


Message of the month of Virgo M

Utterances of Lord Krishna



People speak of happiness in many levels and degrees. Levels are to those who measure, but not to happiness. Happiness is Consciousness beyond measure and hence no measures are there to happiness. As long as they dwell in senses, they look happiness through their own chasms and holes, and talk of its levels and grades. As long as they dwell in mind, they see happiness through that window of mind. The shape is of the window, but not of happiness. As long as they dwell in behaviour, they behave in the name of happiness. They speak of happiness as 'that' and 'that which'. The terms are their own limitations and happiness is beyond 'this' and 'that'. Man sees man through the eyes, whereas the eyes cannot see a man. Similarly happiness knows happiness; the mind and the senses can never know happiness. Happiness exists as discriminating will in you. Only the will touches the experience of happiness. You are therefore expected to stand as your discriminating will, above and beyond your body, senses, mind and behaviour. Now you are happy because you know what is happiness. How do you know that you are happy? Know it by knowing nothing other than happiness while you live. I don't propose to fix you in happiness. Happiness is stable in itself and requires no fixing. Shambala 76: Three Principles

Recollect Shambala, bow down to the Lord Sanat Kumara, and tread the path of Lord Maitreya, the World Teacher.

The Hierarchy is ever striving to manifest the Will of Shambala upon the planet. To conduct the Hierarchical plan, a group of goodwill workers is the need. The primary qualification for such a group, is threefold as follows:

- 1. A poised mind free of emotional disturbances.
- 2. Free of any glamor relating to the Presence of the Masters of Wisdom.
- A constancy of vibration free of any excesses (excitement or despair) in all walks of life.

The above three qualifications are very essential to the aspirants. Such ones are easily inspired by a Master of Wisdom. When these qualifications are absent, a Master of Wisdom, cannot admit a member into the group. Each day, the members would do well to contemplate upon the following:

- 1. What act of service am I to conduct today?
- 2. Are there any acts that are non-essential in my daily routine? If so, how do I free myself of such non-essentials.
- 3. How are my present responsibilities?
- 4. Who do I co-operate with, today?
- 5. Of what utility am I, to the Hierarchy, today?

Each member shall affirm to himself as belonging to Shambala and the Hierarchy. It is also of utility to desire, that in the outer world, he only contacts those with similar aspirations and alignment. That the personality life is submitted to the Will of the Hierarchy and the needs of the co-beings is also desired by the student. To Shambala, he submits himself voluntarily.

To the ones, who have consecrated to the practice given above, the Divine Will gradually substitutes the individual will. The Masters and the Path are proximate to such ones!

In the recent times, Sri Shankaracharya, Sri Gautama Buddha and Pythagoras taught, trained and enabled recruiting a number of well-trained disciples thus strengthening the Hierarchy. Today, these disciples are associated with Shambala. Also, through Jesus, the Christ, several members working with the sixth ray of devotion and second ray of Love-Wisdom are part of the groups relating to the Hierarchy.

The positive sound is the listening-aspect of the sound. The negative sound is the speaking-aspect of the sound. They respectively form the content and the container. That is what we call Mitra and Varuna. Varuna is the measure, Mitra is the measured. The devas of Radiation are 12. The devas of vibration are 11. The devas of materialisation are 8. Together the Devas are chiefly 33 in number. They are:

2 Aswins Mitra And Varuna
12 Adytias Devas of Radiation
11 Rudras Devas of Vibration

8 Vasus Devas of Materialization

33 Devas

The one who realizes the Word is said to be a 'Master of the 33rd degree'. For the devas the Word is very dear, because they have emerged from it. They fulfil the work of the Word. 33 devas + the Word makes 34. The Word, + the Source, from which it comes, makes 35. However it is not called 35, it is called 34 +. The secrets of 'Ezekiel's Wheel' are contained in the number 34 +. In the Bible there is the grand concept of 'Ezekiel's Wheel'. The number relating to it is more than 34 and less than 35.



Ashram Regulations for Entry

Sound key of the term 'Ashram'

The thought is fire and the sound of fire is 'R'. Action in the outer world relates to material and all material activity can be related to the sound 'M'. The first key speaks of 'A'. The third key speaks of 'R' and 'M' and the second key speaks of 'S' and 'H' relating to inhalation and exhalation. When all these sounds are put together, we get the term 'Ashrm' (Ashram).

The sacred term 'ashram' is thus composed of three keys. One relates to A (first key), the second relates to S, H and the third relates to R, M. When the three keys are put together in practice one realizes the ashram. This is an innovative

definition emerging here and now but not a classical definition.

Note the sound:

- A to relate to Omnipresent.
- S, H to relate to inhalation and exhalation having accomplished the regulations of sound
- R, M to relate for right thought and right action

When the three steps are accomplished, one lands in an ashram.



On Secret Doctrine

Space - 11: Brahma

The very names of the two chief deities, Brahmâ and Vishnu, ought to have long ago suggested their esoteric meanings.

For the root of one, Brahmam, or Brahm, is derived by some from the word Brih, "to grow "or "to expand "; and of the other, Vishnu, from the root Vis, "to pervade," to enter in the nature of the essence;

Brahmâ-Vishnu being this infinite space, of which the gods, the Rishis, the Manus, and all in this universe are simply the potencies, Vibhutayah.

* * * * *

- Existence Awareness was presented. We made an understanding of the proximity of the various circles to the paper as the commonness in Existence.
- 2. The center and the circumferences are like this, meaning, like states of awareness, and as existence, we are all the same.
- 3. From out of the Existence, there is a formation of a center. There is on emanation from 'Brahm', which expands or grows thereafter. Thus we understand, 'Brahma' from the word, 'Brih' and from the root of one, 'Brahmam'.
- 4. Thereafter, there is a pervasion. The principle that pervades all, is Vishnu. Vishnu means the permeating light of the universe. It is in this light all forms live, move and have their being. It dwells in all forms, while the latter dwell in it. Vishnu is like the ocean of light, while the beings live as tides of the ocean. Essentially the tide is also the ocean, though seen differently.
- 5. Vishnu pervades all the three planes, the visible, the subtle and the causal, and is even beyond. He is called "the four-armed One". From his light, the causal, the subtle and the gross successively manifest. In three steps he forms the visible world. Again in three steps he lifts up the world into himself.



Saturn

Sam - The Key to Saturn
The Three Eyes

The 3 dots are but the 3 eyes which exist in us.

- · The left eye relates to sight
- · The right eye relates to wisdom and
- The third eye relates to vision (insight) The 3rd eye functions not, to the uninitiated. It is the eye of Cosmic Fire or Pure Consciousness.
- The left eye relates to lunar energy.
- The right eye relates to solar energy.
- When the soli-lunar energies are balanced in oneself, one experiences as a unit of cosmic entity.
- It is therefore recommended that one visualizes the 3 dots in his forehead, with the upper dot at the centre of the forehead. The left and right dots on the left and the right eyebrows.
- In fact these three points on the forehead are the points of emergence of the energies of Ida, Pingala and Sushumna. Meditating upon the 3, one experiences the Pure Consciousness through their merger.
- These three streams of energy flowing in oneself are but one, 1 becomes 3 for manifestation, 3 should become 1 for self-realization.
- Traditionally, these three states are related to Ganga, Yamuna and Saraswathi rivers in India, who find their merger at the Holy Prayaga. When one experiences the Prayaga in oneself, he experiences the Self.



Life and Teachings of Master Jesus

Part 4: Birth of Jesus 11

The Master Jesus was born at midnight on December 22nd. On the World stage, the intelligences have noticed that. Since Jesus was born at the time of the birth of the protection principle on Earth, he was considered a saviour to perform the yajna for human protection. There is a popular saying in the Kashmir valley, that the foundation for the birth of Jesus had been laid 3000 years ago. In the prelude to his birth, the birth and marriage of Mary and Joseph and their preparation for his birth are part of this folk tale. The hidden part of Jesus' story is coming to light now. The story received by me is being informed to you in the following manner. Some new things will be revealed in this story. The truths of these would be known to mankind in the future.


Mary and Joseph were the parents of Jesus. Joseph was a Maha Siddha who learned the absolute skill of masonry. He had close relations with the Greek, Egyptian, Assyrian, and Nepalese universities of masonry. It is this Siddha who is mentioned as the Grand Master Rakoczi, the Count Saint German, and the Grand Master of Masonry by the present-day Theosophical Society. 5000 years ago, by Divine grace, Joseph attained immortality at the juncture of Dvapara and Kali Yuga. Later on, He attained the state of Brahman. He stands as an important member of the Hierarchy who executes the divine plan. Joseph's incarnation in the Jewish race was part of the Masters' plan for the birth of Jesus. Though being a Maha Gyani, Yogi and Siddha, he chose carpentry as his profession.

In the same manner, Mary is also the most virtuous person who attained unparalleled surrender on the path of devotion. She also had her first spiritual awakening five thousand years ago, in the valleys of Kandahar, in present-day Afghanistan. This place was called Gandhar in the Indian language. Diligence,

devotion, worship, chastity, acquisition of knowledge, and service to living beings as her main characteristics, progressing on the path of devotion, she attained the perfect motherly figure. Today, she is being worshipped as the embodiment of motherhood on earth. She too is a Siddha and an immortal, who has been living for thousands of years devoted to the plan of the Hierarchy. In the life of Jesus, she always stood behind Him, extending her cooperation in the form of Sakthi, while He performed great deeds. At the time of the crucifixion of Jesus, though being a mother, she remained unwavering, and she provided him with fortitude, displaying her steady wisdom (stithapragnya). Jesus was born to such chaste parents.

Astrology was very popular at the time of Jesus' birth. In India, Egypt, Greece, Assyria, Chaldea, Babylonia, Galilee and Jerusalem cosmology was being practiced. Doing tapas was very common. According to the Aarudha Lagna, the cause of the birth of the being was known. Jesus was born at the time of the spreading of the protection principle on earth. Accordingly, it was known that he would be a Saviour. Jesus is called the Son of the Virgin, as He was born when the Sun enters into Capricorn and Virgo rises in the East at midnight. But it is not true that he was born of a virgin Mary.

Communication 3



If we communicate at the level of silence, it is a great facility, if we can transmit ideas, it is also a better situation than that which is prevailing now. What we call Telepathy is only communicating at the third level which is the level of Thought. But even telepathy is a miracle to us. Thereafter there is the communication through language. Communications are held as between Ashrams in silence. It is so with the Masters and it is so with the beings in the Higher Systems. We should also tune up to it by following the method. The method is hidden in our practice of sound. Today we need so many words to express the concept of sound.

In the esoteric circles, the teaching is more through impression than expression. It is easier. As between disciples too there are no expressed

words for communication. "The less we speak, the better it is", is the understanding in the inner circles of outer groups. In contrast, the way we speak seems very elementary, preliminary and primitive. It is a paradox that we do not know how to listen and how to speak!

The Teacher 2 - Sri Ramanuja

Sri Ramanuja is the acharya who popularized this mantra among the masses in Kali Yuga. Until the advent of Ramanuja, the mantra was practiced only by those who were initiated into the mantra. Initiation was from mouth to ear. It was secretive and was exclusive. Ramanuja who belongs to the 'path of grace' was initiated from mouth to ear by his teacher in a very famous temple, Srirangam. The temple of Srirangam is a huge temple with vast sprawling land compounded on all four sides. It has four entrances on the east, west, south and north. Each entrance has a very tall gopura (a pyramidal structure). Within the temple, from ancient most times the mantra was practiced by those who were initiated authentically.

Ramanuja while he was in his youthful years, his attitude, devotion and

discipline were admired by a teacher of Vaishnava cult. He drew Ramanuia near and initiated him with the mantra by uttering forth the mantra into the left ear of Sri Ramanuja. Ramanuja was instructed to chant the mantra incessantly and silently associating the mantra with the breath. He was instructed to be secretive of the initiation. The teacher told Ramanuja that the mantra enables the latter to stand liberated from the world. He also said that the liberated ones can serve the world better.

2. The Fundamental Understanding 20

Let us also understand that human body is given to us. We did not choose. It is the best of the forms in creation to experience. The body too is divine. It is the God given vehicle to experience the journey of life. If you abuse it, it gives trouble. If you under use it, it also gives trouble. It should be used as much as is required to be used. If you overuse your vehicle, it wears out quickly. The parts may become non-functional. When you underuse your vehicle, it gets rusted. What is true with your vehicle is true with your body. Fuel it, oil it, grease it and use it to experience. The scriptures say that if one is given a human body, it is an opportunity given. It's like getting, per chance, the best vehicle in creation. It offers an opportunity to experience the splendour of creation, realising oneself. It should not be thrown away recklessly.

As much as the body is needed to journey through, so much it needs to be cast off as the journey is completed. When the purpose is served, there is no wisdom in sitting pretty in the vehicle. The wise ones cast off their bodies as their purpose is fulfilled. The ignorant hang on, for they neither know the purpose of it nor fulfilment of it. Releasing the soul from the shackles of the body is also healing. Today, our medical science advanced so much that we can keep the body alive even after the man is no more conscious. The hospitals in developing countries are gradually getting filled with such non-operating yet living bodies. It is slowly emerging as a problem. This is because, the soul has neither the knowhow to cast off and leave, nor it has the ability to function through. This is a miserable stuck-up to the one in the body and also the ones who are his near and dear. The students of healing are therefore to understand that:

- a. body is given for a purpose
- b. hold the know-how to leave the body as the purpose is fulfilled and
- c. even if the body drops off before such fulfilment of purpose, the soul gains one more.

The Will to be with the Lord 3



All life activity is essentially spiritual, if one can perceive. What is important is perception. People live in outer concepts. They live with borrowed concepts, imposed concepts, traditional concepts. Concepts are concretised forms of that which is conceived. Perception is a deeper functioning than conception. Behind all that one is surrounded with, there is the divine. But the divine is veiled by the concept. One's concept of a spouse is a veil to the divine behind. One's concept of a family is a veil to the hidden divinity.

Likewise concepts of profession, social activity, service etc. are but veils. The divine is behind. The divine is the background consciousness of all projections of sound, colour, number and symbol.

How much one remembers the divine when one sees children and grandchildren, friends, relatives, agreeable persons, disagreeable persons, agreeable situations, disagreeable situations and so on? In all that one encounters, there can be concurrent encountering of the divine besides the changing concepts of activity. This is perceivable if one is regular at practice.



If I am exaggerating, it is only to bring out glaringly to our notice, the understanding and functioning of an aspirant who is under the influence and impulse of 6th Ray.

Prana - life force, part XI 3. Prana 2

The breathing exercises including retention of breath in and out cause expansion and contraction of heart muscle, which strengthens the functioning of the heart. Appropriate breathing helps blood to become more fluid which in turn results in proper flow even through the small arteries. There would be no deficiency of blood in any part of the body. Expansion and contraction through breathing exercises enable the veins and arteries remain open up to the optimum.

This main Prana is also chiefly related to the soul, for soul is also located in the heart, as per the eastern understanding. It moves to head during wakeful hours but generally resides in heart. Heart is the residence of the soul while head is its bureau. The Upanishads say that the soul is placed in Prana and pervades Prana. Prana builds the body with the support of the soul that resides in it. The soul is immutable, indestructible and immortal while Prana is mutable. It proceeds and recedes as per the will of the soul. The third function of Prana functions from the diaphragm to the throat with heart as its seat.

Prana is also differentiated into three types: Satvik, Rajasic and Tamasic, which are described here under:

- a) Satvik Prana: Satvik Prana is subtle and quiet in its flow. Such Prana is in union with the soul and enables experiencing Be-ness. Prana is devoid of all agitations and said to be at rest with the intelligent soul. It is a peaceful state of being in which there is not even excessive consciousness of the body. It is the tranquil state of a person.
- b) Rajasic Prana: It is the dynamic functioning of Prana from the heart which causes pumping of blood and circulating it to the whole body. Due to this Prana the heart throbs. The heartbeat becomes excessive

and rapid when the body is in motion or in activity such as exercises, games, mountaineering. This Prana is also very active when persons are at work. It is the dynamic functioning of the heart, which expends much energy. The persons are generally over-active and ever active when this Prana is dominant. The pulse rate is also high in such people.

c) Tamasic Prana: This Prana is contrary to the earlier one. It is slow, lethargic, and feeble in relation to the functioning of the heart. Drowsiness and dullness are due to Tamasic function of heart. The body feels heavy. The inclination to and the capacity for work remain less than required. The rhythm of the heart beat also changes. There would be jerks and missing heartbeats. The blood is less fluid and therefore flows slow. It has tendencies of congestion.

When this Prana is dominant the hands, feet and other organs become hard like stone during and after sleep. The parts of the body do not become active soon after awakening from sleep. This is due to the slow and feeble flow of Prana and intelligence. It tends people to be more and more inactive. Numbness of the limbs is often felt when Prana functioning from the heart is Tamasic. To activate this Prana one needs to do much exercise and remain active during the day, while the persons dominated by Rajasic Prana need to retreat, relax from time to time.

The functioning of Prana from the heart is pivotal and its triple way of functioning needs to be observed carefully by physicians.

This is what we call the balance of the two as poise. When the poise prevails there is the comprehension, there is brilliance. When the static state prevails there is disappearance of brilliance. When the dynamic state prevails there is the excessive brilliance that causes the damage. If there is more voltage in electricity, then everything is damaged. When there is feeble electricity there is no experience of activity.
