga is best suited for Anuradha, which the native eventually finds through years of prayers, worship and ritual.

The symbol of Anuradha is an unfolding lotus which represents the ability and determination to blossom amidst life's great difficulties. The power of Anuradha natives is in their worship. While one meaning of Anuradha is

Aniruddha, another meaning is "a flash of lightening". The waist and the lower abdominal parts relate to Anuradha. The ruling number is 8, the gemstone is blue sapphire, the colour is dark red, the bird is nightingale, the animal is the female deer, and the tree is vakula (the Spanish cherry).



The natives of Anuradha are endowed with an attractive face, bright eyes, as well as tender and soft looks. The charm of Scorpio prevails over Visakha, Anuradha and Jyesta constellations.

The natives of Anuradha could suffer from cold, cough, sore throat and constipation. They are recommended to take care of their food rhythms and of their clothing in different seasons to insulate them from ill health.

Anuradha pairs with Visakha, the previous constellation, just like Purva Phalguni and Uttara Phalguni, Purvashada and Uttarashada and Purva Bhadra and Uttara Bhadra.

A special characteristic of Anuradha is that the natives are explorers. They try to bridge between disagreeable forces. They are good communicators between high and low. They are open and have the discrimination to cautiously bridge the different energies. They do not depend upon logic and reason, but follow their intuition. They are obsessed with numbers and are good with numerology. They have a natural inclination to explore occult sciences. If their orientation is towards occultism, they derive their power from worship. They receive grace through such worship. They are very sensitive and delicate and get hurt very easily, though seemingly they put up a tough facade.

Anuradha is a creeper of flowers. In yoga the creeper is seen as the serpent. The serpentine power of Anuradha shall have to be tamed, trained, and set into constructive activity. If not, the Saturn-Mars combination could make the natives of Anuradha nocturnal criminals, gangsters, out-laws and gamblers. The best detectives and secret police also emerge from this constellation. When appropriately nurtured, the energy leads the natives of Anuradha to sublime wisdom, secret temples and caves. Indeed, Anuradha can rise like an eagle or stoop down like a subterranean vicious serpent. All stories of eagles and serpents in the world scriptures relate to Scorpio and especially to Anuradha, which is the central theme of Scorpio.



Uranus The Alchemist of the Age

Introduction to Uranus 2

Master C.V.V., a high soul from the ashram of Master Jupiter, said to have steered the energies of Varuna via the planetary Hierarchy of Sirius, Uranus, Jupiter, Saturn and linked the ancient Yoga through the principle of Varuna (Uranus) to speed up the yogic process. The yogic process is a transformation process for a mundane man to transform into a son of God who would realize in and around him the kingdom of God. The science of Yoga is as ancient as creation. And from time to time it is adapted according to the changing times. The Yoga is first said to have been given by the Lord of Time, later by Patanjali and still later by Lord Krishna. Vishnu Sahasranama

Similarly, the indweller of every unit of existence is recognised, realised and worshipped as Vasudeva. The existence of the Lord as everything is Vishnu, while the existence of Lord in everything is Vasudeva. An aspirant who mastered experiencing the Lord as everything in Creation transforms himself into an initiate to whom the next step is realisation of the Lord in everything. When he attains the first step, he is said to have done Vishnuupasana (meditation of Vishnu); when he attains the second step, he is said to have successfully carried out Vasudevopasana (meditation of Vasudeva).

In the second step, the man meditates every given situation as the interplay of the force outside with the individual force inside. Through the balancing of the force, he escapes into his own centre, shedding the personality. With the first step, he transcends the illusion of matter and with the second step, he transcends the illusion of force, which are both negative and positive. When he thus attains the third step, he is the man turned Master - meaning the one that mastered the matter and force. Mastery does not mean conquering, controlling or subduing as is normally understood, but means intelligent balancing. In other words, it is called alignment of matter and force with consciousness within and outside.

The sacred scripture Bhagavata repeatedly postulates these three steps of initiation. It has no religious propagation but has only the spiritual instruction given out in simple and straight way.

Subtle as it is, the busy, intellectual mind that craves for complications is apt to miss the fundamentals.



Paracelsus Health and Healing

Magnetic Healing und Radiatory Healing

Occult healing basically involves two types of healing. One is magnetic healing. The other is radiatory healing. Healing work, in reality, is judicious use of energy applied with love and service.

In magnetic healing the healer does two things. He invokes healing energies to himself and transmits through the related center to the patients. He consciously draws out the sickness by the absorbing the forces which are producing the diseases. He transmits such drawn out forces into the fire of Sun light. As much as the magnetic healer invokes healing energies so much he should able to utilize them in healing the sicknesses. He should also take care to draw out the sickness when he transmits the healing energy. It is not enough if healing energy is supplied. He should consciously draw out the forces responsible for sickness. Care should also be taken to see that the drawn out sickness is distributed into the heat of the Sun light. If this is not done, the healer may draw forces unto him. Frequently healers become sick in their effort to heal others. This is because they do not know how to dissolve the drawn out forces of sickness.

People (healers) use water, fire and air for dissolving the forces of sicknesses. The best method is found to be dissolving into fire. For this purpose they lit fire and transmit the forces of disease drawn out into it. Fire consumes all and relieves the healer. Such fire ritual can be done as per healers need either daily or weekly. Sundays and Thursdays are considered good for this purpose. Some healers regularly burn Camphor in the place of healing before and after healing. This is another way of burning the drawn out forces of sickness. Some use lamps and look into the flame. There are yet others who burns sandal wood. Thus there are many ways to insulate while working with healing. The general practice is to wash hands each time a patient is attended to. This is practiced by allopaths generally.

The magnetic healing involves linking up of the Soul, the heart, the brain and the hands. After such linkup the healer can pour the vital healing force upon the patient. The radiatory healing involves linking up of the Soul, the brain, the heart and the auric emanation. The hands are not needed for healing. The Soul radiates up to the patient displays its power and the Soul of the patient responds through the patient's aura. The power of radiation from the healer decides the depth of healing.

In either of the cases ability to contact one's own Soul is important for the healer. To function as a Soul is the goal of the healer. He should be more in Soul consciousness than in the personality consciousness. If the healer is the follower of the Master of Wisdom, he can invoke the presence of the Master up to himself and receive the necessary healing energies.

When the healer thus decides to work he can chose either of the ways (magnetic or radiatory).

Generally when the healer is more in personality than in the Soul, magnetic healing is recommended. When he is advanced in his quality radiatory healing is recommended. The 1st group of healers wield the Pranic energy. The 2nd group of healers wield Soul energy, which is far superior than the Pranic energy.

There can be a very advanced state of healing where a healer can employ with equal facility energy of the Soul or of the Vital Pranic force. Healing either way has its related discipline.

Dimensions of Ancient Wisdom

To know this, the immediate needs of life are of great consequence and to offer oneself to support the surrounding life is fundamental for any entry into the inner side of man. Without that, nothing can happen. That is where Pranayama becomes important. While you practise Pranayama, you should also carve out your life in such a manner, that the same work you do now carries the value in terms of other's benefit. This shift in attitude is very important. Only when this shift happens, the effort to relate to Pranayama may find its success. Not otherwise.

When you do this Pranayama, it is but application of mind upon respiration. Then you reach with the help of inhalation a point, where the inhalation touches the point of exhalation. Thereafter it becomes exhalation and you come out with exhalation. Regularly, when you practise this, where the inhalation transforms itself into exhalation, there you would perceive the resonance of pulsation. Relating to this resonance of pulsation is very important. It is the first step in Pranayama.

When you make two or three inhalations and exhalations, you already feel the resonance of pulsation. So, associating with pulsation enables you to stay within. As long as mind is with pulsation, it does not move into objectivity. Whenever mind moves again into objectivity, you have to start with respiration again. Consciously move with the help of inhalation deep into your being, where inhalation transforms itself into exhalation. That is where pulsation can be perceived. You can feel the sensation relating to pulsation.

Your mind's ability to relate to the pulsating principle is already a good step, and we notice that this pulsating principle has a double function. It is a centrifugal and centripetal function. Staying with it becomes important. As long as you stay within that, you develop the habit of staying within your being. When you are within your being, the inner develops

itself into a magnetic-radioactive field where you would like to be, whenever there is reason. The taste of pulsation enables a student to quickly complete his obligations in the outer world, get back and stay with pulsation. It is the most endearing experience to be with pulsation.

That is why it is said, that an advanced disciple mostly stays in the cave of the heart and moves out only when there is an essentiality of outer activity. When there is an outer activity, you move out and conduct your work, and again come back and stay within. This staying within, when there is no essential outer work, enables to close the excessive activity of Libra. The sun sign Libra has the tendency to create passion, it has the tendency for illusion, which we call maya, or ignorance, or the fall of man. The fall is certain, when one is after what he desires, and the fall is always prevented, when he is after what he has to do instead of what he has to desire. There is no place for desire in creation, and all those who are in desire are in the related passion and illusion, and they stay disconnected with their inner man and can never be getting into it. The outer world has so many attractions to which the senses are drawn. You don't need all that is available in the outer world. You need to relate to what is to be done and not to look for sense objects.

Picture to the Month of Virgo Virgo - Blessing of the Mother




